Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

When a loved one dies, the world seems at first completely out of kilter. Daily rhythms are disrupted. Relationships shift. Things that seemed important before take a back seat, while other urgent concerns come to the fore. A whole reorientation to life without the physical presence of the loved one is necessary. In the gospel, we catch a glimpse of how the first disciples of Jesus navigated the difficult days in the aftermath of his death, how they had to construct their lives and meaning anew.

One of the key messages of the Gospel of John, from which the gospel of Easter Sunday comes is that the resurrection is not simply a "happily-ever-after" ending or the fulfillment of our expectations. It turns the world on end and defies explanation. It is God's final parable.

John's Gospel drives home the central question. Where is Jesus now? A single character, Mary Magdalene, represents the voice of the community, as she seeks her beloved and laments. "We don't know where they put him" (20:2). Her search echoes that of the lover in the Song of Song: "I sought him whom my soul loves; I sought him but found not" (Song 3:1). The question, "Where?" permeates the whole of John's Gospel. The first followers want to know, "Where are you staying?" (1:38). And in his final address to his disciples, Jesus speaks to them about an eternal dwelling place, which is not a geographical space but his very self (15:4-10).

Fr. Quang, Fr. Candelario and the staff, would like to wish all the parishioners and their families a Blessed and Happy Easter.

Queridas familias del Corazón Inmaculado de María,

Cuando muere un ser querido, al principio el mundo parece completamente fuera de quicio. Los ritmos cotidianos se alteran. Las relaciones cambian. Las cosas que antes parecían importantes pasan a un segundo plano, mientras que otras preocupaciones urgentes pasan a un primer plano. Es necesaria toda una reorientación a la vida sin la presencia física del ser querido. En el Evangelio, vislumbramos cómo los primeros discípulos de Jesús atravesaron los días difíciles que siguieron a su muerte, cómo tuvieron que reconstruir su vida y su sentido.

Uno de los mensajes clave del Evangelio de Juan, del que procede el Evangelio del Domingo de Resurrección, es que la resurrección no es simplemente un final "feliz para siempre" o el cumplimiento de unas expectativas. Pone el mundo patas arriba y desafía toda explicación. Es la parábola final de Dios.

El Evangelio de Juan plantea la pregunta central. ¿Dónde está Jesús ahora? Un único personaje, María Magdalena, representa la voz de la comunidad, mientras busca a su amado y se lamenta. No sabemos dónde lo han puesto" (202). Su búsqueda se hace eco de la de la amante en el Cantar de los Cantares: "Lo busqué, pero no lo hallé" (Cantar 3,1). La pregunta "¿Dónde?" impregna todo el Evangelio de Juan. Los primeros seguidores quieren saber: "¿Dónde te quedas?" (1:38). Y en su último discurso a sus discípulos, Jesús les habla de una morada eterna, que no es un espacio geográfico, sino su propio ser (15:4-10).

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Wishing you a blessed Easter! One of our commitments in growing as disciples of Jesus, especially at the beginning of this most important season of Easter, is to *study* Scripture. John's Gospel today depicts the story of the empty tomb - the reactions of Mary of Magdala and the two disciples trying to make sense of what they had seen. What we may have missed, however, are the words of St. Peter in the first reading from Acts speaking of Jesus: "This man God raised on the third day and granted that he be visible, *not to all the people, but to us, the witnesses chosen by God in advance, who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead.*" Jesus appeared post-resurrection to those to whom he was closest - the witnesses chosen by God whom he had commissioned to preach the Gospel to all people, so all might believe in him. In this way the chosen few, Christ's heralds, would bring the Good News of his resurrection to the many. So we too, now, are witnesses, chosen by God in our baptism and come to this table of thanksgiving and sacrifice. By faith we grow as his disciples, ready to go forth to lead others to him.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

As we know, these first disciples of Christ went on mission throughout the known world to preach to the Jews as well as the Gentiles. Their task was not easy; all endured opposition and hardship; many were martyred. But gone was the fear they may have felt at the crucifixion; by the power of the Holy Spirit these early missionaries were full of courage and commitment, and were driven to proclaim the risen Jesus to all. What does this have to do with us today? By virtue of our baptism, we also are chosen by God to be his witnesses in the world. We are called to "preach the Gospel" with how we live our lives. When we trust in the promises of Christ and know the peace that only he can bring, it gives us the strength to testify to friends, family and others that God loves us and has redeemed us. Good News indeed.

