Dear Families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Today's gospel reveals several key characteristics of discipleship in Christ. First, unlike typical rabbinic relationships at the time where individuals would seek out a teacher to instruct them, Jesus reverses this approach to discipleship. Instead, Jesus calls his first disciples and extends an invitation to them. When Jesus first invited Peter and Andrew to follow him, they could have simply ignored the offer and continued about their daily labor. But of course, this is not the case. In the words of the prophet Isaiah, "the people who walked in darkness have seen a great light" with "abundant joy and great rejoicing."

God reaches us in the ordinariness of our lives. Like Simon, Andrew, James, and John, Jesus finds each of us where we are and invites us to join him in proclaiming the kingdom of God in our own circumstances. It is the task of each of us to welcome Jesus into our own day-to-day experiences, that we, to quote Vatican II's Dogmatic Constitution of the Church, "may work for the sanctification of the world from within, like leaven" (*Lumen Gentium* 31).

El evangelio de hoy revela varias características clave del discipulado en Cristo. Primero, a diferencia de las relaciones rabínicas típicas de la época, en las que las personas buscaban a un maestro para instruirlos, Jesús invierte este enfoque respecto al discipulado. En cambio, Jesús llama a sus primeros discípulos y les extiende una invitación. Cuando Jesús invitó por primera vez a Pedro y Andrés a seguirlo, podrían haber ignorado la oferta y haber seguido con su trabajo diario. Pero, por supuesto, no es así. En palabras del profeta Isaías, "el pueblo que caminó en la oscuridad ha visto una gran luz" con "abundante alegría y gran júbilo."

Dios nos alcanza en la ordinalidad de nuestras vidas. Al igual que Simón, Andrés, Santiago y Juan, Jesús nos encuentra a cada uno donde estamos y nos invita a unirnos a él para proclamar el reino de Dios en nuestras propias circunstancias. Es tarea de cada uno de nosotros dar la bienvenida a Jesús en nuestro lugar experiencias cotidianas, que nosotros, citando la Constitución Dogmática de la Iglesia del Vaticano II, "podemos trabajar para la santificación del mundo desde dentro, como fermento" (*Lumen Gentium* 31).

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

"Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." For most of my life, any time I have heard these words of Jesus, the emphasis has always been on "*Repent*." Recently, I've started to pay more attention to the second half of Jesus' proclamation: "The kingdom of heaven is at hand." Through his coming into our world and the beginning of his public ministry, Jesus' reign has begun. The signs of his kingdom's arrival are striking and immediate; we see Jesus "curing every disease and illness among the people." This is cause for great rejoicing, like the rejoicing we hear of in today's reading from Isaiah: "Anguish has taken wing, dispelled is darkness ... upon those who dwell in the land of gloom a light has shown." Jesus' miracles reveal that the reign of darkness, sin, and death is coming to an end; this is good news, indeed! It's also a major part of our call as disciples. We're called to pray ("thy kingdom come") and to work to advance Jesus' reign on earth.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Like the Apostles Peter, Andrew, James, and John in today's Gospel, we, too, have been called to help build God's kingdom on earth. We do this in a particular way by continuing the works of Jesus here on earth. As Pope Leo XIV reminds us in *Dilexi Te*, "The signs that accompany Jesus' preaching are manifestations of the love and compassion with which God looks upon the sick, the poor and sinners ... The Church, if she wants to be Christ's Church, must be ... a place where the poor have a privileged place." (21) Part of the way we bear witness to the inbreaking of God's kingdom on earth is to put those who are ill and marginalized at the center of our concern. Then the kingdom of God will be manifest and visible in the world, drawing others to Christ.

SERVE

This week, spend some time researching ways you can work with other Christians to serve the sick and the poor of our world. As we conclude this Week of Prayer for Christian Unity (which ends Jan. 25, 2026), there's no better witness we can offer to the dawn of the kingdom of God than being "united in the same mind and in the same purpose" (as Paul calls us to be today) in serving those in need.

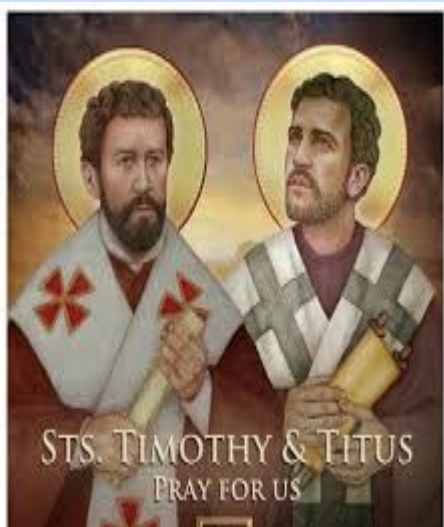

Saints Timothy & Titus – January 26

St. Paul's two letters to Timothy and his letter to Titus are known as the Pastoral Epistles. The three letters are similar in purpose and theme. It is not surprising that the Church celebrates these two followers of Paul, and evangelists, together on January 26th, the day after the Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul.

