Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Sin causes real consequences—and God will never leave us to face those consequences alone. Today's first reading harkens back to the very beginning when the man and the woman eat from the forbidden tree. They disobeyed God. The scene depicts two people hungry for more and better. The first people want to become gods themselves. The serpent lures the man and the woman in by promising to give them what they think they want. The serpent tries to create distance between the people and God—yet God does not allow that to happen.

The sins of the man and the woman hurt their relationship with God. They face severe consequences for what they have done. Still, God does not end the relationship with the man and the women. In one of the more powerful biblical scenes, God is described as walking around the garden in search of the couple. God values both justice and mercy. Sin is not without consequence—and the people who sin remain beloved children of God.

In Today's gospel, Jesus goes up against the religious authorities of the times, the Jerusalem scribes. Jesus recognizes that while the scribes hold great influence within the community, they are corrupt and are not leading the people in the ways God intends. In response Jesus offers two parables to the scribes that call for liberation from sin and division. He shows that even those claiming to be religious authorities can be corrupt.

Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us.

La serpiente atrae al hombre y a la mujer prometiéndoles darles lo que creen que quieren. La serpiente intenta distanciar a la gente de Dios, pero Dios no lo permite.

Los pecados del hombre y de la mujer dañan su relación con Dios. Se enfrentan a graves consecuencias por lo que han hecho. Aun así Dios no pone fin a la relación con el hombre y la mujer. En una de las escenas bíblicas más poderosas se describe a Dios caminando por el jardín en busca de la pareja. Dios valora tanto la justicia como la misericordia. El pecado tiene consecuencias, y las personas que pecan siguen siendo amados hijos de Dios.

En el evangelio de hoy, Jesús se enfrenta a las autoridades religiosas de la época, los escribas de Jerusalén. Jesús reconoce que, aunque los escribas tienen una gran influencia en la comunidad, son corruptos y no dirigen al pueblo como Dios quiere. En respuesta, Jesús ofrece dos parábolas a los escribas que llaman a la liberación del pecado y la división. Muestra que incluso los que dicen ser autoridades religiosas pueden ser corruptos.

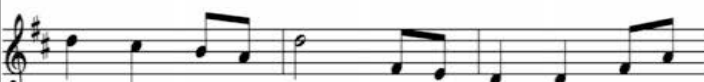

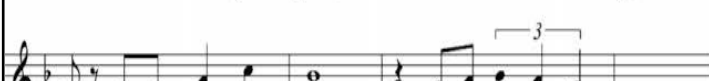

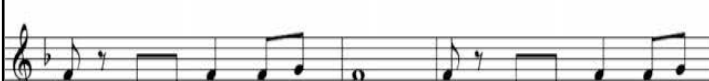

## **St. Anthony of Padua – June 13**

St. Anthony, originally named Fernando, was born in 1195 in Lisbon, Portugal. His spiritual journey began at 15 when he embraced the religious life, joining the order of St. Augustine. His unwavering dedication and commitment were evident as he spent nine years in rigorous study, culminating in his ordination as a priest.

St. Anthony's life took a significant turn when he was present in Coimbra, Portugal, during the solemn return of the first Franciscan martyrs' bodies from Morocco. Filled with a fervent desire to earn the martyr's crown, he sought permission to leave his order, join the Franciscans, and embark on a mission to Morocco. His request was granted, and he embraced the Franciscan way of life, adopting the name Anthony.

Illness required Anthony to leave Morocco and return to Portugal. His ship, however, could not navigate around several storms and ended up in Sicily. The friars there nursed him back to health. He asked to be sent to Northern Italy to learn the Franciscan way of life. He was assigned to a hermitage for a life of seclusion and contemplation.

In 1222, he attended an ordination of Dominicans and Franciscans. After a meal, he was asked to give a short sermon. Unaware of his previous education, they asked for something simple. His skill at preaching was discovered then, and his quiet life of contemplation was exchanged for a life of public preaching. He was later given the title "Hammer of Heretics."

He was responsible for educating friars in sacred theology and continued his public preaching. He was later made provincial in Northern Italy and spent much time in Padua. Anthony died in 1231 at the age of 35. Many miracles were attributed to him, and he was declared a saint less than a year later. He is especially invoked worldwide as the patron saint of lost items. The richness of his teachings, especially in his published Sermons, led to Pope Pius XII declaring him a Doctor of the Church in 1946.

## **San Antonio de Padua - 13 de junio**

San Antonio, cuyo nombre original era Fernando, nació en 1195 en Lisboa (Portugal). Su itinerario espiritual comenzó a los 15 años, cuando abrazó la vida religiosa, ingresando en la orden de San Agustín. Su inquebrantable dedicación y compromiso se hicieron evidentes durante los nueve años de rigurosos estudios que culminaron con su ordenación sacerdotal.

La vida de San Antonio dio un giro significativo cuando estuvo presente en Coimbra, Portugal, durante el solemne regreso de los cuerpos de los primeros mártires franciscanos de Marruecos. Lleno de un ferviente deseo de ganar la corona de mártir, pidió permiso para dejar su orden, unirse a los franciscanos y embarcarse en una misión a Marruecos. Su petición fue concedida y abrazó el estilo de vida franciscano, adoptando el nombre de Antonio.

Una enfermedad le obligó a abandonar Marruecos y regresar a Portugal. Su barco, sin embargo, no pudo sortear varias tormentas y acabó en Sicilia. Allí, los frailes le curaron. Pidió ser enviado al norte de Italia para aprender el estilo de vida franciscano. Se le asignó una ermita para llevar una vida de reclusión y contemplación.

En 1222, asistió a una ordenación de dominicos y franciscanos. Después de una comida, le pidieron que pronunciara un breve sermón. Desconocedores de su formación previa, le pidieron algo sencillo. Entonces se descubrió su habilidad para la predicación, y su tranquila vida de contemplación se cambió por una vida de predicación pública. Más tarde recibió el título de «Martillo de Herejes».

Se encargó de educar a los frailes en teología sagrada y continuó con su predicación pública. Más tarde fue nombrado provincial en el norte de Italia y pasó mucho tiempo en Padua. Murió en 1231, a la edad de 35 años. Se le atribuyeron numerosos milagros y fue declarado santo menos de un año después. Se le invoca especialmente en todo el mundo como patrón de los objetos perdidos. La riqueza de sus enseñanzas, especialmente en sus Sermones publicados, llevó al Papa Pío XII a declararle Doctor de la Iglesia en 1946.

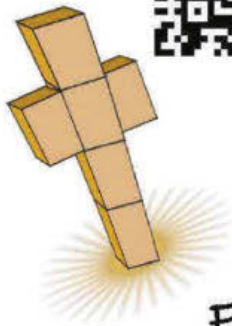
