Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Today we hear how Jonah, sent by God to warn the people, storms through the streets of Nineveh, scaring the citizens out of their wits. And it works! God has a change of heart, seeing "by their actions" how the people turn from evil (Jonah 3:10). A new day dawns.

Next we hear Paul telling the Corinthians, "The world in its present form is passing away" (1 Corinthians 7:31). He calls for a change of heart. Stopping short of telling them to stop carrying out their everyday activities, he urges them—rather mysteriously—to live "as though" they aren't doing the things they are doing. A new day has dawned.

Finally, Jesus stands on the shore and cries, "The kingdom of God is at hand!" (Mark 1:14). Simon and Andrew abandon their nets—and even their father—and follow him. A new day had dawned.

Everyone has to change when a new day dawns: the Ninevites, the Corinthians, the apostles, even Jesus! Did a new day dawn today for us as well?

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Sometimes I feel like I need a Jonah in my life: someone who will come along and shake things up; someone who will nudge me and say, *hey, you're doing it wrong!* No one wants to be criticized, but I know I need loving guidance to help me when I am not at my best. It's easy to get caught up in the swirl of life and neglect (even if unintentionally) what's important. Jonah was given the unpleasant task of pointing out to the people of Nineveh their failings. Unlike many communities who resisted God's words, by the end of the first day of Jonah's anticipated three-day trek across the city, "the people of Nineveh believed God; they proclaimed a fast and all of them, great and small, put on sackcloth." For all the evil they had done, and the rebellion they had demonstrated, the people there weren't irredeemable. They simply needed Jonah to point out how they had gone astray, and the grace of open ears and hearts to receive the message. Who has the Lord placed in our lives in the role of Jonah? How has he blessed us with the ability to receive, and repent where necessary?

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

We don't seem to have obvious prophets like Jonah nowadays, but that doesn't mean God has left us without guides. We have the Church, Christ's body on earth, and the ever-present help of the Holy Spirit. In today's Gospel, we hear how Jesus selected his first followers: men who would become the Twelve Apostles, anointed to spread his word and speak in his stead even after Jesus left the earth. We know that there were other followers: men, women and children who became his disciples; Jews and Gentiles who were baptized. We are part of that apostolic tradition, each one of us baptized into the common priesthood "exercised by the unfolding of baptismal grace - a life of faith, hope, and charity, a life according to the Spirit." (CCC 1547) The call to holiness can be hard to hear in the din of today's busy and secular world, but it is not impossible. We can pray for the grace to hear how God is asking each of us to live out his commands and proclaim the Good News to the world.

PRAY Today's psalm (Ps 25:4-5, 6-7, 8-9) is a wonderful way to ask God for this favor. Make it part of your morning or evening prayer for the next week. "Your ways, O Lord, make known to me; teach me your paths."

The Conversion of St. Paul – January 25

This week, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul. This is one of the more dramatic conversions detailed in the New Testament. The account has been depicted in art since medieval times, especially in the Baroque period. Fra Angelico, Michelangelo, and Caravaggio all painted works depicting this event.

Before being known as Paul, Saul of Tarsus was a Pharisee who zealously persecuted the disciples of Jesus, known as members of the Way. In the Acts of the Apostles chapter 7, he was present at the stoning of St. Stephen, "The witnesses laid down their garments at the feet of a young man named Saul." (Acts 7:58).

Saul obtained permission from the high priest in Jerusalem to go to Damascus and find and imprison members of the Way. "Now as he journeyed he approached Damascus and suddenly a light from heaven flashed about him. And he fell to the ground and heard a voice saying to him, 'Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me? And he said, 'Who are you, Lord?' And he said, 'I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting.'" (Acts 9:3-5).

Paul's life completely changed after this dramatic encounter with the Risen Lord! Paul went on to zealously evangelize the world to Christ. St. Thomas Aquinas says in his *Summa Theologia*, "Suddenly when he was in the midst of sin, his heart was perfectly moved by God to hear, to learn, to come; and hence he received grace suddenly." May God also move us to hear, learn, and come to Jesus.

Please continue to pray for vocations to the priesthood, diaconate, religious life, and Holy Matrimony. St. Paul, pray for us! Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us!

La Conversión de San Pablo - 25 de enero

Esta semana, la Iglesia celebra la fiesta de la Conversión de San Pablo. Se trata de una de las conversiones más dramáticas del Nuevo Testamento. El relato ha sido representado en el arte desde la época medieval, especialmente en el Barroco. Fra Angelico, Miguel Ángel y Caravaggio pintaron obras que representaban este acontecimiento.

Antes de ser conocido como Pablo, Saulo de Tarso era un fariseo que perseguía celosamente a los discípulos de Jesús, conocidos como miembros del Camino. En el capítulo 7 de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, estuvo presente en la lapidación de San Esteban: "Los testigos depusieron sus vestiduras a los pies de un joven llamado Saulo". (Hechos 7:58).

Saulo obtuvo permiso del sumo sacerdote en Jerusalén para ir a Damasco y encontrar y encarcelar a miembros del Camino. "Mientras iba de camino, se acercó a Damasco y, de repente, una luz del cielo lo envolvió. Cayó al suelo y oyó una voz que le decía: 'Saulo, Saulo, ¿por qué me persigues? Y él respondió: '¿Quién eres, Señor? Y él respondió: 'Yo soy Jesús, a quien tú persigues'". (Hechos 9:3-5).

La vida de Pablo cambió por completo después de este dramático encuentro con el Señor resucitado. Pablo pasó a evangelizar celosamente el mundo a Cristo. Santo Tomás de Aquino dice en su *Summa Theologia*: "De repente, cuando estaba en medio del pecado, su corazón fue perfectamente movido por Dios a escuchar, a aprender, a venir; y por eso recibió la gracia de repente." Que Dios nos mueva también a nosotros a escuchar, aprender y venir a Jesús.

Por favor, sigan rezando por las vocaciones al sacerdocio, al diaconado, a la vida religiosa y al Santo Matrimonio. ¡San Pablo, ruega por nosotros! Inmaculado Corazón de María, ruega por nosotros.
