Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Paul's back! After last week's "violent abuse," opponents organized a lynch mob that beat Paul nearly to death. But call Paul the "energizing evangelist," transforming deadly cruelty into life-giving zeal. Paul's past courage should inspire our commitment; Revelation's future "new heaven, new earth" should inspire our optimism. But Revelation's present assurance, "Behold, God's dwelling is with the human race," should challenge us to become "missionaries of mercy."

Pope Francis declared that the Church's credibility is completely dependent on our showing unconditional mercy. Mercy, said Francis, makes the Church, the world, and everyone young again, reawakened to life's noblest virtues. Fittingly, in today's Gospel Jesus reinforces that theme: "This is how all will know you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

What does love for one another truly mean? Do we treat others respectfully, with compassion, with understanding? Are we open to newcomers, other backgrounds, different ideas and customs? How many times do we look at others and make unkind comments or do not accept them? These are hard questions to ask ourselves.

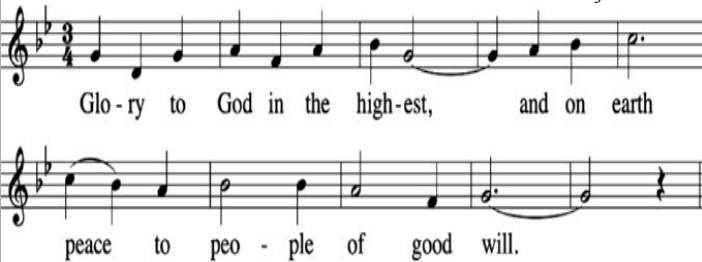

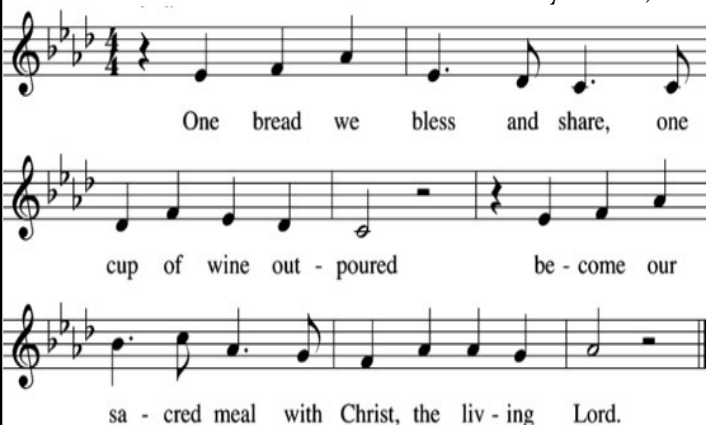

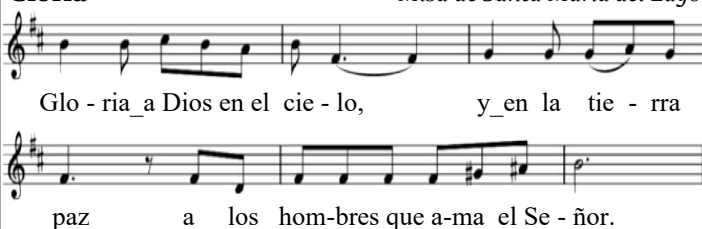

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Today's Gospel occurs shortly before Jesus gives his Last Supper Discourses in the Gospel of John. Judas has betrayed Jesus, and now the Lord speaks to his inner circle for one of the last times before his arrest. "I will be with you only a little while longer," he says. At these words, I imagine a hush falling over the group. Rattled by Judas' strange actions and alarmed by the Lord announcing his impending departure, the disciples' eyes must have darted about as they held their breath, awaiting Jesus' words. "I give you a new commandment," he says. "Love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another." In a word, Jesus summarizes his teaching: love as God loves. He is using these last moments to exhort his disciples to be as he is. We know it won't be easy – it will involve sacrifice and suffering – but the Holy Spirit is present with us to guide and advocate for us on our journey.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Have you ever experienced a season of suffering and wondered, "Have I done something wrong?" When we meet resistance on the narrow path, it can make us question our choices, ourselves, and sometimes even God. Let today's first reading be a boost of confidence on your journey; remember that your suffering does not imply a misstep. "It is necessary for us to undergo many hardships to enter the kingdom of God," Paul and Barnabas exhort the disciples (and us). It is natural to grow fatigued, especially when we encounter hardships. This is one reason why the Lord desires that we never journey alone. By God's perfect design, humans require companionship, from other humans and from the Creator himself. In the reading from the Book of Revelation, John the Apostle hears a loud voice saying, "God himself will always be with them as their God." Though the road may be peppered with pain, and the trials overwhelming, may we never forget that our God is very near!

