Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

A few years ago, during Rome's quiet summer, Pope Francis took a day off to visit privately with some old friends, whose identity took Catholic Italy by surprise: Evangelical Protestants. They welcomed Francis to their Pentecostal Church of Reconciliation, where Francis asked pardon for Catholic persecutions and celebrated the Holy Spirit's "Pentecostal work." Unlike Satan, declared Francis, who creates division among God's children, the Holy Spirit creates a diversity rich and beautiful. And unity; not uniformity, Francis specified, but unity in diversity. Francis named the Spirit's gift "reconciled diversity."

Pentecost's rich treasury of scriptural readings, for Saturday's vigil and Sunday's morning liturgy, traces the Holy Spirit's work from creation's beginning, through Jesus' resurrection, into the church's earliest days, now into our days. Kindled in our hearts, the Spirit's gentle fire is ours to share generously, even with those most strikingly different from us. All hearts are Spirit-warmed by reconciled diversity.

This weekend summertime begins. Many have graduated from school and are looking forward to summer vacations. Many will start a new path in the fall from beginning college, high school, grammar school or join the work force. Let us pray for all of them as they start a new chapter in their lives.

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

In today's first reading, we join the Apostles in the Upper Room. These individuals had accompanied Jesus to his death and been witnesses to his resurrection and ascension. Can you imagine the throes of emotion accompanying each experience? Now, they gather together, perhaps discussing what to do next. They wonder where they should go, and who they should listen to, since Jesus was no longer there: "And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind." In a moment swelling with grace, tongues of fire descended upon each person present, "and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit." What might this moment have sounded like? Looked like? Felt like? The Apostles were weary and grieving, but Jesus made a promise he intended to keep — that he would send an advocate in his name to teach them everything. That same Spirit now waits to guide and empower us if we are willing to receive him.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Jesus' death left his followers grieving and disoriented. They had left everything to follow him. And now, he was gone. What would become of them? Jesus said: "I have told you this while I am with you. The Advocate, the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you." On this feast of Pentecost, Jesus' promise is fulfilled. When the Father sent down the Spirit, it was not just for a singular, grand moment in time; the Spirit came for good. In the same way the Apostles were strengthened by the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, so were we strengthened at our confirmation. We were commissioned, as were they, to live out our faith in the world. When we need strength in this mission, let us remember that the word advocate comes from the Latin word *advocatus*, which means "one who draws near." *Come, Holy Spirit, come!*

REFLECT

Read the *Veni, Sancte Spiritus* ("Come, Holy Spirit") prayer that we heard before the Gospel today. Each line, laden with powerful imagery, invites us to understand the Spirit more intimately. Reflect on where you experience the Holy Spirit in your life today, and where you long for a greater outpouring of his fire.

Pentecost

Happy birthday, Church! Pentecost completes the paschal mystery, and by His coming, "The Holy Spirit causes the world to enter into the 'last days,' the time of the Church." (CCC 732). Pentecost is the day when the Church's sacraments are inaugurated, specifically the sacrament of baptism.

Acts of the Apostles uses vivid descriptions of the coming of the Holy Spirit. "And suddenly a sound came from heaven like the rush of a mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared to them tongues as of fire, distributed and resting on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance." (Acts 2:2-4)

Pentecost derives its name from the number fifty, which is how many days after Easter it is celebrated. The Israelites also had a feast fifty days after Passover called Shavout, which is the Hebrew word for weeks. This was one of the three pilgrimage festivals. The Jews were expected to travel to the temple in Jerusalem as commanded by the Bible. During the Temple period, the focus was on agriculture, particularly the grain harvest, with a specific emphasis on wheat. The grain harvest lasted seven weeks and was referred to as the season of gladness. Barley was harvested during Passover and wheat during Shavuot. Two loaves of bread from the wheat harvest were then offered in the temple. After the destruction of the Temple in the year 70, when offerings could no longer be made there, the focus of Shavuot shifted to the giving of the Torah, or the law, as revealed by God on Mount Sinai.

After receiving the Holy Spirit, Peter boldly preaches to the crowds. In his speech he quotes a prophecy from the prophet Joel, "And in the last days it shall be, God declares that I will pour out my Spirit upon all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams." (Acts 2:17). The time of the Church in the New Covenant has begun and is indeed a new season of gladness!

Holy Spirit, strengthen us! Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us!

Pentecostés

¡Feliz cumpleaños, Iglesia! Pentecostés completa el misterio pascual y, con su venida, «el Espíritu Santo hace entrar al mundo en los "últimos días", el tiempo de la Iglesia». (CIC 732). Pentecostés es el día en que se inauguran los sacramentos de la Iglesia, concretamente el sacramento del bautismo.

Los Hechos de los Apóstoles describen vívidamente la venida del Espíritu Santo. «Y de repente vino del cielo un estruendo como de un viento impetuoso, que llenó toda la casa donde estaban sentados. Y se les aparecieron lenguas como de fuego, repartidas y posadas sobre cada uno de ellos. Y fueron todos llenos del Espíritu Santo y comenzaron a hablar en otras lenguas, según el Espíritu les daba que hablasen.» (Hechos 2:2-4)

Pentecostés deriva su nombre del número cincuenta, que es el número de días después de Pascua que se celebra. Los israelitas también tenían una fiesta cincuenta días después de la Pascua llamada Shavout, que es la palabra hebrea para semanas. Era una de las tres fiestas de peregrinación. Se esperaba que los judíos viajaran al templo de Jerusalén tal y como ordenaba la Biblia. Durante el período del Templo, la atención se centraba en la agricultura, en particular en la cosecha de grano, con un énfasis específico en el trigo. La cosecha de cereales duraba siete semanas y se la conocía como la estación de la alegría. La cebada se cosechaba durante la Pascua y trigo durante Shavuot. Dos panes de la cosecha de trigo se ofrecían en el templo. Tras la destrucción del Templo en el año 70, cuando ya no se podían hacer ofrendas en él, Shavuot pasó a centrarse en la entrega de la Torá, o ley, revelada por Dios en el monte Sinaí.

Tras recibir el Espíritu Santo, Pedro predica con valentía a la multitud. En su discurso cita una profecía del profeta Joel: «Y acontecerá en los últimos días, dice Dios que derramaré mi Espíritu sobre toda carne, y vuestros hijos y vuestras hijas profetizarán, y vuestros jóvenes verán visiones, y vuestros ancianos soñarán sueños». (Hechos 2:17). El tiempo de la Iglesia en la Nueva Alianza ha comenzado y es realmente una nueva estación de alegría.

¡Espíritu Santo, fortalécenos! Inmaculado Corazón María, ruega por nosotros.
