Dear Families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Today's readings center on the suffering of God's Beloved foretold in Isaiah, given voice in the psalms, and theologized in Paul's letter to the Philippians. God the Son, coequal with the Father and worthy of all praise, chooses out of love to descend to our humanity, living, suffering, and even dying as one of us.

The arc of Palm Sunday begins with the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem in the first gospel reading, but immediately after shifts to his passion and death. This transition is abrupt, but maybe something we can find parallel to our own lives. At one moment, it's easy to recognize the grandeur of God and his care for us, and in the next, we find ourselves unable to find God's presence anywhere at all. As we experience his "crucifixion," we can take consolation in knowing how this story ends—with the resurrection of Jesus on the third day.

This is a busy week for all Catholics. We have the Holy Week schedule on page 9. Please take your bulletin home this week to refer to for all our services during Holy Week.

El arco del Domingo de Palmas comienza con la entrada triunfal de Jesús en Jerusalén en la primera lectura del evangelio, pero inmediatamente después se traslada a su pasión y muerte. Esta transición es abrupta, pero quizá algo que podamos encontrar en paralelo con nuestras propias vidas. En un momento, es fácil reconocer la grandeza de Dios y su cuidado por nosotros, y al siguiente, nos encontramos incapaces de encontrar la presencia de Dios en ningún lugar. Mientras experimentamos su "crucifixión", podemos consolarnos en saber cómo termina esta historia: con la resurrección de Jesús al tercer día.



# Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

Mt 21:1-11 | Is 50:4-7 | Phil 2:6-11 | Mt 26:14—27:66

## GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Pay attention to the prominence of Scripture in today's Mass. At Masses where there's a Procession or the Solemn Entrance, we'll hear the Gospel reading proclaiming Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. During our regular Liturgy of the Word, we'll also read through the lengthy account of Christ's passion (this year, from the Gospel of Matthew). Following the reading of the passion a brief homily may be given, but there may also be a period of silence rather than a homily. In so many ways, it seems that beginning with Palm Sunday (and all throughout Holy Week), the Church is inviting us to feast on God's Word in a deeper way than perhaps at any other time in the liturgical year. As disciples, our whole Christian life must be nourished not only by the sacraments, but by the Word of God. As Lent comes to a close, we can think back to our Gospel of the First Sunday of Lent, where Jesus tells us that "One does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes forth from the mouth of God." (Mt 4:4) The events we hear about during this time are the climactic moments in the unfolding plan of our salvation. By reading the Gospel accounts, we're invited to *participate* in them through this liturgy which makes them present to us, here and now.

## GO EVANGELIZE

### PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Paul's Letter to the Philippians speaks of Jesus' self-emptying love. Although he was God, Jesus took on our humanity and offered his life in humble obedience to the Father, accepting, willfully, even death on a cross. When we consider our efforts to lead others to know the Lord, we're invited to adopt his own way of reaching out to humanity. Do we enter into the lived experience of those we seek to evangelize? In what ways do we empty (humble) ourselves in order to draw near to them? Are we willing to set aside our plans, our agenda, our way of doing things, and willingly accept God's way of doing things? Following the example of our Lord, our own efforts at evangelization should be marked by humility and self-emptying love.

## STUDY

One of the best ways we can participate in the celebration of these sacred days is to spend time reading the Scriptures for each day of Holy Week. Read the text, then sit in silence, allowing the words to wash over you. What moments or lines stand out to you? 



# Sharing Divine Mercy Compartiendo la Divina Misericordia

## Mercy Moments in Scripture Momentos de Misericordia en las Escrituras



### Mercy Moment #129

Divine Mercy Defined: John 19:33-34

One of the most powerful symbols of mercy in Scripture is the flow of blood and water from the pierced side of Christ on the Cross, which are depicted by the red and white rays in the Divine Mercy image. As St. John Paul II says, "Coming from this Heart that was overflowing with generous love, [were] two rays of light which illuminated the world... Through the mystery of this wounded heart, the restorative tide of God's merciful love continues to spread over the men and women of our time. Here alone can those who long for true and lasting happiness find its secret."

John Paul II explains that this image invites everyone to draw near to the merciful heart of Jesus: "Anyone can come here, look at this image of the merciful Jesus, His Heart radiating grace, and hear in the depths of his own soul what St. Faustina heard: Fear nothing, I am with you always.' And if this person responds with a sincere heart 'Jesus, I trust in You, he will find comfort in all his anxieties and fears."

### Momento de Misericordia #129

Divina Misericordia Definido: Juan 19:33-34

Uno de los más poderosos símbolos de la misericordia en la Sagrada Escritura es el flujo de sangre y agua del costado de Cristo en la Cruz, el cual está representado por los rayos rojo y blanco en la imagen de la Divina Misericordia. Como San Juan Pablo II dice: "Viniendo de este Corazón que estaba desbordado de amor, estaban dos rayos de luz los cuales iluminaban al mundo... a través del misterio de este corazón herido, la restauradora marea de amor misericordioso de Dios continúa propagándose sobre hombres y mujeres de nuestro tiempo. Juan Pablo II explica que esta imagen invita a todos a acercarse al corazón misericordioso de Jesús: "Cualquiera puede venir aquí, mirar esta imagen de Jesús misericordioso, Su Corazón radiante de gracia, y oír en las profundidades de su alma lo que Santa Faustina oyó: "No tengas miedo, yo estoy contigo siempre". Y si esta persona responde con un corazón sincero "Jesús, en ti confío, él encontrará consuelo de todas sus ansiedades y miedos".

O Jesus, be mindful of Your own bitter Passion and do not permit the loss of souls redeemed at so dear a price of Your most precious Blood. O Jesus, when I consider the great price of Your Blood, I rejoice at its immensity, for one drop alone would have been enough for the salvation of all sinners. Although sin is an abyss of wickedness and ingratitude, the price paid for us can never be equaled. Therefore, let every soul trust in the Passion of the Lord, and place its hope in His mercy. God will not deny His mercy to anyone. Heaven and earth may change, but God's mercy will never be exhausted. Oh, what immense joy burns in my heart when I contemplate Your incomprehensible goodness, O Jesus! I desire to bring all sinners to Your feet that they may glorify Your mercy throughout endless ages.


