Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Today's readings remind us that we are part of one Body and one Spirit. Humankind shares a common call. Thus, we are to care for one another just as we would care for our most cherished loved one. Particularly, biblical stories like today's first reading and gospel emphasize the need to care for people living in poverty. The hungry must be fed. It is the responsibility of those who have enough food to ensure that everyone else has their fill too. Bearing responsibility for each other is a foundational aspect of faith expressed in the Old and New Testaments.

The story of the feeding of the five thousand is the only miracle account to be written about in all four gospels. John's framing helps readers know a deeper truth about Jesus that he is the Son of the living God who has come to nourish our every need. The physical feeding of the crowds with five loaves and two fish is significant for sure. But what matters most to John is that people come to know and believe in the miracle worker.

The people deem Jesus a prophet upon benefiting from his miraculous feeding, but their understanding of Jesus is still limited to earthly frameworks of leadership. They want to make him a political king, which is not the type of kingship Jesus came to take on. So, the Son of God withdraws to the mountain alone. He takes time for silence and solitude with God to discern his next steps.

Queridas familias del Inmaculado Corazón de María,

Las lecturas de hoy nos recuerdan que formamos parte de un solo Cuerpo y de un solo Espíritu. La humanidad comparte una llamada común. Por tanto, debemos cuidarnos unos a otros como cuidaríamos a nuestro ser más querido. En particular, relatos bíblicos como la primera lectura y el evangelio de hoy subrayan la necesidad de cuidar de las personas que viven en la pobreza. Hay que alimentar a los hambrientos. Es responsabilidad de los que tienen suficiente comida asegurarse de que los demás también se sacien. Asumir la responsabilidad por los demás es un aspecto fundamental de la fe expresado en el Antiguo y el Nuevo Testamento.

La historia de la alimentación de los cinco mil es el único relato milagroso que aparece en los cuatro evangelios. El encuadre de Juan ayuda a los lectores a conocer una verdad más profunda sobre Jesús: que es el Hijo del Dios vivo que ha venido a alimentar todas nuestras necesidades. La alimentación física de las multitudes con cinco panes y dos peces es sin duda significativa. Pero lo más importante para Juan es que la gente conozca y crea en el hacedor de milagros.

La gente considera a Jesús un profeta al beneficiarse de su alimentación milagrosa, pero su comprensión de Jesús sigue limitada a los marcos terrenales de liderazgo. Quieren hacer de él un rey político, que no es el tipo de realeza que Jesús vino a asumir. Por eso, el Hijo de Dios se retira solo a la montaña. Se toma un tiempo de silencio y soledad con Dios para discernir sus próximos pasos.

## St. Ignatius of Loyola – July 31

The Church celebrates St. Ignatius, the founder of the Society of Jesus (Jesuits), on Wednesday, July 31. He was born in the village of Loyola in Azpeitia, Spain, in October of 1491. He was the youngest of the thirteen children of his parents, who were of the minor nobility of the clan of Loyola. For most of his childhood, Ignatius was driven to achieve military success and fame.

At seventeen, Ignatius joined the army. One year later, he fought for the Duke of Najera. He participated in many battles. In the Battle of Pamplona in 1521, he was seriously wounded by a French cannonball that fractured his leg. He was sent home to his father's castle in Loyola and underwent several painful operations that left his right leg shorter than his left, ending his military career.

During the long hours of his recovery, Ignatius, seeking to escape the monotony, requested books from his sister-in-law. He intended to immerse himself in the romantic chivalry he had read in his youth. However, the absence of such books in the castle led to a different path. His sister-in-law brought him books on the lives of Christ and the saints. Little did she know this simple act would be instrumental in sparking a profound change in Ignatius.

He became aware that when his daydreams were about chivalry and fame, he felt dry and dissatisfied, but when he thought about living a life like the saints, he experienced joy and peace. This was the beginning of a profound spiritual conversion.

Over the next several years, he traveled to monasteries and the Holy Land, spent extended time in prayer, and practiced rigorous asceticism, formulating the fundamentals of what became known as his *Spiritual Exercises*. He bolstered his education by attending universities in Spain and Paris.

With six fellow Spaniard students, Ignatius conceived the order he later founded. Its purpose was missionary work and teaching. In addition to the vows of chastity, obedience, and poverty, the Jesuits also vow obedience to the Pope. Pope Paul III approved the Jesuit Order in 1540. Ignatius died sixteen years later, on July 31, 1556.

## San Ignacio de Loyola - 31 de julio

La Iglesia celebra a San Ignacio, fundador de la Sociedad de Jesús, el miércoles 31 de julio. Nació en el pueblo de Loyola en Azpeitia, España, en octubre de 1491. Era el menor de los trece hijos de sus padres, que pertenecían a la nobleza menor del clan de Loyola. Durante la mayor parte de su infancia, Ignacio fue impulsado a alcanzar el éxito military y la fama.

Los diecisiete años, Ignacio se alistó en el ejército. Un año más tarde, luchó para el duque de Najera. Participó en muchas batallas. En la batalla de Pamplona, en 1521, fue gravemente herido por una bala de cañón francesa que le fracturó la pierna. Fue enviado a casa, al castillo de su padre en Loyola, y sometido a varias dolorosas operaciones que le dejaron la pierna derecha más corta que la izquierda, poniendo fin a su carrera militar.

Durante las largas horas de su recuperación, Ignacio, buscando escapar de la monotonía, pidió libros a su cuñada. Su intención era sumergirse en la caballería romántica que había leído en su juventud. Sin embargo, la ausencia de tales libros en el castillo lo llevó por otro camino. Su cuñada le trajo libros sobre la vida de Cristo y los santos. No podía imaginar que este sencillo acto provocaría un profundo cambio en Ignacio.

Se dio cuenta de que cuando sus ensueños giraban en torno a la caballería y la fama, se sentía seco e insatisfecho, pero cuando pensaba en vivir una vida como la de los santos, experimentaba alegría y paz. Fue el comienzo de una profunda conversión espiritual.

Durante los años siguientes, viajó a monasterios y a la Tierra Santa, pasó largo tiempo en oración y practicó un ascetismo riguroso, formulando los fundamentos de lo que se conocieron como sus Ejercicios Espirituales. Reforzó su educación asistiendo a universidades en España y París.

Con seis compañeros españoles, Ignacio concibió la orden que más tarde fundaría. Su objetivo era el trabajo misionero y la enseñanza. Además de los votos de castidad, obediencia y pobreza, los jesuitas también hacen voto de obediencia al Papa. El Papa Pablo III aprobó la Orden de los Jesuitas en 1540. Ignacio murió dieciséis años después, el 31 de julio de 1556.

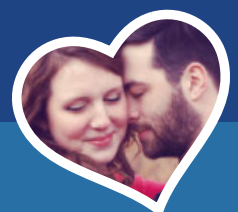
