Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

This Sunday's celebration of the Baptism of the Lord closes the Christmas season. In the Scriptures, we see one more epiphany, or manifestation, of the Spirit of God in Jesus — but this time it is as an adult, rather than as a child. Jesus' baptism serves as the inauguration of his prophetic mission and the messianic age. In the Gospel narrative, a crucial moment comes when the Spirit of God comes upon Jesus and a voice from heaven echoes the words of Isaiah: "*This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased*" (Matthew 3:17).

On page 12 of this week's bulletin, you will find our deacon-candidates who earlier this week received the last of the minor orders - the acolyte. Fairly soon, and only with God's grace and your prayers, they will be ordained to permanent diaconate. We are blessed to have two of them from IHM, and the other two from our neighbor parishes.

The next few weeks are fairly quiet. Not a lot of activity. This will not last for long so it is a good time to start a book you have been putting off reading, attend a daily morning mass, or spend time with Jesus at the Blessed Sacrament. Our lives get so busy so fast we forget where our priorities need to be focused, on our Heavenly Father.






