Dear families of Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Today's feast of the Transfiguration presents the full force of God's power. In the rare moments when humans are permitted to encounter God's intense fullness, the human reaction is the same: fear. The prophet Daniel is so frightened by his visions that he falls flat on his face in terror.

Today's Gospel reports that Peter, James, and John were "very much afraid" when they saw Jesus transfigured on the mountain. They too fell prostrate in fear. These mighty revelations of God's brilliant majesty have a paralyzing effect on those who witness them.

God does not prefer to terrify us, however. God chooses only rare moments to reveal the divine glory, and then sends witnesses to the rest of us so we can believe without fear. Saint Peter's letter advises us to be attentive to God's witnesses. Their testimony is true. Their words renew our hearts and transform our lives.

For most of us now that school has resumed summer has ended. But the weather tells us differently. We had a slow start to our summer weather, but it is still staying very warm. As our children return to school and we return to our daily routines let us pray that we stay safe and in God's care. The last Confirmation registration for our teens as well as the Faith Formation for children will be on Sunday, August 13 at 10:00am in the Hall.

Sin embargo, Dios no prefiere aterrorizarnos. Dios elige sólo momentos excepcionales para revelar la gloria divina, y luego nos envía testigos para que podamos creer sin miedo. La carta de san Pedro nos aconseja estar atentos a los testigos de Dios. Su testimonio es verdadero. Sus palabras renuevan nuestro corazón y transforman nuestra vida.

Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord

Dn 7:9-10, 13-14 | 2 Pt 1:16-19 | Mt 17:1-9

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

According to the dictionary definition, to be transfigured is to “transform into something more beautiful or elevated.” This is what we see happening in Matthew’s Gospel today: Jesus takes his closest disciples up the mountain and there he is transformed – he is *transfigured* – before them: “His face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light.” He is also joined by Moses and Elijah as a sign that he is the fulfillment of God’s promises of old. Jesus completes the old covenant that God made with his people and brings us the new covenant of salvation. The Transfiguration parallels the Baptism of the Lord in that we once again hear God speaking from the heavens to say, “This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased.” But during the Transfiguration, God adds the words, “Listen to him.” That’s a command not just for his disciples there on the mountain but for us today as well.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

In elementary school, we were often reminded to listen. I remember one teacher who made a point to impress upon our class that listening is different from hearing. It is easy to hear, but to listen, you need to take the time to understand what is being said. In his letter today, Peter is urging us to listen to the prophetic message of Jesus. He says, “You will do well to be attentive to it” and then compares doing so to being “a lamp shining in a dark place.” The world today can be a very dark place, but we don’t have to be content to live in the shadows. By following Jesus’ example and commands, we can bring light – along with hope and joy – to our corner of the world. Sometimes that takes courage, though. It might involve making uncomfortable or unpopular choices, but Peter promises that the “day will dawn.” When that happens, we will undoubtedly see the fruits of our good works in our efforts to build God’s kingdom.

PRAY This week, let us pray in both words and actions as Jesus taught us. If the Lord’s Prayer is not already part of your daily prayer routine, try incorporating it this week. Then, look for ways to follow in the footsteps of Jesus by reaching out to someone who may appreciate a phone call or a visit.

Saints – St. Dominic

On Tuesday, August 8, the church honors St. Dominic, founder of the Dominican Order, also known as the Order of Preachers (OP). He was born in Calaruega, Spain, around 1172-1173. There is a tradition that before his mother, Blessed Jane of Aza, conceived Dominic, she had a dream in which she saw a hound racing through the world with a flaming torch in its mouth, igniting the world.

St. Dominic was sent to southern France as there was a tremendous upheaval due to the Albigensian heresy. He introduced a new evangelizing plan involving evangelical poverty and fraternal teaching about doctrine. To enable sound doctrine, his order would focus on the systematic education of the friars. He received approval from Pope Innocent III. He first set up a convent for women in 1206, establishing solid prayer support for his preaching. This, in essence, became the beating heart of his new order! In 1216 Pope Honorius III approved the Order of Preachers.

