



Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

As we begin our season of fasting, prayer, and almsgiving, the reading from Deuteronomy reminds us of our duty of almsgiving, that we "set [our offerings] before the Lord, [our] God, [and] shall bow down in [God's] presence" (Deuteronomy 26:10). The reading from Romans refers us to our prayer, reminding us that "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart . . . For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved" (Romans 10:8, 13). These are comforting words and encourage us to ask God for what we need and to aid us in our prayer.

Finally, the Gospel of Luke shows us a fasting Jesus, who was tempted as we are, and who knows what it means to be human. Someone once said that temptation arises when you're tired and weary, and the devil comes along and makes a perfectly reasonable suggestion. Jesus shows us that, with his help, we too can overcome our temptations, reasonable as they may sound.

This week we have two Lenten Reflections. On Tuesday, March 11, Fr. Candelario will do the Reflection in Spanish and on Thursday, March 13, Fr. Huong will do the Reflection in English. Both will begin at 7pm in the Church. This is a way to start Lent, so plan to attend.

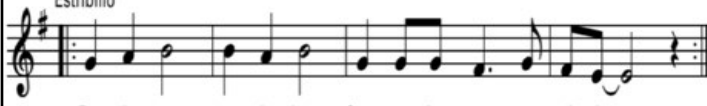

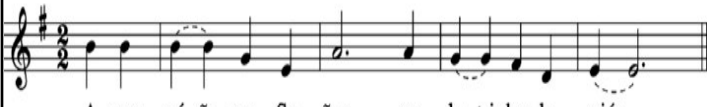

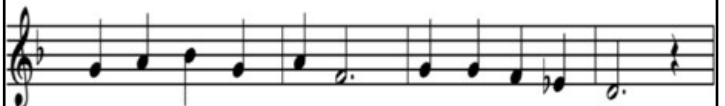

## First Sunday of Lent

### **GROW** AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

We've all seen it: the standard cartoon sketch in which the main character, faced with a decision, imagines the devil coaxing him toward evil on one shoulder while an angel encourages him toward good on the other. Lighthearted though they are, these classic scenes are the product of Biblical wisdom and millennia of human experience. In fact, the Garden of Eden provided the prototype: Eve was the first to listen to Satan in a conversation that was disastrous for her and her descendants. It is no coincidence that, in today's Gospel, Jesus finds himself in a desert – the “opposite” of a garden, so to speak – where he, too, confronts the devil. But note Jesus' response to Satan's advances: the Incarnate Word of God neither barter nor argues from human wisdom. For no amount of time does he turn over Satan's proposals in his heart. Instead, Jesus rejects the temptations immediately and relies on the power of the Word of God to put the devil in his place.

### **GO** EVANGELIZE

#### **PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT**

The Lenten season is meant to be a “desert” in which we, like Jesus, confront temptation. It is not a self-improvement program; it is an opportunity to reject sins, habits, and attitudes which keep us distant from God so that we can give a wholehearted “yes” to his plan for our lives. But the scene from today's Gospel is offered on the first Sunday of Lent to remind us that we do not go into the desert alone. Jesus entered first to show us that he would be with us every time we are tempted. If, instead of giving Satan airtime, we stay close to Jesus (in prayer and by frequenting the sacraments) and immerse ourselves in the Word of God (by reading Scripture), we, like him, will draw our strength from God. We will emerge victorious because, as St. Paul reminds us, “The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart,” and, “everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”

### **PLAN**

Have you made a Lenten plan yet? If not, the time is now! Don't be afraid to be generous with God. Remember the three pillars of Lent: prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Could you add a daily Mass or Rosary to your schedule? Could you incorporate some form of self-denial into your weekly meal plan or media consumption? Once you've worked out a plan, offer it to God and ask him to bless your efforts to grow in virtue out of love for him.

In his Papal Bull of Indiction of the Ordinary Jubilee of the Year 2025, *Spes Non Confundit* (*Hope does not disappoint*). Pope Francis says, "Let us not neglect Confession, but rediscover the beauty of this sacrament of healing and joy, the beauty of God's forgiveness of our sins!"