Timothy was born in Lystra, which is in present-day south-central Turkey. Specific biographical information relating to his birth and death has been lost to history. A fourth-century book from Ephesus, *The Acts of Timothy*, says that his death occurred in 97 AD at the age of 79 or 80. We do know that his mother and grandmother were Jewish and early Christian converts, and that they introduced Timothy to the Scriptures. His father was a Gentile.

On a visit to Lystra, St. Paul recognized Timothy's gifts and made him a disciple. He accompanied St. Paul on his travels to Macedonia and Greece. He also sent him as a trusted advisor to the new Churches in Corinth, Thessalonica, and Ephesus. The two letters to Timothy in the

New Testament were written to him in Ephesus, while St. Paul was in prison in Rome. In the Second Letter, St. Paul asks Timothy to come to him soon.

Titus was a Greek who studied philosophy and poetry. He was converted to Christianity by St. Paul. Like Timothy, Titus became a valued and trusted colleague. He served St. Paul as a traveling companion, secretary, and ambassador. He traveled with St. Paul to Jerusalem for the Council of Jerusalem, which decided not to require circumcision for Gentile converts. This issue caused significant trouble throughout the early Christian communities.

Later, St. Paul sent Titus to Crete, ordaining him a bishop there. Similar to Timothy, exact biographical data on Titus is not available. His death on Crete has been recorded as occurring in both 96 and 107 AD.

The letters St. Paul wrote to these two early Christian Saints bear out his affection for and trust in these men to strengthen the early Christian communities he sent them to aid. In Second Timothy 4:7, he writes, "I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith." We should all strive to be able to say that at the end of our lives, too!

Santos Timoteo y Tito – 26 de enero

Las dos cartas de San Pablo a Timoteo y su carta a Tito son conocidas como las Epístolas Pastorales. Las tres letras son similares en propósito y tema. No es de extrañar que la Iglesia celebre juntos a estos dos seguidores de Pablo y evangelistas el 26 de enero, el día después de la Fiesta de la Conversión de San Pablo.

Timothy nació en Listra, que hoy se encuentra en el centro-sur de Turquía. La información biográfica específica relacionada con su nacimiento y muerte se ha perdido en la historia. Un libro del siglo IV de Efezo, *Los Hechos de Timoteo*, dice que su muerte ocurrió en el año 97 d.C. a los 79 u 80 años. Sabemos que su madre y su abuela fueron judías y conversas al cristianismo temprano, y que introdujeron a Timoteo en las Escrituras. Su padre era gentil.

En una visita a Listra, San Pablo reconoció los dones de Timoteo y lo hizo discípulo. Acompañó a San Pablo en sus viajes a Macedonia y Grecia. También le envió como consejero de confianza a las nuevas iglesias de Corinto, Tesalónica y Efezo. Las dos cartas a Timoteo en el Nuevo Testamento le fueron escritas en Efezo, mientras San Pablo estaba en prisión en Roma. En la Segunda Carta, San Pablo pide a Timoteo que vaya pronto a verle.

Titus era griego y estudiaba filosofía y poesía. Fue convertido al cristianismo por San Pablo. Al igual que Timothy, Titus se convirtió en un colega valioso y de confianza. Sirvió a St. Paul como compañero de viaje, secretario y embajador. Viajó con San Pablo a Jerusalén para el Concilio de Jerusalén, que decidió no exigir la circuncisión para los conversos gentiles. Este problema causó importantes problemas en las primeras comunidades cristianas.

Más tarde, San Pablo envió a Tito a Creta, ordenándolo obispo allí. Al igual que en Timothy, no se dispone de datos biográficos exactos sobre Tito. Su muerte en Creta ha sido registrada como ocurrida tanto en el año 96 como en el 107 d.C.

Las cartas que San Pablo escribió a estos dos primeros santos cristianos demuestran su afecto y confianza en estos hombres para fortalecer las primeras comunidades cristianas a las que les envió a ayudar. En Segundo Timoteo 4:7, escribe: «He luchado la buena batalla, he terminado la carrera, he guardado la fe». ¡Todos deberíamos esforzarnos por poder decir eso al final de nuestras vidas también!

