FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1

What is a Marian Conference?

The 2019 Marian Conference at Immaculate Heart of Mary Church is an opportunity to enter into an experience of prayer, reflection, learning and adoration with the ultimate goal of becoming closer to Jesus through His mother, Mary. In an atmosphere alternating between quiet and celebration, it will be a gathering of at least 1,000 Catholics from IHM and nearby parishes to reflect on their lives, their families and our world today; and with the help of the international and national speakers invited for the event, grow deeper in relationship with Mary and Jesus.

Do I need to pre-register?

Yes, as seating is limited, we advise you to pre-register online via FaithDirect or Eventbrite beginning March 2019. You may also opt to pre-register through mail or by dropping off the signed form at the Parish Office of Immaculate Heart of Mary Church (500 Fairview Avenue, Brentwood, CA 94513). Same day registration will be available during the Conference; however, for the interest of organization and convenience on the part of the participants, we advise that you take advantage of the various avenues to pre-register.

What does my Conference registration fee cover?

Your registration fee of \$30 covers admission to sessions and side events during the two-day Conference. 
