Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

In today's gospel, Jesus tells a parable that uses the image of sowing a tiny seed to speak about the way radical change beings. Mustard seed is barely visible, and at first may escape notice when it settles into the soil. When it sprouts, however, it shoots up into a large vigorous plant that spreads uncontrollably. It cannot be contained in defined plots but crosses over into fields where it is unwanted. And once it takes root, it is nearly impossible to eradicate. In Jesus' parable this weed that was the bane of many farmers' existence did not get into the field accidentally; it is deliberately sown.

Sowing tiny seeds of hope has unforeseen effects that go far and wide. At the end of the mustard seed parable, Jesus says that all the birds of the sky will dwell in the shade of the mustard plant's large branches. The image is the same as in the first reading, where Ezekiel speaks of the hoped-for messianic time when all nations would be drawn to Israel. They would be like birds of all varieties flocking to the sheltering boughs of a cedar tree. These readings give us courage that no action is too small for sowing God's reign. They bolster our hope that faithful, everyday choices to scatter the seeds of Christ's love unleashes a power that can transform the world.

Queridas familias del Inmaculado Corazón de María,

En el evangelio de hoy, Jesús cuenta una parábola que utiliza la imagen de la siembra de una semilla diminuta para hablar del modo de ser del cambio radical. La semilla de mostaza apenas se ve, y al principio puede pasar desapercibida cuando se asienta en la tierra. Sin embargo, cuando brota, m se convierte en una gran planta vigorosa que se extiende sin control. No puede contenerse en parcelas definidas, sino que cruza a campos donde no es deseada. Y una vez que echa raíces, es casi imposible erradicarla. En la parábola de Jesús, esta mala hierba, que era la pesadilla de la existencia de muchos agricultores, no entró en el campo accidentalmente, sino que fue sembrada deliberadamente.

Sembrar pequeñas semillas de esperanza tiene efectos imprevistos que llegan muy lejos. Al final de la parábola del grano de mostaza, Jesús dice que todas las aves del cielo habitarán a la sombra de las grandes ramas de la planta de mostaza. La imagen es la misma que en la primera lectura, donde Ezequiel habla del esperado tiempo mesiánico en el que todas las naciones serían atraídas hacia Israel. Serían como pájaros de todas las variedades que acuden a las ramas protectoras de un cedro. Estas lecturas nos animan a creer que ninguna acción es demasiado pequeña para sembrar el reino de Dios. Refuerzan nuestra esperanza de que las opciones fieles y cotidianas de esparcir las semillas del amor de Cristo desencadenan una fuerza capaz de transformar el mundo.

Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus & The Immaculate Heart of Mary

As a community, we come together to observe the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on the second Friday after Trinity Sunday, this year on Friday, June 7. The Immaculate Heart of Mary is our shared celebration on the following Saturday, June 8. The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart was first celebrated in 1670 in France, a testament to the visions of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque and the growing devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus that unites us all.

The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is a devotion to the long-suffering love and eternal compassion of Christ toward humanity. In art, this devotion is symbolized by a flaming heart shining with divine light, pierced with a lance, and encircled by a crown of thorns. It is often shown in the bosom of Jesus with his wounded hand pointing to it. The wounds and crown of thorns allude to Christ's passion and the flames to the burning of his ardent and endless love.

Devotion to the Sacred Heart developed out of devotion to the Holy Wounds of Christ. It is believed to have started in Benedictine monasteries as early as the eleventh century. Dominicans, Franciscans, and Carthusians practiced it from the thirteenth to the sixteenth centuries.

The devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary has a scriptural basis. The Gospel According to Luke twice states that Mary kept things in her heart and pondered them. The attraction of the devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary is the love in her heart for Jesus and God. The Immaculate Heart of Mary signifies her great love for God, her great purity, and her complete openness to the Holy Spirit. La Solemnidad del Sagrado Corazón se celebró por primera vez en 1670 en Francia, testimonio de las visiones de Santa Margarita María Alacoque y de la creciente devoción al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús que nos une a todos.

La devoción al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús es una devoción al amor sufrido y a la compasión eterna de Cristo hacia la humanidad. En el arte, esta devoción está simbolizada por un corazón en llamas que brilla con luz divina, atravesado por una lanza y rodeado por una corona de espinas. A menudo se muestra en el pecho de Jesús con su mano herida apuntando hacia él. Las heridas y la corona de espinas aluden a la pasión de Cristo y las llamas al ardor de su amor ardiente e inagotable.

La devoción al Sagrado Corazón se desarrolló a partir de la devoción a las Santas Llagas de Cristo. Se cree que comenzó en los monasterios benedictinos ya en el siglo XI. Dominicos, franciscanos y cartujos la practicaron entre los siglos XIII y XVI.

La devoción al Corazón Inmaculado de María tiene una base bíblica. El Evangelio según San Lucas afirma dos veces que María guardaba las cosas en su corazón y las meditaba. La atracción de la devoción al Corazón Inmaculado de María es el amor de su corazón por Jesús y por Dios. El Corazón Inmaculado de María significa su gran amor a Dios, su gran pureza y su total apertura al Espíritu Santo. Es un recuerdo de la profunda vida interior de María, en la que experimentó alegrías y penas, permaneciendo fiel a Dios.



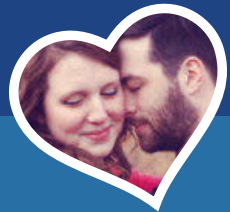
