Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

The reading from Acts is set in the Upper Room, where the disciples are gathered between the ascension and Pentecost. About 120 people are there (1:15) a symbol for the full number of disciples. In the preceding verse, Luke lists as present the Twelve along with the women, presumably Mary Magdalene, Joanna, Susanna, and the many others (Luke 8:1-3) who came up to Jerusalem and witnessed the crucifixion (Luke 23:49 saw Jesus laid in the tomb (Luke 23:55-56) and discovered it empty (Luke 24:1-9). Jesus' mother and his family are also there.

Today's gospel gives us the special chance to listen to Jesus' prayer to God. He asks his Holy Father to make the people one, to protect us and allow us to share in the joy of the good News. Jesus exclaims, "Consecrate them in the truth." Jesus prays for our good. He prays for our growth. In what ways might Jesus' prayer influence your own prayers during this last week of the Easter season?

We have had 176 children receive their First Communion on the last two Saturdays. Please pray for them and their families that they continue to grow in their faith as they join the Community of Immaculate Heart of Mary at Mass.

También están allí la madre de Jesús y su familia.

El evangelio de hoy nos brinda la oportunidad especial de escuchar la oración de Jesús a Dios. Le pide a su Santo Padre que haga del pueblo uno, que nos proteja y nos permita compartir la alegría de la Buena Nueva. Jesús exclama: "Conságralos en la verdad". Jesús reza por nuestro bien. Reza por nuestro crecimiento. ¿De qué manera podría influir la oración de Jesús en tus propias oraciones durante esta última semana del tiempo pascual?

## Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord

Acts 1:1-11 | Eph 1:17-23 | Mk 16:15-20

### **GROW** AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

It's easy for me to get impatient with the Lord – to wonder why he makes me wait for an answer to a prayer or, worse, why his answer may be no. However, when I look back at the lessons of the Bible, it becomes clear that God works on his timetable, not mine. That same message comes through in today's first reading. The apostles ask Jesus whether he will be restoring the kingdom to Israel, and he is clear in his answer: "It is not for you to know the times or seasons that the Father has established by his own authority." And then, after saying this, he ascends to the Father. Forty days after his resurrection, Jesus has left his disciples again. But instead of leaving them to weep and mourn – as happened after his death – this time, our Lord left them with a mission. They were to "Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature." They did, faithfully, and they traveled far and wide. Armed with the gift of the Holy Spirit which they received at Pentecost, they baptized countless people as they shared the Good News about Jesus and his gift of salvation.

### **GO** EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

After Jesus gives the disciples the command to go out and preach the Gospel, he says that "whoever believes and is baptized will be saved." He offers salvation for those who believe in him. And he says that the disciples, and us, will be his witnesses in the world. Sacred tradition tells us that Andrew and Philip preached in Asia Minor while Bartholomew and Thomas spent time in India. Others are said to have gone to Palestine, Persia, and Ethiopia. All died a martyr's death – except John who had been entrusted with the care of our Blessed Mother. We are his witnesses today, and we are also commissioned to go into the world and proclaim the Gospel. Today, as we celebrate his ascension into heaven, let us allow ourselves a moment to gaze upward and behold Jesus' power and glory. Let the Ascension renew our commitment to do the work he has asked us to do, and remind us of his presence here with us in all that we do.

**PRAY** We know the mission Jesus has given us and we know we have the Holy Spirit to help us carry it out. For prayer this week, meditate on Paul's words to the Ephesians and ask the Lord for "a Spirit of wisdom and revelation resulting in knowledge of him. May the eyes of [our] hearts be enlightened, that [we] may know what is the hope that belongs to his call."





## Our Lady of Fatima – May 13

Our Lady of Fatima is a Marian apparition experienced by three children, Lucia dos Santos, Jacinta Marto, and Francisco Marto, beginning on May 13, 1917, in Fatima, Portugal. Before Our Lady appeared to the three, an angel appeared to Lucia and three of her friends and later to Lucia, Jacinta, and Francisco. He asked them to pray, "My God, I believe, I adore, I hope, and I love Thee! I beg pardon for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope, and do not love Thee!"

Our Lady, clothed in radiant white, appeared to the three children, requesting their return to the same spot on the thirteenth day of the following six months. She posed a profound question that resonates with us all: would they offer themselves to God, willing to endure suffering as an act of reparation for sins committed against Him, and pray for the conversion of

sinners? With unwavering faith, Lucia responded on behalf of all, "Yes." Our Lady then entrusted each of them with the task of daily rosary, a plea for world peace, and the war's end.

Lucia shared the visions with her mother, and soon, the entire village was privy to this sacred knowledge. However, the children were met with scorn and disbelief. Undeterred by the skepticism, they returned to the site on the thirteenth of the following months, continuing to receive visions and instructions for prayer. This persistence in the face of doubt is a testament to the strength of their faith.

On October 13, 1917, the last month of the visions, tens of thousands gathered with the children. Our Lady identified herself as the Lady of the Rosary and asked for a chapel to be built in Her honor on the site. What became known as the Miracle of the Sun followed. Many witnessed the sun reflecting many colors and dancing, whirling, and spinning around the sky!

Our Lady of the Rosary, pray for us! Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us!

## Nuestra Señora de Fátima - 13 de mayo

Nuestra Señora de Fátima es una aparición mariana experimentada por tres niños, Lucía dos Santos, Jacinta Marto y Francisco Marto, a partir del 13 de mayo de 1917, en Fátima, Portugal. Antes de que Nuestra Señora se apareciera a los tres, un ángel se apareció a Lucía y a tres de sus amigas y más tarde a Lucía, Jacinta y Francisco. Les pidió que rezaran: "¡Dios mío, yo creo, adoro, espero y te amo! Te pido perdón por los que no creen, no adoran, no esperan y no te aman".

La Virgen, vestida de blanco radiante, se apareció a los tres niños, pidiéndoles que volvieran al mismo lugar el día trece de los seis meses siguientes. Ella les planteó una pregunta profunda que resuena en todos nosotros: ¿se ofrecerían a Dios, dispuestos a soportar el sufrimiento como acto de reparación por los pecados cometidos contra Él, y a rezar por la conversión de los pecadores? Con fe inquebrantable, Lucía respondió en nombre de todos: "Sí". La Virgen encomendó entonces a cada una de ellas la tarea del rosario diario, una súplica por la paz del mundo y el fin de la guerra.

Lucía compartió las visiones con su madre, y pronto, todo el pueblo tuvo conocimiento de este sagrado conocimiento. In embargo, los niños fueron recibidos con desprecio e incredulidad. Sin dejarse intimidar por el escepticismo, volvieron al lugar el día trece de los meses siguientes, y siguieron recibiendo visiones e instrucciones para la oración. Esta persistencia ante la duda es un testimonio de la fuerza de su fe.

El 13 de octubre de 1917, último mes de las visiones, decenas de miles de personas se reunieron con los niños. La Virgen se identificó como la Señora del Rosario y pidió que se construyera en el lugar una capilla en su honor. Lo que se conoce como el Milagro del Sol. Muchos fueron testigos de cómo el sol reflejaba muchos colores y bailaba, giraba y daba vueltas alrededor del cielo.

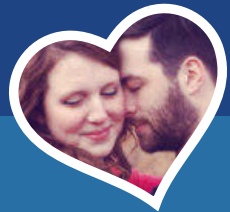