GROW & GO Christ is risen, Alleluia! The Resurrection means that nothing can separate us from God's love and presence with us. Spend time this week in prayer contemplating these two truths: The purpose of our lives is to continually GROW in intimate relationship with God; and Jesus' final command to his disciples and us is to "GO and make disciples of all nations." (Mt 28:19)



HE IS RISEN

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) website says about Easter, "The Easter Vigil is the 'Mother of All Vigils' and Easter Sunday is the greatest of all Sundays." We are now in the Season of Easter!

Easter is celebrated for more than just one day! The first eight days are called the Octave of Easter, which ends on Divine Mercy Sunday. The joyous celebrations of Easter Sunday are prolonged for the entire octave. Each day's liturgical readings and actions mimic what happened on Easter Sunday. In the early Church, the newly baptized would wear their baptismal gowns during the octave. Saying "Happy Easter" is appropriate each day during the Octave.

The Easter season lasts 50 days, from Easter Sunday to Pentecost (which comes from the Greek word for fiftieth). The Paschal Candle, first used during the Easter Vigil, symbolizes the risen Christ's divine light. It is kept near the ambo throughout Easter and lit for all liturgical celebrations.

Alleluia returns to the liturgy as well. It comes from two Hebrew words and means praise God.

It is only fitting that the Church celebrates Jesus' Resurrection for more than one day. Happy Easter! Alleluia! Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us!

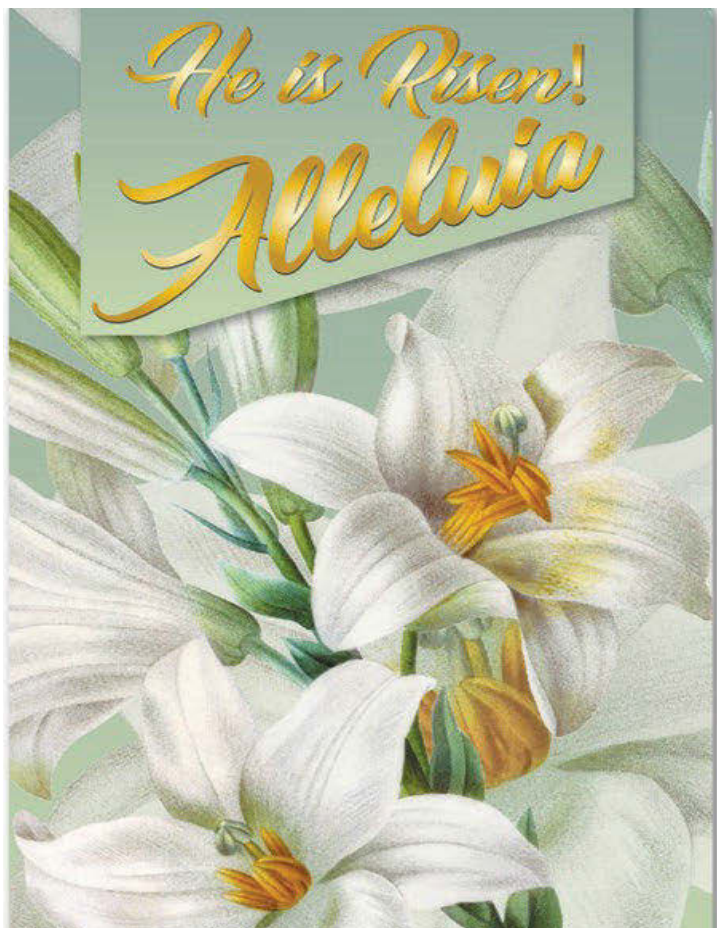
HA RESUCITADO

El sitio web de la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de Estados Unidos (USCCB) dice sobre la Pascua: "La Vigilia Pascual es la 'Madre de todas las Vigilias' y el Domingo de Pascua es el más grande de todos los domingos". ¡Ya estamos en el Tiempo de Pascua!

