



Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

In today's readings, we find ourselves being drawn more deeply into relationship with Jesus. We are getting to know more about him as we see how he struggles with the news of his cousin John's arrest. His first response is to withdraw, to leave Nazareth and go to Capernaum. There he is perhaps both consoled and challenged by the words of Isaiah that Matthew quotes: **"the people who sit in darkness have seen a great light, / on those dwelling in a land overshadowed by death / light has arisen"** (Matthew 4:16). Jesus contemplates his cousin's death, perhaps his own death, and he seeks the light. Maybe it is these words of Isaiah that move Jesus out of his withdrawal and into action. He begins to preach, teach, cure disease and illness, and proclaim the gospel of the kingdom.

In just two weeks we will host the "10th" Pan de Vida retreat for teens. This is an experience the youth of our parish and other parishes never forget and it leads them closer to Christ. If your child is a student of the IHM Confirmation program they are required to attend a retreat and this one is very worthwhile.

En las lecturas de hoy nos encontramos inmersos más profundamente en una relación con Jesús. Estamos llegando a saber más sobre él a medida que vemos cómo lucha con la noticia del arresto de su primo Juan. Su primera respuesta es retirarse, dejar Nazaret e ir a Capernaum. Allí, tal vez es consolado y desafiado por las palabras de Isaías que Mateo cita: **"las personas que se sientan en la oscuridad han visto una gran luz, / en aquellos que habitan en una tierra ensombrecida y la muerte / la luz ha surgido"** (Mateo 4:16). Jesús contempla la muerte de su primo, quizás su propia muerte y busca la luz. Quizás estas son las palabras de Isaías que sacan a Jesús de su camino hacia la acción. Comienza a predicar, enseñar, curar epidemias y enfermedades y proclamar el evangelio del Reino.

En solo dos semanas patrocinaremos el "Décimo" Retiro de Pan de Vida para adolescentes. Esta es una experiencia que los jóvenes de nuestra parroquia y otras parroquias nunca olvidan y los llevan más cerca a Cristo. Si su hijo es estudiante del Programa de Confirmación de ICM, este es un requisito que deben asistir y uno que vale la pena.







SERVING ONLY THE CONSECRATED HOST AT HOLY COMMUNION

During this time of the year when there is a growing number of people with cold or flu, we at Immaculate Heart of Mary are taking necessary measures to avert the spread of these infectious diseases.

Effective immediately, and temporarily, **only the consecrated hosts** (Body of Christ) will be served at communion.

These safety protocols are issued in our collective desire to keep our Church, our worship space, to truly be a sanctuary promoting holistic health of every parishioner—in body, mind and spirit.