PRAY

Today's readings reveal themes of perseverance in faith, radical love, and the stunning reality that the Lord is *truly present* to us. As we pray with these Scriptures, consider asking yourself: *What areas of my life feel distant from the Lord's presence? How can I open these areas up to receive his light and his love?* Take time to talk to the Lord in prayer about these things. When you do, make sure you leave space and silence for him to speak.

Jubilee 2025 – Confraternities

Throughout the year of the Jubilee 2025, the Church celebrates different groups, dioceses, and events. For example, in February, there was the Jubilee for Armed Forces, Police, and Security, and later in the month, the Jubilee of Deacons. This month, one of the Jubilees is the Jubilee of Confraternities, celebrated May 16-18.

What are Confraternities? They are Christian voluntary associations of laypeople, established by competent ecclesial authorities, to promote special works of Christian charity or piety. Some examples are the Confraternity of Penitents, the Confraternity of the Holy Guardian Angels, and the Rosary Confraternity, which we will look at closely. Each confraternity has its own set of rules or bylaws that members promise to live by. These are not religious vows but rules set up to govern the confraternity.

Many Immaculate Heart of Mary parishioners pray the Rosary, so let us take a closer look at a Confraternity that may interest you, the Rosary Confraternity. It was established over 500 years ago. Members strive to pray the entire Rosary (15 decades) each week. (This requirement was established long before the Luminous Mysteries were added.) Pope Leo XIII stated in his apostolic constitution on the Confraternity, "Whenever a person fulfills his obligation of reciting the Rosary according to the rule of the Confraternity, he includes in his intentions all its members, and they in turn render him the same service many times over." So, as a member of the Rosary Confraternity, every time you pray a Rosary, you are praying for the intentions of all the other members, and all of them are praying for your intentions.

The benefits of being a member of the Rosary Confraternity are: the special protection of the Mother of God, a share in the prayer of the many members throughout the world, even after death, a share in the Masses and apostolic works of the entire Order of Preachers, and the intercession of the heavenly court, various plenary and partial indulgences.

The Rosary Confraternity is an apostolate of the Western Dominican Province in Portland, Oregon. To enroll in the Rosary Confraternity, go to rosarycenter.org and click "enroll."

Jubileo 2025 – Confraternidades

A lo largo del año del Jubileo 2025, la Iglesia celebra diferentes grupos, diócesis y eventos. Por ejemplo, en febrero se celebró el Jubileo de las Fuerzas Armadas, la Policía y la Seguridad y, más adelante, el Jubileo de los Diáconos. Este mes, uno de los Jubileos es el de las Cofradías, que se celebra del 16 al 18 de mayo.

¿Qué son las Confraternidades? Son asociaciones cristianas voluntarias de seglares, erigidas por las autoridades eclesiales competentes, para promover obras especiales de caridad o piedad cristiana. Algunos ejemplos son la Confraternidad de Penitentes, la Confraternidad de los Santos Angeles Custodios y la Confraternidad del Rosario, que estudiaremos detenidamente. El Papa León XIII declaró en su constitución apostólica sobre la Confraternidad, «Siempre que una persona cumple con su obligación de rezar el Rosario según la regla de la Confraternidad, incluye en sus intenciones a todos sus miembros, y ellos a su vez le prestan el mismo servicio muchas veces.» Así pues, como miembro de la Confraternidad del Rosario, cada vez que rezas un Rosario, estás rezando por las intenciones de todos los demás miembros, y todos ellos están rezando por tus intenciones.

Los beneficios de ser miembro de la Confraternidad del Rosario son: la protección especial de la Madre de Dios, la participación en la oración de los numerosos miembros en todo el mundo, incluso después de la muerte, la participación en las misas y trabajos apostólicos de toda la Orden de Predicadores, y la intercesión de la corte celestial, varias indulgencias plenas y parciales.