In Baptism, we are made holy without blemish, as our sins are wiped clean. The *Catechism of the Catholic Church, paragraph 1426, states*, "Nevertheless the new life received in Christian initiation has not abolished the frailty and weakness of human nature, nor the inclination to sin that tradition calls *concupiscence*, which remains in the baptized." This is the reason for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Jesus calls us to conversion not just once but continually. Sin is an offense against God, damaging our communion with him and weakening our communion with the Church. The Sacrament of Reconciliation liturgically accomplishes God's forgiveness and reconciliation with the Church. It is a gateway to hope!

One of the tactics of the Devil is to try to convince us that our sins are so bad that God no longer wants us. This is just one of his lies. God's love and mercy far exceed our sins. God loves each of us so much that he would rather die than risk spending eternity without us. That is love! The only sin that God will not forgive is the sin that we refuse to ask him for forgiveness. That is the sin against the Holy Spirit, refusing to seek pardon, or if there is no sorrow for a sin.

To avoid this danger, we should regularly examine our conscience (more on this soon) and go to the sacrament of Reconciliation. In doing so, we obtain from God absolution for our sins, we strengthen our bond with the Church and we are filled with God's grace to help us fulfill his will. God's love and mercy are far greater than our sins.

## Jubileo 2025 - Reconciliación, Parte 1

En su Bula de Indicación del Jubileo Ordinario del Año 2025, *Spes Non Confundit* (La esperanza no defrauda). El Papa Francisco dice: «¡No descuidemos la Confesión, sino redescubramos la belleza de este sacramento de sanación y alegría, la belleza del perdón de Dios de nuestros pecados!»

En el Bautismo, somos hechos santos sin mancha, ya que nuestros pecados son limpiados. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, párrafo 1426, afirma: «Sin embargo, la vida nueva recibida en la iniciación cristiana no ha abolido la fragilidad y debilidad de la naturaleza humana, ni la inclinación al pecado que la tradición llama concupiscencia, que permanece en los bautizados.» Esta es la razón del sacramento de la Reconciliación.

Jesús nos llama a la conversión no una sola vez, sino continuamente. El pecado es una ofensa a Dios, daña nuestra comunión con Él y debilita nuestra comunión con la Iglesia. El sacramento de la Reconciliación realiza litúrgicamente el perdón de Dios y la reconciliación con la Iglesia. Es una puerta a la esperanza.

Una de las tácticas del Diablo es intentar convencernos de que nuestros pecados son tan graves que Dios ya no nos quiere. Esta es sólo una de sus mentiras. El amor y la misericordia de Dios superan ampliamente nuestros pecados. Dios nos ama tanto a cada uno de nosotros que preferiría morir antes que arriesgarse a pasar la eternidad sin nosotros. ¡Eso es amor! El único pecado que Dios no perdonará es el pecado por el que nos negamos a pedirle perdón. Ese es el pecado contra el Espíritu Santo, negarse a buscar el perdón, o si no hay dolor por un pecado.

Para evitar este peligro, debemos hacer regularmente examen de conciencia (próximamente hablaremos de ello) y acudir al sacramento de la Reconciliación. Al hacerlo, obtenemos de Dios la absolución de nuestros pecados, reforzamos nuestro vínculo con la Iglesia y nos llenamos de la gracia de Dios para que nos ayude a cumplir su voluntad. El amor y la misericordia de Dios son mucho más grandes que nuestros pecados.

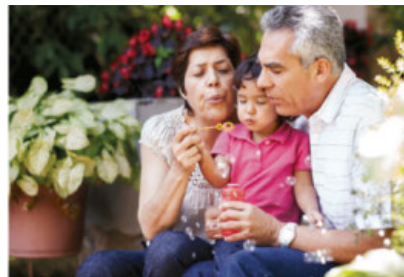

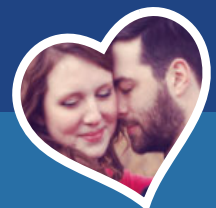
