

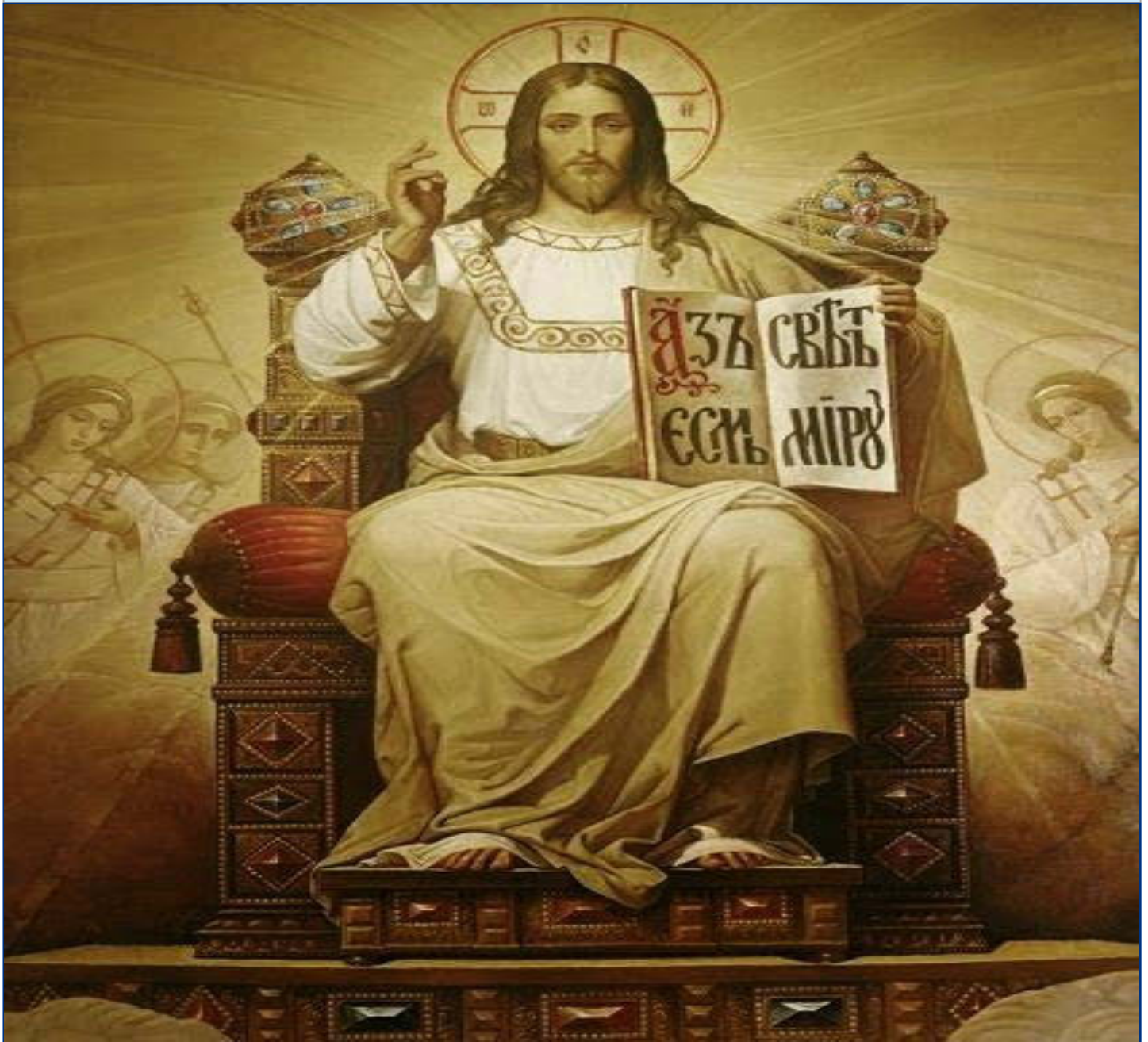

Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Americans have an uncomfortable relationship with kings. The American Revolution was fought for independence from King George, after all. Nonetheless, today every Catholic church around the world celebrates the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. Today's feast invites us to look beyond our national loyalties and rejoice in our primary identity. ***We are children of God in Jesus, Christ the King.*** Our readings help us consider what it's like to belong to God's kingdom. The book of Samuel captures the deep longing of the Israelites for a king to shepherd them. Saint Paul reminds the Colossians that we belong to the kingdom of Christ, whose power he praises in a beautiful hymn. Finally, Luke's Gospel calls to mind the kind of king Jesus chooses to be—a suffering servant, a man for others. ***By sacrificing his life for us, Jesus throws open the gates of Paradise.***

Today the Feast of Christ the King ends our Church calendar. Fresh from baptism's waters, we are anointed with chrism "as Christ was anointed priest, prophet, and king." This feast is a key to our identity. On this feast, we recognize Christ as a king who breaks the usual mold of kingship, and who shapes his kingdom with our hands, our words, our deeds of love and service. On December 1, we begin the season of Advent. We start the new liturgical year for Catholics. During this time let us prepare for the coming of Christ on Christmas.

Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us.

El libro de Samuel captura el profundo anhelo de los israelitas por un rey que los pastoreen. San Pablo recuerda a los colosenses que pertenecemos al reino de Cristo, cuyo poder alaba en un hermoso himno. Por último, el Evangelio de Lucas evoca el tipo de rey que Jesús elige ser, un siervo sufriente, un hombre para los demás. ***Al sacrificar su vida por nosotros, Jesús abre las puertas del Paraíso.***

Hoy, la fiesta de Cristo Rey termina nuestro calendario de la Iglesia. Recién salidos de las aguas del bautismo, somos ungidos con el crisma "como Cristo fue ungido sacerdote, profeta y rey". Esta fiesta es la clave de nuestra identidad. En esta fiesta, reconocemos a Cristo como un rey que frena el molde habitual de la realeza, y que da forma a su reino con nuestras manos, nuestras palabras, nuestros actos de amor y servicio. El 1 de diciembre, comenzamos la temporada de Adviento. Comenzamos el nuevo año litúrgico para los católicos. Durante este tiempo, preparémonos para la venida de Cristo en Navidad.
