Wis 12:13, 16-19 | Rom 8:26-27 | Mt 13:24-43

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

The parables were always my favorite Gospel readings when I was growing up. One we just heard, regarding the wheat and the weeds, was particularly comforting to me as a child. It was simple to understand, I thought: Those of us in God's Church were obviously the wheat and, of course, destined for salvation. We just needed to endure living among "the weeds" while we are in this world. As an adult, however, I realize that Jesus' message is much more challenging - much more convicting regarding my own failures and sins: I could be a weed! And while I certainly don't like that thought, I also don't like considering that anyone would be thrown into the "fiery furnace." After all, we are supposed to love one another and desire that they become part of the body of Christ and have eternal life. The reality of this world, however, is that temptation and sin surround us. Fortunately, Jesus gives us himself as the Bread of Life in the Eucharist, and we have the gift of mercy in the sacrament of reconciliation. These sacraments, as well as prayer, give us the "nutrients" we need to ensure that we remain the wheat God has sown in his field, and that we can help others be that too.

While the sacraments can fortify our faith, what about our neighbors, friends or family who are not Catholic or who have fallen away from the Church? This is where evangelization comes in - inviting someone to join you at Mass or suggesting a religious book they might enjoy reading. If you don't think such a simple act could make much difference in the life of another, take heart in the parables contained in the long form of today's Gospel. In those, Jesus reminds us that it doesn't take much to spread the Good News of the kingdom of heaven. The smallest of seeds can turn into the largest of plants and a small amount of yeast can leaven much flour. And if we have moments where we lack courage or feel in need of assistance, St. Paul reminds us that "the Spirit comes to the aid of our weakness." Never underestimate the power of the Advocate: he can help us pray, can intercede for us, and provide what we need to be good seed in the world.

PRAY Let us pray this week for the strength to live out our baptismal promise to reject evil, and to gain courage so as to be a witness to God, and to work toward building his kingdom on earth wherever and whenever we can.

Saints – St. Anne and St. Joachim

We will look at some of the Saints the Church celebrates throughout the year. On Wednesday, July 26th, the Church celebrates St. Joachim and St. Anne, the Blessed Virgin Mary's parents.

There is no mention of Mary's parents in Scripture. What we know about them, including their names, is found in second and third-century writings. These writings became the foundation for establishing the Feast of the Nativity of the Virgin Mary (September 8) and the Feast of the Immaculate Conception (December 8). These sources indicate that St. Anne (Hannah in Hebrew) was born in Bethlehem. She married St. Joachim but was childless for some time.

They each received a vision from an angel who announced that Anne would conceive and bear a most wonderful child. Prior to conceiving, Anne had solemnly promised God that if given a child, she would dedicate it to the Lord's service. When Mary was three years old, her parents fulfilled this promise and brought her to the Temple of Jerusalem to be brought up. This account closely mirrors the Old Testament account of Hannah in 1 Samuel 1.

St. Anne is the patron saint of women in labor. St. Anne and St Joachim are the patron saints of grandparents. St. Anne and St. Joachim, pray for us! Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us!

Santos - Santa Ana y San Joaquín

La Escritura no menciona a los padres de María. Lo que sabemos de ellos, incluidos sus nombres, se encuentra en escritos de los siglos II y III. Estos escritos se convirtieron en la base para establecer la Fiesta de la Natividad de la Virgen María (8 de septiembre) y la Fiesta de la Inmaculada Concepción (8 de diciembre). Estas fuentes indican que Santa Ana (Hannah en hebreo) nació en Belén. Se casó con San Joaquín, pero no tuvo hijos durante algún tiempo.

Ambos recibieron una visión de un ángel que les anunció que Ana concebiría y daría a luz un hijo maravilloso. Antes de concebir, Ana había prometido solemnemente a Dios que, si le daba un hijo, lo dedicaría al servicio del Señor. Cuando María tenía tres años, sus padres cumplieron esta promesa y la llevaron al Templo de Jerusalén para que fuera educada. Este relato refleja fielmente el de Ana en 1 Samuel 1 del Antiguo Testamento.

Santa Ana es la patrona de las parturientas. Santa Ana y San Joaquín son los patronos de los abuelos. Santa Ana y San Joaquín, rogad por nosotros. Inmaculado Corazón de María, ruega por nosotros.

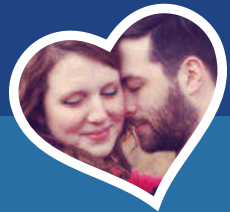
