Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

The apostles have just returned from their first attempts at teaching and expelling evil spirits, and their report to Jesus is a probably an enthusiastic retelling of all the marvels they accomplished. Jesus invites them to a deserted place, the kind of place where he would customarily go apart to pray (Mark 1:35). Perhaps the disciples were in danger of becoming a bit too enamored of their own abilities to perform wonders. The deserted place will help them experience more deeply the divine compassion that calls them into mission and that is the source of all that they are able to do. From their ability to receive divine compassion in their own neediness, they become able to be the compassion of God towards others. Just so, in any work of reconciliation, the ability to experience compassion, that is, is to "feel with" the other, from the other's point of view, is crucial in moving forward oneness.

For creating unity in our own day, we can emulate this same pattern. We start with contemplative dwelling with the Source of our grace, allowing ourselves to be transformed into the very peace we desire. Second, making peace is costly; it demands crossing over dividing walls to listen deeply and with empathy to the "other," and being willing to engage in long processes of dialogue, clarifying where we have common ground and where we yet differ, and praying for the guidance of the Spirit to find the way through the impasses.

Los apóstoles acaban de regresar de sus primeros intentos de enseñar y expulsar espíritus malignos, y su informe a Jesús es probablemente un relato entusiasta de todas las maravillas que realizaron. Jesús les invita a un lugar desierto, el tipo de lugar donde él solía apartarse para orar (Mc 1,35). Tal vez los discípulos corrían el riesgo de sentirse demasiado orgullosos de su propia capacidad para realizar prodigios. El lugar desierto les ayudará a experimentar más profundamente la compasión divina que les llama a la misión y que es la fuente de todo lo que son capaces de hacer. Desde su capacidad de recibir la compasión divina en su propia necesidad, se vuelven capaces de ser la compasión de Dios hacia los demás. Del mismo modo, en cualquier trabajo de reconciliación, la capacidad de experimentar la compasión, es decir, de "sentir con" el otro, desde el punto de vista del otro, es crucial para avanzar hacia la unidad.

Para crear unidad en nuestro propio día, podemos emular este mismo modelo. Comenzamos con una morada contemplativa en la Fuente de nuestra gracia, permitiéndonos transformarnos en la paz que deseamos. En segundo lugar, hacer la paz es costoso; exige cruzar los muros divisorios para escuchar profundamente y con empatía al "otro", y estar dispuestos a comprometernos en largos procesos de diálogo, clarificando dónde tenemos puntos en común y dónde aún diferimos, y rezando para que el Espíritu nos guíe para encontrar el camino a través de los callejones sin salida.

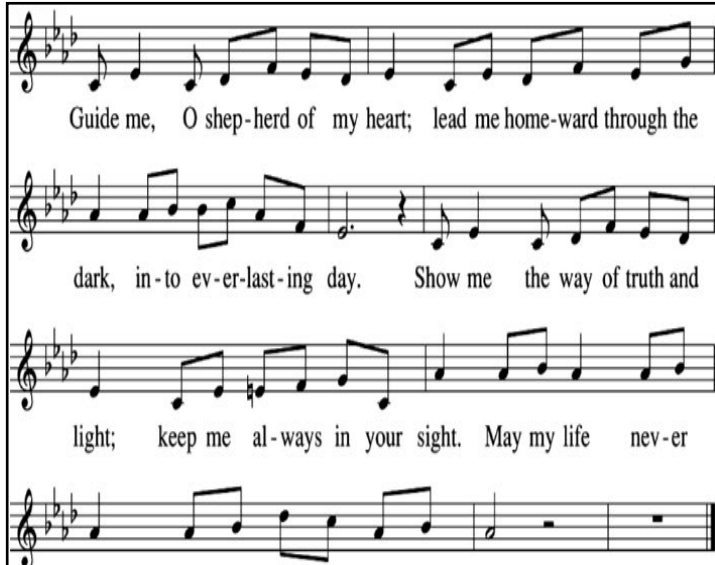

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

What words do we associate with being misled? Deceived, fooled, cheated? While these actions make great plot points in novels and movies, in real life they are offenses against justice, charity, and truth. In both the first reading and the Gospel today, we hear that God's people are being misled ("Woe to the shepherds who mislead and scatter the flock of my pasture") and/or left to their own devices ("for they were like sheep without a shepherd"). In the time of Jeremiah the kings of Judah, who were shepherding in God's name, were not tending their flock: They had "scattered [his] sheep and driven them away." Jeremiah prophesies that the Lord will gather the remnant of his flock and bring them back to their meadow; in short, the Lord offers hope. He would raise up from the house of David a true shepherd to guide and guard his people. The incarnation of Jesus is the manifestation of that hope, and in him we have a guiding light to lead us along the correct path. He will never deceive, fool, or cheat. In this world filled with unrest and division, he offers something that no mortal man or woman can: He is the one who saves and redeems. He is the one true shepherd.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

When life is packed with activities and stress, today's readings remind us what we need to do - let go of our worries and focus on Jesus. Just as, in the first reading, God's people are scattered because of poor shepherding, all of us can lose sight from time to time of what should be first and foremost in our lives: our relationship with Jesus. The key to living a good life is to listen to Jesus' words and disregard all the other noise out there. St. Paul writes that Christ is our peace, reconciling us to God and giving us access in one Spirit to the Father, through himself. In addition to Jesus bringing us the peace we need, he also guides us to the Truth. As Christians, we choose Truth over chaos and deception. It's easy to be inadvertently misled in this busy world; losing one's way is rarely intentional. But we can all struggle at times with keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus and his loving, guiding hand. If we want true peace in our lives, choose Jesus; choose his compassion and love; and be open to his desire to "teach [us] many things."