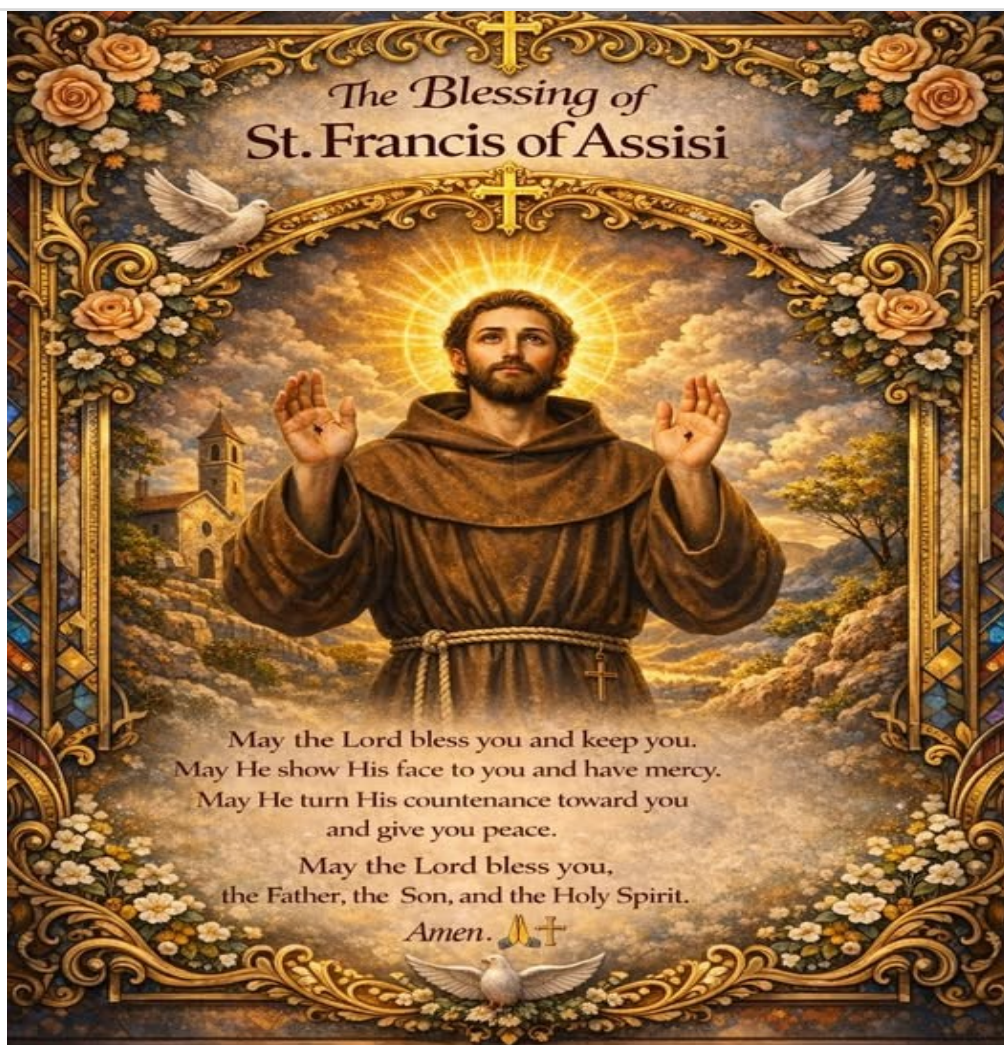
Santos Timoteo y Tito, orad por nosotros. ¡Inmaculado Corazón de María, ruega por nosotros!

This Franciscan Jubilee Year, considered a gift for the entire Church and an occasion for authentic spiritual renewal, was inaugurated on Jan. 10 with [a decree](#) issued by the Apostolic Penitentiary of the Holy See.

Until Jan. 10 of next year, the faithful can obtain this grace under the usual conditions — sacramental confession, Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the pope — by making a pilgrimage to any Franciscan conventual church or place of worship dedicated to St. Francis anywhere in the world.

Furthermore, the elderly, the sick, and those who, for serious reasons, cannot leave their homes can obtain the plenary indulgence by spiritually joining in the jubilee celebrations and offering their prayers, pains, or sufferings to God.

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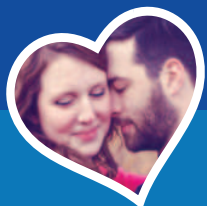