La Pascua se celebra durante más de un día. Los primeros ocho días se llaman la Octava de Pascua, que termina el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. Las alegres celebraciones del Domingo de Pascua se prolongan durante toda la octava. Las lecturas litúrgicas y las acciones de cada día imitan lo que sucedió el Domingo de Pascua. En la Iglesia primitiva, los recién bautizados vestían sus trajes de bautismo durante la octava. Decir "Feliz Pascua" es apropiado cada día durante la Octava.

El tiempo pascual dura 50 días, desde el Domingo de Resurrección hasta Pentecostés (palabra griega que significa quincuagésimo). El cirio pascual, que se utiliza por primera vez en la Vigilia Pascual, simboliza la luz divina de Cristo resucitado. Se mantiene cerca del ambón durante toda la Pascua y se enciende en todas las celebraciones litúrgicas. El aleluya vuelve también a la liturgia. Procede de dos palabras hebreas y significa alabar a Dios.

Es justo que la Iglesia celebre la Resurrección de Jesús durante más de un día. ¡Feliz Pascua! ¡Aleluya! ¡Inmaculado Corazón de María, ruega por nosotros!

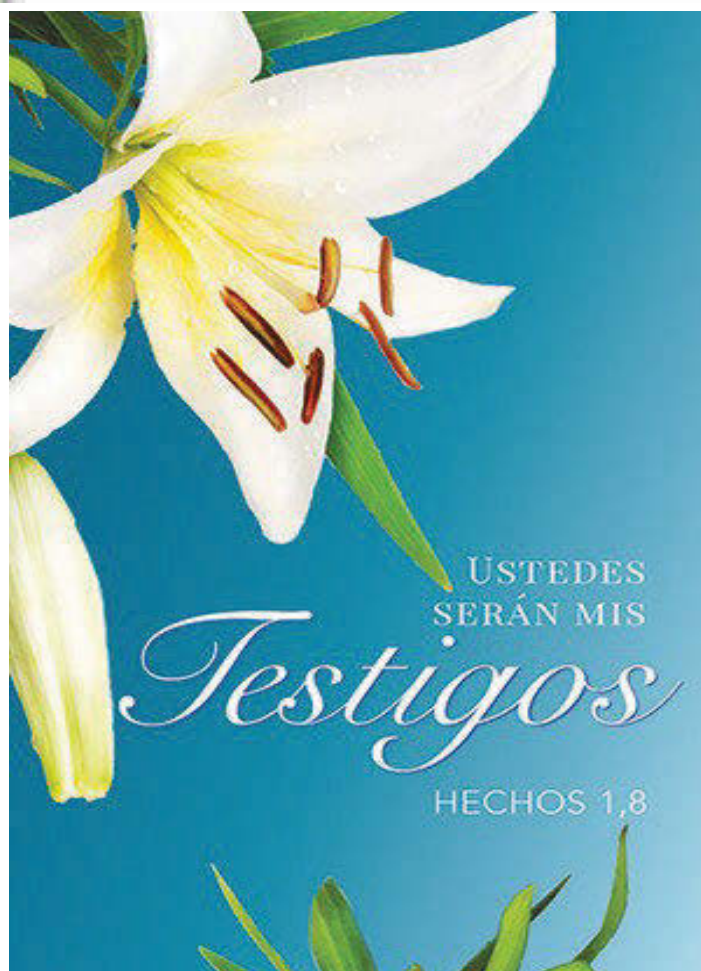

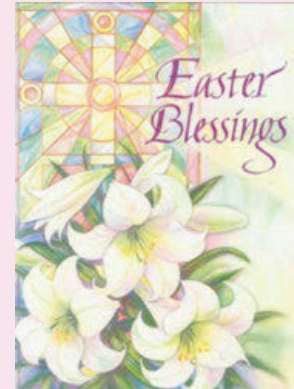

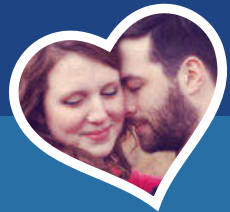