PRAY This week find your true rest and peace by meeting Jesus at daily Mass or Eucharistic adoration. Even better, why not share the peace of Christ with someone who you know might be struggling, and invite them to come to Mass or adoration with you? The crowds of people who came to see Jesus learned about him from others; let us do the same and share the joy we find in Jesus with others.

St. Mary Magdalene – July 22

On July 22, the Church celebrates St. Mary Magdalene, a devoted, faithful, and persistent disciple of Jesus. Mary Magdalene is mentioned in all four Gospels, which indicates her importance. She is described as the Apostle to the Apostles, as she was recorded in each Gospel account as the first to receive the news of the Resurrection.

The Gospels do not provide much biographical information about Mary, so many theories have been developed. Some have distinguished Mary Magdalene from the sinner of Luke 7:36-50 and Mary, the sister of Martha and Lazarus of Bethany. Others hold that all three are the same person. Let us focus on what is known.

Mary was a follower of Jesus who accompanied and ministered to him. Jesus cast out seven demons from her. She was with the Blessed Mother and the Apostle John at the Crucifixion, standing at the foot of the Cross. She witnessed Jesus' dead body being laid in the tomb. She set out early to the tomb to anoint Jesus' body, and when she saw the empty tomb, she ran to tell Peter and John.

When they returned home, Mary stayed at the tomb weeping. She then encountered two angels and spoke to them. Jesus, concealing his identity at first, also spoke to her. She was trying to ascertain where Jesus' body was. He then called her name and revealed himself to her. After this, she went to the disciples and said, "I have seen the Lord." (John 20:18). Jesus chose her to be the first witness to his Resurrection and to be the first to proclaim it.

It is not known where Mary lived and traveled after the Resurrection. Some traditions state she ended up with St. John and the Blessed Mother in Ephesus, while others say she ended up in France. We know that Mary was a devoted follower of Christ, and we should have no doubt that she was faithful and loyal to Him for the rest of her life.

St. Mary Magdalene, pray for us. Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us!

Please continue to pray for vocations to the priesthood, permanent diaconate, religious life, and holy matrimony.

Santa María Magdalena - 22 de julio

El 22 de julio, la Iglesia celebra a Santa María Magdalena, discípula devota, fiel y perseverante de Jesús. María Magdalena es mencionada en los cuatro Evangelios, lo que indica su importancia. Se la describe como la Apóstol de los Apóstoles, ya que aparece en cada Evangelio como la primera en recibir la noticia de la Resurrección.

Los Evangelios no proporcionan mucha información biográfica sobre María, por lo que se han desarrollado muchas teorías. Algunos han distinguido a María Magdalena de la pecadora de Lucas 7:36-50 y María, la hermana de Marta y Lázaro de Betania. Otros sostienen que las tres son la misma persona. Centrémonos en lo que se sabe.

María era una seguidora de Jesús que le acompañaba y le servía. Jesús expulsó de ella siete demonios. Estuvo con la Virgen y el apóstol Juan en la Crucifixión, al pie de la Cruz. Fue testigo del sepelio de Jesús. Salió temprano hacia el sepulcro para ungir el cuerpo de Jesús y, cuando vio el sepulcro vacío, corrió a decírselo a Pedro y a Juan.

Cuando volvieron a casa, María se quedó llorando junto al sepulcro. Entonces se encontró con dos ángeles y habló con ellos. Jesús, que al principio ocultaba su identidad, también habló con ella. Ella intentaba averiguar dónde estaba el cuerpo de Jesús. Él la llamó por su nombre y se le reveló. Después de esto, ella fue a los discípulos y dijo: "He visto al Señor". (Juan 20:18). Jesús la eligió para ser la primera testigo de su Resurrección y la primera en proclamarla.

No se sabe dónde vivió y viajó María después de la Resurrección. Algunas tradiciones afirman que fue a parar con San Juan y la Virgen a Éfeso, mientras que otras dicen que fue a parar a Francia. Sabemos que María fue una devota seguidora de Cristo, y no debemos dudar de que le fue fiel y leal durante el resto de su vida.

Santa María Magdalena, ruega por nosotros. Corazón Inmaculado de María, ruega por nosotros.

Por favor, seguid rezando por las vocaciones al sacerdocio, al diaconado permanente, a la vida religiosa y al santo matrimonio.

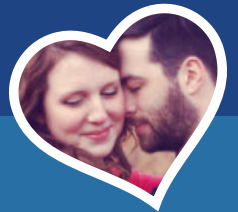
