The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

Gen 14:18-20 | 1 Cor 11:23-26 | Lk 9:11b-17

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Today's feast is set apart to reverence the gift of Jesus in the Eucharist. In our limited human capacity, this concept can feel abstract, and we may struggle to understand it. In these moments, I find that pondering the person of Jesus Christ in the Gospels illuminates my mind and heart. Hearing the familiar story of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes in today's Gospel, I'm particularly struck by the first line of the passage: "Jesus spoke to the crowds about the kingdom of God, and he healed those who needed to be cured." Notice that Luke doesn't say that Jesus heals *everyone*, rather, he heals those who *need* to be cured. This is not an act of favoritism, but a revelation of his perfect divine wisdom and a glimpse into the true person of Jesus Christ. In his great mercy and perfect love, Jesus knew instantly what each person needed. And this Jesus, who came to heal and cure, is the one we receive in the Eucharist today.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Today's feast is a reminder of the staggering truth that 2,000 years later, at every Eucharistic celebration in Catholic churches around the world, Christ becomes truly present. The same Jesus of the Gospels who taught the crowds, multiplied the loaves, and gave himself completely on the cross, gives himself to us *today*: body, blood, soul, and divinity. We are not unlike the crowds in today's Gospel — we have come with our hopes and needs to encounter Jesus. Today, at this table, no one goes hungry; Jesus meets our needs by giving us his unconditional love while nourishing us both physically and spiritually. We can be reassured that God is always present in our lives.

REFLECT

In a special way today, reflect on the Eucharist, the "source and summit of the Christian life." The word Eucharist comes from Greek and Latin words for "thanksgiving." Pray with a grateful heart today that Jesus, the Bread of Life, makes himself truly present to us.

The Mystery of the Eucharist

In his encyclical, *Ecclesia de Eucharistia*, Pope St. John Paul II says, "By the gift of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, the Church was born and set out upon the pathways of the world, yet a decisive moment in her taking shape was certainly the institution of the Eucharist in the Upper Room. Her foundation and wellspring is the whole *Triduum paschale*, but this is as it were gathered up, foreshadowed, and 'concentrated' forever in the gift of the Eucharist. In this gift, Jesus Christ entrusted to his Church the perennial making present of the paschal mystery. With it he brought about a mysterious 'oneness in time' between that Triduum and the passage of the centuries." (par.5)

In every Mass since the Last Supper, the Crucifixion, death, Resurrection, and Ascension of Christ are re-presented, or made present to the assembly. These events exist in eternity and are made present for us at each Mass. That is the "mysterious oneness in time" he is referring to.

St. Thomas Aquinas, often known only for his keen intellect, was also a great poet of the Eucharist. His works give us the language of worship and devotion to the Holy Eucharist. Think of *O Salutaris Hostia* and *Adore Te Devote*. He also wrote the liturgy for Corpus Christ, the hymns, and the sequence. The sequence (Lauda Sion) is sung before the Gospel. The sequence urges us to praise God and to do it well:

Let the chant be loud and high,
Sweet and tranquil be the joy
Felt today in every breast;
On this festival, divine
Which recounts the origin
Of the Glorious Eucharist.

En su encíclica *Ecclesia de Eucharistia*, el Papa Juan Pablo II dice: "Por el don del Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés, la Iglesia nació y se puso en camino por las sendas del mundo, pero un momento decisivo en su formación fue ciertamente la institución de la Eucaristía en el Cenáculo. Su fundamento y fuente es todo el Triduo pascual, pero éste está como recogido, prefigurado y «concentrado» para siempre en el don de la Eucaristía. En este don, Jesucristo confió a su Iglesia la perenne actualización del misterio pascual. Con él realizó una misteriosa «unidad en el tiempo» entre aquel Triduo y el paso de los siglos". (par.5)

Santo Tomás de Aquino, a menudo conocido sólo por su agudo intelecto, fue también un gran poeta de la Eucaristía. Sus obras nos proporcionan el lenguaje del culto y la devoción a la Sagrada Eucaristía. Pensemos en *O Salutaris Hostia* y *Adore Te Devote*. También escribió la liturgia del Corpus Christi, los himnos y la secuencia. La secuencia (Lauda Sion) se canta antes del Evangelio. La secuencia nos exhorta a alabar a Dios y a hacerlo bien:

Que el canto sea fuerte y alto,
Dulce y tranquila sea la alegría
Sentida hoy en cada pecho;
En esta fiesta, divina
Que narra el origen
De la Gloriosa Eucaristía.

Inmaculado Corazón María, Mujer de la Eucaristía, ruega por nosotros.
