## Lectura

### Primera lectura

### 2 Reyes 4, 8-11, 14-16a

Le pondremos allí una cama, una mesa, una silla y una lámpara, para que se quede allí, cuando venga a visitarnos".

Así se hizo y cuando Eliseo regresó a Sunem, subió a la habitación y se recostó en la cama. Entonces le dijo a su criado: "¿Qué podemos hacer por esta mujer?" El criado le dijo: "Mira, no tiene hijos y su marido ya es un anciano". Entonces dijo Eliseo: "Llámala". El criado la llamó y ella, al llegar, se detuvo en la puerta. Eliseo le dijo: "El año que viene, por estas mismas fechas, tendrás un hijo en tus brazos".

One day Elisha came to Shunem, where there was a woman of influence, who urged him to dine with her. Afterward, whenever he passed by, he used to stop there to dine. So she said to her husband, "I know that Elisha is a holy man of God. Since he visits us often, let us arrange a little room on the roof and furnish it for him with a bed, table, chair, and lamp, so that when he comes to us he can stay there." Sometime later Elisha arrived and stayed in the room overnight.

Later Elisha asked, "Can something be done for her?" His servant Gehazi answered, "Yes! She has no son, and her husband is getting on in years." Elisha said, "Call her." When the woman had been called and stood at the door, Elisha promised, "This time next year you will be fondling a baby son."

### READING 2

### Rom 6:3-4, 8-11

Brothers and sisters:

If, then, we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him. We know that Christ, raised from the dead, dies no more; death no longer has power over him. Immaculate Heart of Mary Church Future Reopening Plan  
With restrictions and limitations, under the guidance of  
Bishop Michael Barber and Contra Costa County Health,

**IHM Church plans to reopen for (inside 100 people) worship on July 1, 2020.**

Prior to reopening, IHM staff and ministers  
will undergo extensive health and safety training.

### **Before Mass**

All ministers will wash their hands with soap and warm water for 20 seconds at the beginning of the Mass and after as well.

### **In Church, Hall, Plaza and Meditation Garden**

To ensure that we do not exceed the persons capacity in the church, and in the Hall, the ushers will count the number of parishioners.

Space in Plaza and in the Meditation Garden will be utilized to limit the number so that no one is turned away. Please bring your own chairs. Thanks.

All are encouraged to choose one Mass per week in the church so that more people can celebrate in-person.

There are daily Masses throughout the week to accommodate more people.

### **Worship Aids**

If you like to follow along with the prayers at Mass, the readings will be printed in the Bulletin. Please bring the bulletin home after use.

There will not be worship Missals available in the church. Only our choir will sing and there will be 4 choir members per mass.

### **Wear a Face Covering**

Guided by the Center for Disease Control (CDC), everyone must wear a face covering that covers the nose and mouth.

### **Arriving at Church**

#### **Arrive Early**

Please arrive 30 minutes early to allow time to park and be counted. First come first serve.

#### **Entrance and Exit**

Enter only at the Church front doors that face Fairview Avenue. The side doors are exits only.

#### **Inside the Church**

Our holy water fonts will continue to be empty for safety.

To ensure proper social distancing, please stay on the marked signs on the floor. Members of one household may sit together in one place.

### **6-Foot Distance**

In the church, parish hall, meditation garden and the plaza, 6-foot physical distancing policy will be implemented. Seating will be reduced to allow for more space between parishioners.

### **Liturgy**

To reduce contact, the presentation of the gifts has been removed.

### **Sign of Peace**

We will offer peace in the silence of our hearts.

### **Communion**

The Precious Blood (Cup) will not be available. The faithful can receive Communion in the hand or on the tongue.

### **After Mass**

No gather for fellowship in the Church, hall, plaza, or parking lots after Mass.

### **Print bulletins will be available.**

### **Cleaning**

Touched areas of the church will be cleaned after each Mass.

### **Adoration Chapel**

Will remain closed.

### **Confession**

We continue to have Confession in the church.  
Tuesdays at 6:00 – 7:00 PM and Saturdays at 3:30 – 4:30 PM

### **Livestream Mass**

Mass will continue to be livestreamed on Youtube.

### **Those at Risk**

Anyone who is in an at-risk health group or does not feel comfortable attending a public gathering should stay home.

Also, anyone who is sick or has been exposed to the coronavirus should refrain from attending a public Mass as it is an act of Christian charity to safeguard the health of others.

Until further notice, Bishop Barber continues to dispense the faithful from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days.

## **Clergy Instructions**

The priest and deacon must wear a face covering for the distribution of Holy Communion.

