It is the goal of the Respect Life Committee here at Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish to assist parishioners in understanding and embracing the Church's vision of human life and dignity, both in our individual lives and families, and as a Catholic community.

The Respect Life Ministry through prayer, communication and education, strives to promote and protect the God-given dignity of human life from conception to natural death in keeping with the teachings of Christ as articulated by the Roman Catholic Church.

Respect Life Abortion Facts:

- Abortion is legal in the U.S. throughout all nine months of a pregnancy.
- 50 Million abortions have occurred in the U.S. since Roe v. Wade in 1973.
- One out of three (1/3) of all pregnancies in the U.S. end in an abortion.
- Most abortions (90%+) are performed as a means of birth control.
- 55% of unwanted pregnancies occurred while using some form of birth control.
- 47% of women having an abortion have had one or more previous abortions.
- Less than 2% of women having an abortion claimed rape or incest.
- 700,000 abortions are performed each year in the U.S. after nine weeks pregnancy.
- Day 1 in the womb, the DNA code is encoded.
- Approximately day 18 in the womb, the child's heart begins to beat.
- Approximately day 42 in the womb, significant brain waves are recorded.
- Approximately week 24 in the womb, 60% of babies survive premature birth.
