Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

In today's gospel, Jesus speaks of the Father as a vintner who prunes branches that are bearing fruit so that they will produce even more. There is a strong emphasis on bearing fruit, the expression "bear fruit" occurs five times in the passage. It speaks not only of the fecundity in our relationship with God but also of missionary outreach and of interdependence with the other branches in the vine.

The image of God as a vine grower and Israel as the vineyard is a familiar one in the Scriptures (e.g., Isa 5:1-7; 27:2-5; Jer 2:21; Ps 80:8-18). Most often the metaphor is used to express God's disappointment in the lack of yield from the vine so tenderly planted and nurtured. In the Gospel of John, this is not the case. The disciples Jesus is addressing in the Last Supper scene (15:3) are already pruned, so that they will be more fruitful. Branches that do not bear fruit are taken away.

How can we ensure that we are abiding in Christ, and he is in us? In the second reading, 1 John 3:24 gives a simple formula: "Those who keep his commandments remain in him and he in them, and the way we know that he remains in us is from the Spirit that he gave us." The writer also spells out what it means to keep the commandments, "we should believe in the name... Jesus Christ and love one another just as he commanded us" (1 John 3:23).

Queridas familias del Inmaculado Corazón de María,

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús habla del Padre como de un viñador que poda los sarmientos que dan fruto para que produzcan aún más. La expresión "dar fruto" aparece cinco veces en el pasaje. Habla no sólo de la fecundidad en nuestra relación con Dios, sino también de la proyección misionera y de la interdependencia con los demás sarmientos de la vid.

La imagen de Dios como viñador y de Israel como viña es familiar en las Escrituras (p. ej., Is 5,1-7; 27,2-5; Jer 2,21; Sal 80,8-18). La mayoría de las veces, la metáfora se utiliza para expresar a Dios desde la vid tan tiernamente plantada y cuidada. En el Evangelio de Juan, no es éste el caso. Los discípulos a los que Jesús se dirige en la escena de la Última Cena (15:3) ya están podados para que den más fruto. Las ramas que no dan fruto se quitan.

¿Cómo podemos asegurarnos de que permanecemos en Cristo y él está en nosotros? En la segunda lectura, 1 Juan 3,24 nos da una fórmula sencilla: "Los que guardan sus mandamientos permanecen en él y él en ellos, y sabemos que él permanece en nosotros por el Espíritu que nos ha dado". El escritor explica también lo que significa guardar los mandamientos: "debemos creer en el nombre... de Jesucristo, y amarnos unos a otros como él nos mandó" (1 Jn 3,23).

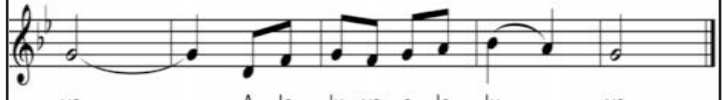

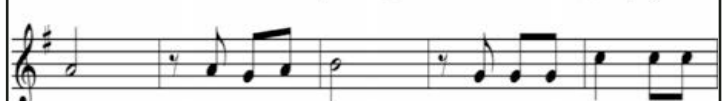

“Where do they get their energy!” Maybe you’ve said that about your children as they run around the yard while you’re trying to wrangle them inside for bedtime. Jokes abound about how sugar and caffeine are what keep most adults going, but we know it’s proper nutrition, exercise, and rest that enable us to do well whatever it is we do. That is all relevant to us physically. What about spiritually? Bishop Barron, writing on the Gospel, says, “Jesus declares that he is the vine and we are the branches. He is the power and energy source in which we live.” (*Word on Fire Bible*, 548) Just as we see the effects of sugar and caffeine on people, we see the supernatural effects of Jesus’ love on, and in, people. As he nurtures us with his perfect love, and that flows into us who are grafted onto him, it changes us. It transforms us and converts us away from sin and toward God. We fill up on that spiritual fuel in the sacramental life of the Church and become a witness to it in how we go about our days – loving one another.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

“Children, let us love not in word or speech but in deed and truth.” These words from John in our second reading provide the perfect bridge between the ministry of Paul, about whom we heard in the first reading, and Christ’s message in the Gospel. With Jesus as “the power and energy source in which we live,” we not only can profess the truth, but live it. We not only give our own account of Christ working in us, as Paul did, who came to them speaking out “boldly in the name of the Lord,” but we stand beside one another, as Barnabas did, vouching for Paul to the Apostles. We are united in baptism, in love, in profession of faith, and in communion with one another. When we consistently act in a Christian manner toward others and keep God’s commandments, John says, we “remain in him, and he in [us], and the way we know that he remains in us is from the Spirit he gave us.” In other words, those who remain in Christ “will bear much fruit” – a tangible sign that easily answers the question, “where does he/she get her energy?”

PRAY Is there anything in your life that is an obstacle to Jesus being the power and energy source in which you live? Are your days fueled more by anger, frustration, or ambition than his love? Pray this week in thanksgiving to God for where he has given you conversion of heart, and ask him for the grace to see where improvement is needed and the will to make it happen.

