

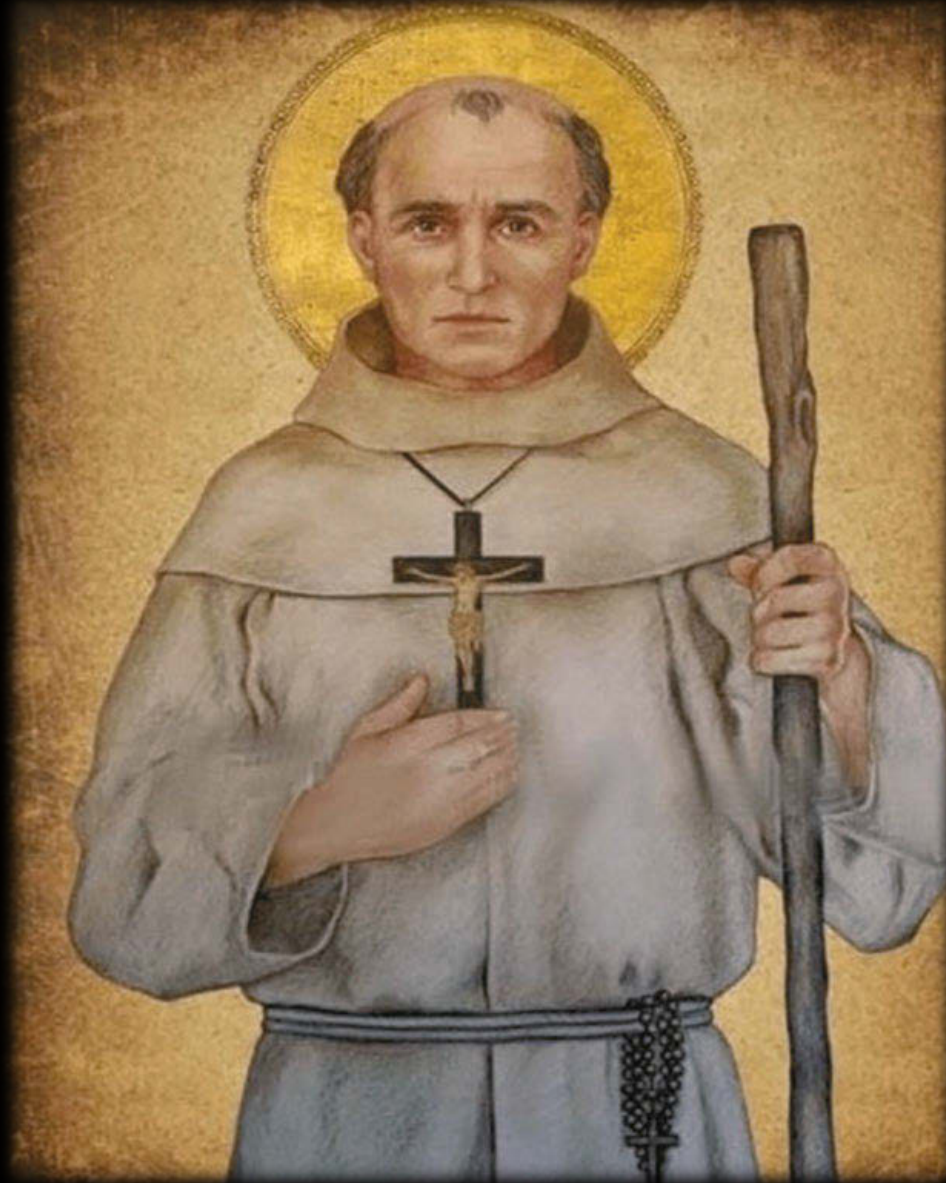

Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Suffering separates. It leaves those like the woman in today's gospel anguishing in physical and emotional pain. Her community excluded this woman because of her hemorrhaging, deeming her ritually unclean. By the time she got to Jesus, the woman must have been exhausted. She must have tried countless doctors and remedies. Nothing was working. The woman knew she was not supposed to be out in the crowd. She knew the judgments people would pass as she sought healing. Nevertheless, she persisted.

The woman believed in Jesus' power to heal and nothing—and no pain, no social norms, nothing—was going to stop her from his help. The woman elbowed her way through the masses to get closer enough to Jesus to touch the fringe of his garment. Her hemorrhaging stops. After being cast out for a dozen years, the woman bravely declared her faith for all to hear. She shared her story which was part of the healing too.

In today's second reading, Saint Paul addresses the practice of generosity. It is not enough, he says, to excel in faith, discourse, knowledge, earnestness, and love. You must also excel in being gracious. Saint Paul puts forth a vision of community where people with abundance provide for the needs of those who have less. Jesus provides the model for excelling in generosity. The Son of God gave up his very life so that humankind may be raised up. In this spirit, we too are asked to use our time, talents, and treasures in service of others. We are called to care for the most vulnerable among us through tangible actions.

