



Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Today our readings are about faith, frustration, and how much is enough. Habakkuk is a complainer having an argument with God. Timothy is encouraging a community challenged by cowardice and the apostles want more faith than they have. Things aren't happening fast enough for any of them or for us. All of them and we want God to do something sooner rather than later and we want God to give us a reason to believe that it will all work out. What does God do? God puts it back on them—and us—telling Habakkuk to describe the world he wants; telling the apostles to do more than the expected. Doing more with less is a familiar phrase today and ***a reminder that a little faith may be enough even for the most difficult times.***

Next week beginning 1pm October 11 is our Marian Conference. All the planning and preparing has brought us to this point. Starting with this Saturday, October 12<sup>th</sup> we will have a 5:00PM Youth and Family Mass that will take place every month on the second Saturday. Also, on Saturday, October 12, the 6:30 PM Mass will be replaced with a Mass at 7:30PM and will be the closing Mass for the Marian Conference with our own Pastor, Quang Dong, presiding. If you have not yet registered, do so in the parish office.

Hoy las lecturas son sobre la fe, la frustración y cuánto es suficiente. Habacuc es un quejoso que tiene una discusión con Dios. Timoteo está animando a una comunidad desafiada por la cobardía y los apóstoles quieren más fe de la que tienen. Las cosas no están sucediendo lo suficientemente rápidas para nadie de ellos o para nosotros. Todos ellos y también nosotros queremos que Dios haga algo más pronto que tarde y queremos que Dios nos dé una razón para creer que todo saldrá bien. Dios se lo devuelve a ellos -y a nosotros- diciéndole a Habacuc que describa el mundo que quiere; diciéndole a los apóstoles que hagan más de lo que esperaban. Hacer más con menos es una frase familiar hoy en día y un ***recordatorio de que un poco de fe puede ser suficiente incluso en los momentos más difíciles.***

La próxima semana tomará lugar nuestra Conferencia Mariana. Toda la planificación y preparación nos ha llevado a este punto. Tendremos una Misa de Jóvenes y Familias a las 5:00PM que tomará lugar todos los meses en el segundo sábado del mes. El sábado 12 de octubre, la Misa de las 6:30PM ha sido cambiada a las 7:30PM que será la Misa de clausura de la Conferencia Mariana con nuestro propio Pastor, Padre Quang Dong, presidiendo.
