Confronted with God's power and majesty, the first response of the prophet Isaiah was to acknowledge his sinfulness. "Woe is me; I am doomed! For I am a man of unclean lips," he said aloud. Is 6:1-2a, 3-8 | 1 Cor 15:1-11 | Lk 5:1-11

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

“Woe is me, I am doomed!” “I am the least of the apostles, not fit to be called an apostle.” “Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man.” Do you notice a theme today? Each of these lines – taken from our readings – reveals the humbling reality that when humans stand in the glorious presence of God, we must confront the Truth, look at ourselves honestly, and recognize our sin. We are reminded of the Garden, when original sin disfigured human nature and Adam and Eve, realizing their nakedness, hid themselves from God. The story would be tragic if that had been the end. But in today’s readings and in our own lives, the crippling effects of our sin are *not* the end. By becoming aware of our sin – agonizing though this may be – we invite the Lord in. It’s the crack in the door that he will enter, bringing mercy and freedom found only in him.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Each of today’s readings shows how God’s presence leads us to acknowledge our lack; however, that’s only “step one.” Notice what happens next in each instance. “Your wickedness is removed, your sin purged.” “But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace to me has not been ineffective.” “Jesus said to Simon, ‘Do not be afraid.’” See how, in each example, hearts are transformed from shame and guilt to courage and confidence. The readings explain how as each person is freed, they are compelled to act boldly. So, what changed? The same thing that can happen in our own lives: as we acknowledge our sin, we open ourselves to the flow of grace. We allow the Lord to heal and free us, making us radiant and setting our hearts on fire with love.

PLAN

Choose one virtue you’d like to cultivate in order to root out a sinful habit. Then make a plan to practice that virtue. It can be as simple as “I will always pray to the Holy Spirit before I talk to that person at work who bothers me.” Make sure your plan is: (1) specific [“I will never sin again” doesn’t count], and (2) doable [“I will pray every day for six hours to grow in patience” is not possible for most people]. Finally, offer your plan to God and ask him for whatever strength, grace, and healing you need to grow in that virtue.

Jubilee 2025 – Hope, Part 1

In the movie *The Shawshank Redemption*, the main character, Andy, explains to his fellow inmates the importance of hope. His friend, Red, is unconvinced, explaining that hope is dangerous and can drive a man insane in prison. When Red is finally released after decades in prison, he is miserable. The world outside prison is vastly different from the world inside. Before Andy escapes, he makes Red promise if he gets released he will find a package Andy will leave him. Red follows Andy's directions and finds the package. In a note, Andy writes, "Hope is a good thing. Maybe the best of things, and no good thing ever dies." Red decides to join Andy, who lives in Mexico. On the bus to the border, Red, in a voice-over, says, "I hope I can make it across the border. I hope the Pacific is as blue as it is in my dreams. **I hope.**" Red discovers the world is much bigger than the walls you may find yourself in, or your fear of change and hope is much better than despair.

There is much despair in our culture today, especially among young people. They do not understand their importance or that they were created intentionally for a purpose, and their existence is not accidental. They were created by a loving God who went to extreme lengths to save them. This God desires to be in a relationship with them. Those who despair, like Red from above, lack hope.

God supplies the best of hope, the theological virtue of hope He infuses into our soul at Baptism. The Letter to the Hebrews has several passages about hope, including this one:

"When God desired to show more convincingly to the heirs of the promise the unchangeable character of his purpose, he interposed with an oath, so that through two unchangeable things, in which it is impossible that God should prove false, we who have fled for refuge might have strong encouragement to seize the **hope** set before us. We have this as a sure and steadfast anchor of the soul, a hope that enters into the inner shrine behind the curtain, where Jesus has gone as a forerunner on our behalf." (*Heb. 6:17-20a*)

It describes hope as an anchor for our soul in heaven, our true home!

Red sigue las instrucciones de Andy y encuentra el paquete. En una nota, Andy escribe: «La esperanza es algo bueno. Quizás la mejor de las cosas, y ninguna cosa buena muere jamás». Red decide reunirse con Andy, que vive en México. En el autobús hacia la frontera, Red, con voz en off, dice: «Espero poder cruzar la frontera. Espero que el Pacífico sea tan azul como en mis sueños. **Espero**». Red descubre que el mundo es mucho más grande que los muros en los que te puedes encontrar, o que tu miedo al cambio, y que la esperanza es mucho mejor que la desesperación.

Hoy en día hay mucha desesperación en nuestra cultura, especialmente entre los jóvenes. No comprenden su importancia ni que fueron creados intencionadamente con un propósito, y que su existencia no es accidental. Fueron creados por un Dios amoroso que hizo todo lo posible por salvarlos. Este Dios desea tener una relación con ellos. Los que desesperan, como Red de arriba, carecen de esperanza.

Dios suministra la mejor de las esperanzas, la virtud teológica de la esperanza que infunde en nuestra alma en el Bautismo. La Carta a los Hebreos contiene varios pasajes sobre la esperanza, entre ellos éste:

«Cuando Dios quiso mostrar más convincentemente a los herederos de la promesa el carácter inmutable de su propósito, se interpuso con un juramento, para que por medio de dos cosas inmutables, en las que es imposible que Dios se muestre falso, nosotros, que hemos huido para refugiarnos, tuviéramos un fuerte estímulo para aprovechar la **esperanza** puesta ante nosotros. Tenemos esto como un ancla segura y firme del alma, una esperanza que entra en el santuario interior detrás de la cortina, donde Jesús ha ido como precursor en nuestro nombre». (*Heb. 6:17-20a*)