Priest does not wear a face covering when presiding at Mass since he is far away from the people.

Only the priests, deacon and trained Eucharist's Ministers are to distribute Communion during the Mass.

If the priest's, deacon's and ministers' hands come into contact with the faithful's hand or tongue, disinfectant wipes or a clean, unused cloth and a bowl of disinfectant will be available for the priest, deacon or ministers to sanitize their fingers.

**More communications** will follow via Flocknotes, the IHM website, live stream Masses and emails.



1. Al comienzo de la misa y al terminar, todos los ministros se lavarán las manos con jabón y agua caliente durante 20 segundos.
2. El templo, el salón, la plaza y el jardín de meditación serán utilizados durante cada Misa para asegurarnos de no exceder la capacidad autorizada de personas en la iglesia. Los ujieres acomodaran a las personas conforme vayan llegando. No se permitirá el apartado de lugares, sin excepciones. Favor de traer sus propias sillas para afuera.
3. Se recomienda llegar 30 minutos antes de la celebración para facilitar el conteo y disponibilidad de lugares.
4. El uso de cubierta facial es mandatorio en todo momento mientras se encuentre dentro de las instalaciones parroquiales.
5. Habrá una cantidad limitada del boletín con las lecturas y los cantos impresos en la iglesia. También puede descargar el boletín en nuestra pagina web o en la descripción de cada misa en línea en YouTube.
6. Una vez tomado del boletín de la parroquia deberá llevarlo a casa. No habrá Misales en la iglesia por tiempo indefinido.
7. El Ingreso al templo se hará solo por las puertas frontales de la Iglesia en la plaza. Las puertas laterales servirán solo como salidas.
8. Los depósitos de agua bendita seguirán vacíos por seguridad de todos por tiempo indefinido.
9. Para garantizar un distanciamiento social adecuado (6 pies de distancia), siga los señalamientos marcados en el piso entre las bancas. Los miembros de un hogar pueden sentarse juntos a poca distancia de cada uno.
10. Durante la celebración de la Misa, evite tener contacto con otras personas. Por lo mismo, la presentación de las ofrendas, el signo de la paz, quedan suspendidos hasta nuevo aviso. El sostener las manos durante el Padre Nuestro nunca ha sido parte de la liturgia católica y también queda prohibido.
11. La comunión se administrará bajo la especie del pan solamente por tiempo indefinido.
12. Los fieles pueden recibir la comunión en la mano (siguiendo las normas de salud y limpieza) o en la boca, esta no está prohibida.
13. Al término de la Misa se anima encarecidamente que No se reúnan en la plaza ni en ningún otro lugar dentro de las instalaciones parroquiales para dar fácil acceso al siguiente grupo de personas de las misas posteriores.
14. Las áreas comúnmente tocadas en la iglesia serán debidamente desinfectadas al termino de cada celebración.

15. La capilla del Santísimo y el Salón de los niños (cryroom) permanecen cerrados al acceso publico por el momento.
16. El Sacramento de la Reconciliación seguirá en su horario normal, martes 6-7pm y sábado 3:30-4:30pm. O por cita previa.
17. La misa continuará siendo transmitida en vivo por Youtube.
18. Se recomienda encarecidamente a cualquier persona que se encuentre en alto riesgo de salud, que haya estado expuesta al coronavirus o que no se sienta cómoda asistir a una reunión pública que permanezca en casa y participe de la celebración por internet. Salvaguardar la salud de los demás también es un acto de caridad.
19. La obligación de asistir a Misa físicamente sigue dispensada por el Obispo hasta nuevo aviso.
20. Los ministros extraordinarios de comunión, así como el clero que distribuyen la misma, deberán utilizar cubrebocas durante la distribución del sacramento.
21. Mientras preside la misa, el sacerdote no está obligado a cubrirse la boca, ya que el altar está lejos del contacto con los fieles.
22. Solo los clérigos y ministros extraordinarios de la Eucaristía propiamente entrenados están autorizados a distribuir la comunión durante y fuera de la Misa (sus propios familiares en casa solamente) cuando se les es permitido.
23. Durante la distribución de la comunión, el ministro que distribuye tendrá acceso a lavarse y desinfectarse las manos en caso de caer en contacto físico con el comulgante que recibe en la mano o en la boca.
24. Los comunicados oficiales de la parroquia, así como los links propios de las celebraciones, seguirán siendo disponibles a través del sistema de Flocknote y del sitio web parroquial [www.ihmbrentwood.com](http://www.ihmbrentwood.com)