Queridas familias del Inmaculado Corazón de María,

El sufrimiento separa. Deja a los que, como la mujer del evangelio de hoy, se angustian por el dolor físico y emocional. Su comunidad excluyó a esta mujer a causa de su hemorragia, considerándola ritualmente impura. Cuando llegó a Jesús, la mujer debía de estar agotada. Debía de probar innumerables médicos y remedios. Nada funcionaba. La mujer sabía que no debía estar entre la multitud. Sabía que la gente la juzgaría mientras buscaba la curación. Sin embargo, persistió.

La mujer creía en el poder de Jesús para curar y nada -ni el dolor, ni las normas sociales, ni nada- iba a impedir que recibiera su ayuda. La mujer se abre paso a codazos entre la multitud para acercarse lo suficiente a Jesús como para tocar los flecos de su manto. Su hemorragia se detiene. Después de haber sido expulsada durante una docena de años, la mujer declaró valientemente su fe para que todos la oyeran. Compartió su historia, que también formó parte de la curación.

En la segunda lectura de hoy, San Pablo aborda la práctica de la generosidad. No basta, dice, con sobresalir en la fe, el discurso, el conocimiento, la seriedad y el amor. También hay que sobresalir en ser generoso. San Pablo propone una visión de la comunidad en la que las personas con abundancia atienden las necesidades de los que tienen menos. Jesús ofrece el modelo para sobresalir en generosidad. El Hijo de Dios entregó su propia vida para que la humanidad pudiera ser elevada. En este espíritu, también a nosotros se nos pide que utilicemos nuestro tiempo, nuestros talentos, al servicio de los demás. Estamos llamados a cuidar de los más vulnerables entre nosotros mediante acciones tangibles.

St. Junipero Serra - July 1

On Monday, July 1, the Church commemorates St. Junipero Serra, the patron saint of California. A man of profound faith and unwavering dedication, St. Junipero Serra's establishment of missions across Mexico and California as a Franciscan Missionary has left an indelible mark on the religious landscape of these regions.

He was born Miguel Jose Serra Ferrer on the Spanish island of Majorca in 1713. At seven, he visited the Franciscan friary near his parents' home. He showed an interest and talent in liturgical songs and was educated in the friars' school. At 16, he became a Franciscan novice. He was given the name Junipero.

He was ordained a priest when he was 24 and began teaching philosophy. He was a gifted teacher and philosopher and was assured a prestigious future in Spain. His heart, however, desired to be a missionary. He was eventually given permission and landed in Veracruz in 1749.

Fr. Junipero was sent to the Sierra Gorda mission and took up life there. 1767, King Carlos of Spain expelled the Jesuits from New Spain (Mexico). Fr. Junipero was appointed to take over the missions the Jesuits set up in Baja. From there, he continued to push north into California with his fellow Franciscans. He founded 8 of the 21 Spanish missions in California stretching from San Diego to San Francisco. Fr Junipero was a gifted preacher who showed fatherly love towards all he sought to convert. He died at 70 in 1784 at the mission in modern-day Carmel-by-the-Sea, California. Pope Francis canonized him in 2015.

Please continue to pray for vocations to the priesthood, permanent diaconate, religious life, and marriage.

San Junípero Serra - 1 de julio

El lunes 1 de julio, la Iglesia conmemora a San Junípero Serra, patrón de California. Hombre de fe profunda y dedicación inquebrantable, el establecimiento de misiones en México y California por parte de San Junípero Serra como misionero franciscano ha dejado una huella indeleble en el paisaje religioso de estas regiones.

Nació como Miguel José Serra Ferrer en la isla española de Mallorca en 1713. A los siete años visitó el convento franciscano cercano a la casa de sus padres. Mostró interés y talento para los cantos litúrgicos y fue educado en el colegio de los frailes. A los 16 años, se hizo novicio franciscano. Recibe el nombre de Junípero.

Fue ordenado sacerdote a los 24 años y comenzó a enseñar filosofía. Era un profesor y filósofo dotado y se le aseguró un futuro prestigioso en España. Sin embargo, su corazón deseaba ser misionero. Le concedieron el permiso y desembarcó en Veracruz en 1749.

El P. Junípero fue enviado a la misión de Sierra Gorda y allí comenzó su vida. En 1767, el rey Carlos de España expulsó a los jesuitas de Nueva España (México). El P. Junípero fue designado para hacerse cargo de las misiones que los jesuitas habían establecido en Baja California. Desde allí, siguió avanzando hacia el norte de California con sus compañeros franciscanos. Fundó 8 de las 21 misiones españolas de California, desde San Diego hasta San Francisco. El padre Junípero era un predicador dotado que mostraba un amor paternal hacia todos los que intentaba convertir. Murió a los 70 años, en 1784, en la actual misión de Carmel by-the-Sea, California. El Papa Francisco lo canonizó en 2015.

Por favor, sigan rezando por las vocaciones al sacerdocio, al diaconado permanente, a la vida religiosa y al matrimonio.