While it may seem evident that the order is referred to as the Dominicans in honor of St. Dominic, another reason exists. It combines the Latin words ***Domini***, which means Lord, and ***canis***, which means hounds. So, the Dominicans are the hounds of the Lord, which goes back to the vision of Dominic's mother. In artwork depicting St. Dominic, there is often a small dog with a torch in its mouth with him.

Every year on May 8, the Order of Preachers celebrates the Patronage of the Blessed Virgin Mary over the Order. St. Dominic, pray for us; Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us!

Santos - Santo Domingo

El martes 8 de agosto, la Iglesia honra a Santo Domingo, fundador de la Orden de los Dominicos, también conocida como Orden de Predicadores (OP). Nació en Calaruega, España, hacia 1172-1173. Existe la tradición de que, antes de que su madre, la beata Juana de Aza, concibiera a Domingo, tuvo un sueño en el que veía a un sabueso que corría por el mundo con una antorcha encendida en la boca, encendiendo el mundo.

Santo Domingo fue enviado al sur de Francia cuando se producía una tremenda agitación debido a la herejía albigense. Introdujo un nuevo plan evangelizador que incluía la pobreza evangélica y la enseñanza fraterna de la doctrina. Para hacer posible una doctrina sólida, su orden se centraría en la educación sistemática de los frailes. Recibió la aprobación del Papa Inocencio III. En 1206 fundó un convento para mujeres, estableciendo un sólido apoyo en la oración para su predicación. Esto, en esencia, se convirtió en el corazón palpitante de su nueva orden. En 1216, el Papa Honorio III aprobó la Orden de Predicadores.

Si bien puede parecer evidente que la orden se denomine Dominicos en honor a Santo Domingo, existe otra razón. Combina las palabras latinas ***Domini***, que significa Señor, y ***canis***, que significa sabuesos. Así pues, los dominicos son los sabuesos del Señor, lo que se remonta a la visión de la madre de Domingo. En las obras de arte que representan a Santo Domingo, a menudo aparece con él un pequeño perro con una antorcha en la boca.

Cada año, el 8 de mayo, la Orden de Predicadores celebra el Patrocinio de la Santísima Virgen María sobre la Orden. Santo Domingo, ruega por nosotros; ¡Inmaculado Corazón de María, ruega por nosotros!

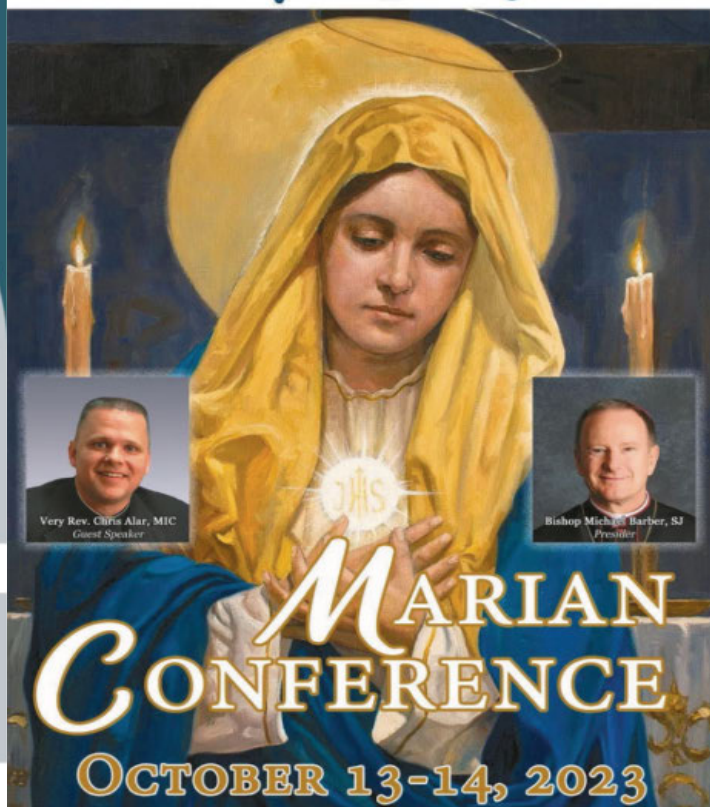

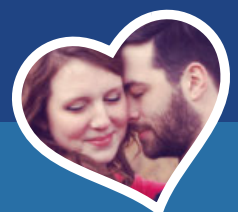