St. Catherine of Sienna – April 29

St. Catherine, born in 1347 in Sienna, Italy, was one of twenty-five siblings. From a young age, she embraced an austere life, dedicating herself to Christ at seven. By sixteen, she had become a Lay Dominican, choosing to live in a small room in her parents' house. During this time, she developed a profound relationship with Jesus and began to receive mystical experiences. After three years of mostly living cloistered in her room, she rejoined her family, dedicating herself to serving the sick and the poor and working tirelessly for the conversion of sinners. Her devotion to Christ and her selfless service to others serves as a powerful example for all.

In 1370, St. Catherine, in another mystical vision, heard a divine command that would change the course of her life. She was called to leave her cell in her parents' house and enter public life. With the help of others, as Catherine was illiterate, she began corresponding with people in every state of life, including princes, papal legates, and even Pope Gregory XI. At the time, the pope was exiled to Avignon, France, and St. Catherine passionately urged him back to Rome. Later, Pope Gregory sent her to try and negotiate peace with the Florentine Republic. She dictated her spiritual treatise, *The Dialogue of Divine Providence*, during this time.

St. Catherine's earthly journey came to an end on April 29, 1380, at the age of 33. Her funeral was celebrated by Pope Urban VI, a testament to the respect and admiration she had garnered. Devotion to her spread rapidly after her death, a clear indication of the profound impact she had on people's lives. Pope Pius II canonized her in 1461, recognizing her as a saint of the Catholic Church. Her influence continued to grow, and she was declared the patron saint of Rome in 1866 and of Italy along with St. Francis of Assisi in 1939 by Pope Pius XI. Pope Paul VI elevated her status further by declaring her a Doctor of the Church in 1970. In 1999, St. Pope John Paul II declared her Patron Saint of Europe, a testament to her universal appeal and relevance.

Santa Catalina de Siena - 29 de abril

Santa Catalina, nacida en 1347 en Siena (Italia), era una de veinticinco hermanos. Desde muy joven adoptó una vida austera, dedicándose a Cristo a los siete años. A los dieciséis, se hizo laica dominica y eligió vivir en una pequeña habitación de la casa de sus padres. Durante este tiempo, desarrolló una profunda relación con Jesús y comenzó a recibir experiencias místicas. Después de tres años de vida enclaustrada en su habitación, se reunió con su familia, dedicándose al servicio de los enfermos y los pobres y trabajando incansablemente por la conversión de los pecadores. Su devoción a Cristo y su servicio desinteresado a los demás son un poderoso ejemplo para todos.

En 1370, Santa Catalina, en otra visión mística, escuchó una orden divina que cambiaría el curso de su vida. Fue llamada a abandonar su celda en casa de sus padres y entrar en la vida pública. Con la ayuda de otros, ya que Catalina era analfabeta, comenzó a mantener correspondencia con personas de toda condición, incluyendo príncipes, legados papales e incluso el Papa Gregorio XI. Por aquel entonces, el Papa estaba exiliado en Aviñón, Francia, y Santa Catalina le instó apasionadamente a que regresara a Roma. Más tarde, el Papa Gregorio la envió a intentar negociar la paz con la República Florentina. Durante este tiempo dictó su tratado espiritual, *El Diálogo de la Divina Providencia*.

El viaje terrenal de Santa Catalina llegó a su fin el 29 de abril de 1380, a la edad de 33 años. Su funeral fue celebrado por el Papa Urbano VI, testimonio del respeto y la admiración que había suscitado. Su devoción se extendió rápidamente tras su muerte, lo que demuestra el profundo impacto que tuvo en la vida de la gente. El Papa Pío II la canonizó en 1461, reconociéndola como santa de la Iglesia Católica. Su influencia no dejó de crecer y en 1866 fue declarada patrona de Roma y en 1939, junto con San Francisco de Asís, patrona de Italia por el Papa Pío XI. El Papa Pablo VI elevó aún más su estatus al declararla Doctora de la Iglesia en 1970. En 1999, el Papa Juan Pablo II la declaró Patrona de Europa, testimonio de su atractivo y relevancia universales.

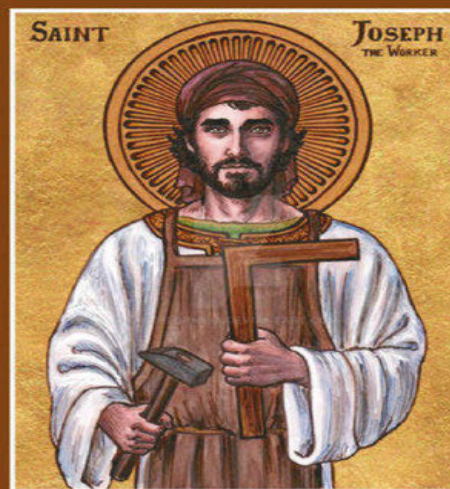

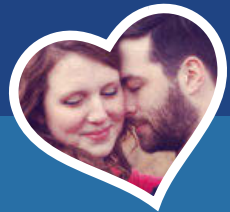
