Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

We find it difficult to convey ideas to people unless we can actually show them something, demonstrate what we mean. God, who is invisible and truly beyond human understanding, apparently faces the same difficulty. People want to *see*, not just listen to an idea. So, God gave us Jesus Christ, God made visible in the world.

During these past weeks we have seen how Jesus was revealed as an infant to the shepherds and the magi, and then began his adult "public life" at his baptism by John. Today's Gospel reading tells us of his "first sign," providing wine for the wedding guests at Cana.

Of course, even Jesus, God made visible, was not always easily understood in his own day, nor is he even now. So, we must ponder what we see: the poverty and simplicity of his birth, his humility and openness before John the Baptist, his kindness and compassion toward people in their ordinary problems, such as running short of wine at a wedding. Yet it is in coming to know Jesus that we come to know God.

As we begin the Jubilee Year of Hope let us grow closer to God our Father, Jesus His Son, Mary our Mother, and let the Hope Spirit guide us.

Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us.

Pero al conocer a Jesús conocemos a Dios.

Así como empezamos el Año Jubilar de la Esperanza, acerquémonos más a Dios nuestro Padre, Jesús su Hijo y María su Madre, y dejar que el Santo Espíritu nos guíe.

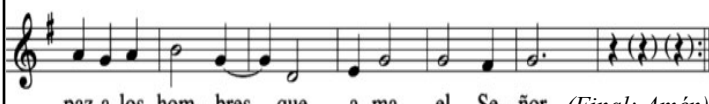

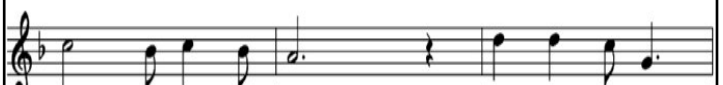

Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Is 62:1-5 | 1 Cor 12:4-11 | Jn 2:1-11

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Pop quiz: What was the name of the bride and groom at the wedding in today's Gospel? If you're unsure, you're not alone; the bridegroom is mentioned only in passing and the names of the newlyweds are not recorded at all in Scripture. Instead, the most prominent man in the account is Jesus; the most prominent woman is his mother, the Blessed Virgin Mary. In light of today's first reading, this apparent omission begins to make sense. "As a young man marries a virgin," the prophet Isaiah writes, "your Builder shall marry you." Jesus is the "Builder" of the universe, the Word through whom all things were created. Mary, whom Jesus calls "Woman," stands as a representative of the Church. This image of God as Bridegroom of his people, common throughout the Old Testament, thus takes on its full significance in Christ. He is the Bridegroom who will "wed" himself to his Church irrevocably when he offers his life for her on the cross.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

It is clear that Scriptures give us many "stories behind the stories"—a sort of "visible invisible" as we see with today's Gospel of the Wedding at Cana. What we think is happening, and who we assume are the main characters, are important and yet also diminished beside the infinite and eternal, self-sacrificing love of God. How much of our own lives contains such stories of God's immense and great love for us, behind the scenes that play out day to day? The Lord gives us all good gifts, and he uses them to help us see, know, understand and love him. The smallest moment, or the most important detail, may not be recorded or remembered, but the generosity and irrevocable love of God will never fade and will always sustain us.

JOURNAL

Although God's love for us never diminishes, we sometimes struggle to maintain the enthusiasm of our earliest encounters with him. This week, create a spiritual "photo album" you can use to remind yourself of God's blessings in your life. Recall pivotal moments in your spiritual life, write them down in a notebook, and return to them with praise and thanksgiving whenever you feel your heart drifting from the Lord.



January – Month of the Holy Name

“She will bear a son and you are to name him Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins.” (Matthew 1:21)

“Behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name him Jesus.” (Luke 1:31)

“At the name of Jesus every knee should bend, of those in heaven and on earth and under the earth.” (Phil 2:10)

The month of January is the Month of the Holy Name of Jesus. As we see from the above passages of Scripture, the name of Jesus is not random; Joseph and Mary were divinely ordained to bestow this name to the child in Mary’s womb. St. Paul’s letter to the Philippians shows us the immense importance of the name of Jesus.

The name **Jesus** comes from the Hebrew **Yeshua** or **Joshua** and means God saves, or God is salvation. This name carries the weight of divine purpose and the long-awaited messianic promise.

In the Acts of the Apostles, after Pentecost, Peter heals a paralytic beggar in the temple: “In the name of Jesus Christ the Nazorean.” This incident caused a commotion in the temple area, and the High Priest asked them, “By what power or by what name have you done this?” Peter replied, “In the name of Christ Jesus, the Nazorean.” They were ordered to refrain from preaching in Jesus’ name, but they continued. The Church continues to conclude her prayers today with **“through Jesus Christ, our Lord.”**

In the 13th century, Pope Gregory X entrusted the Dominicans with spreading devotion to the Holy Name. In the 15th century, St. Bernardine of Siena popularized the devotion by displaying a tablet with the IHS monogram representing the Holy Name of Jesus in Greek.

Let us continue following these holy saints to honor and revere the Most Holy Name of Jesus.
Most Holy Name of Jesus, have mercy on us! Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us!

Enero - Mes del Santo Nombre

«Daré a luz un hijo y le pondré por nombre Jesús, porque él salvará a su pueblo de sus pecados». (Mateo 1:21)

«He aquí que concebirás en tu seno y darás a luz un hijo, y le pondrás por nombre Jesús».
(Lucas 1:31)

«Al nombre de Jesús debe doblarse toda rodilla, de los que están en el cielo, en la tierra y debajo de la tierra». (Flp 2,10)

El mes de enero es el Mes del Santo Nombre de Jesús. Como vemos en los pasajes anteriores de la Escritura, el nombre de Jesús no es aleatorio; José y María fueron divinamente ordenados para otorgar este nombre al niño en el vientre de María. La carta de San Pablo a los Filipenses nos muestra la inmensa importancia del nombre de Jesús.

El nombre **Jesús** viene del hebreo **Yeshua o Joshua** y significa Dios salva, o Dios es salvación. Este nombre lleva el peso del propósito divino y de la promesa mesiánica tan esperada.

En los Hechos de los Apóstoles, después de Pentecostés, Pedro cura a un mendigo paralítico en el templo: «En el nombre de Jesucristo el Nazareo». Este incidente causó conmoción en la zona del templo, y el Sumo Sacerdote les preguntó: «¿Con qué poder o en qué nombre habéis hecho esto?». Pedro respondió: «En el nombre de Cristo Jesús, el Nazareo». Se les ordenó que se abstuvieran de predicar en nombre de Jesús, pero ellos continuaron. La Iglesia sigue concluyendo hoy sus oraciones con **«por Jesucristo, nuestro Señor».**

En el siglo XIII, el Papa Gregorio X encomendó a los dominicos la difusión de la devoción al Santo Nombre. En el siglo XV, San Bernardino de Siena popularizó la devoción exhibiendo una tablilla con el monograma IHS que representa el Santísimo Nombre de Jesús en griego.

Sigamos a estos santos para honrar y venerar el Santísimo Nombre de Jesús.

Santísimo Nombre de Jesús, iten piedad de nosotros! Inmaculado Corazón de María, ruega por nosotros.
