

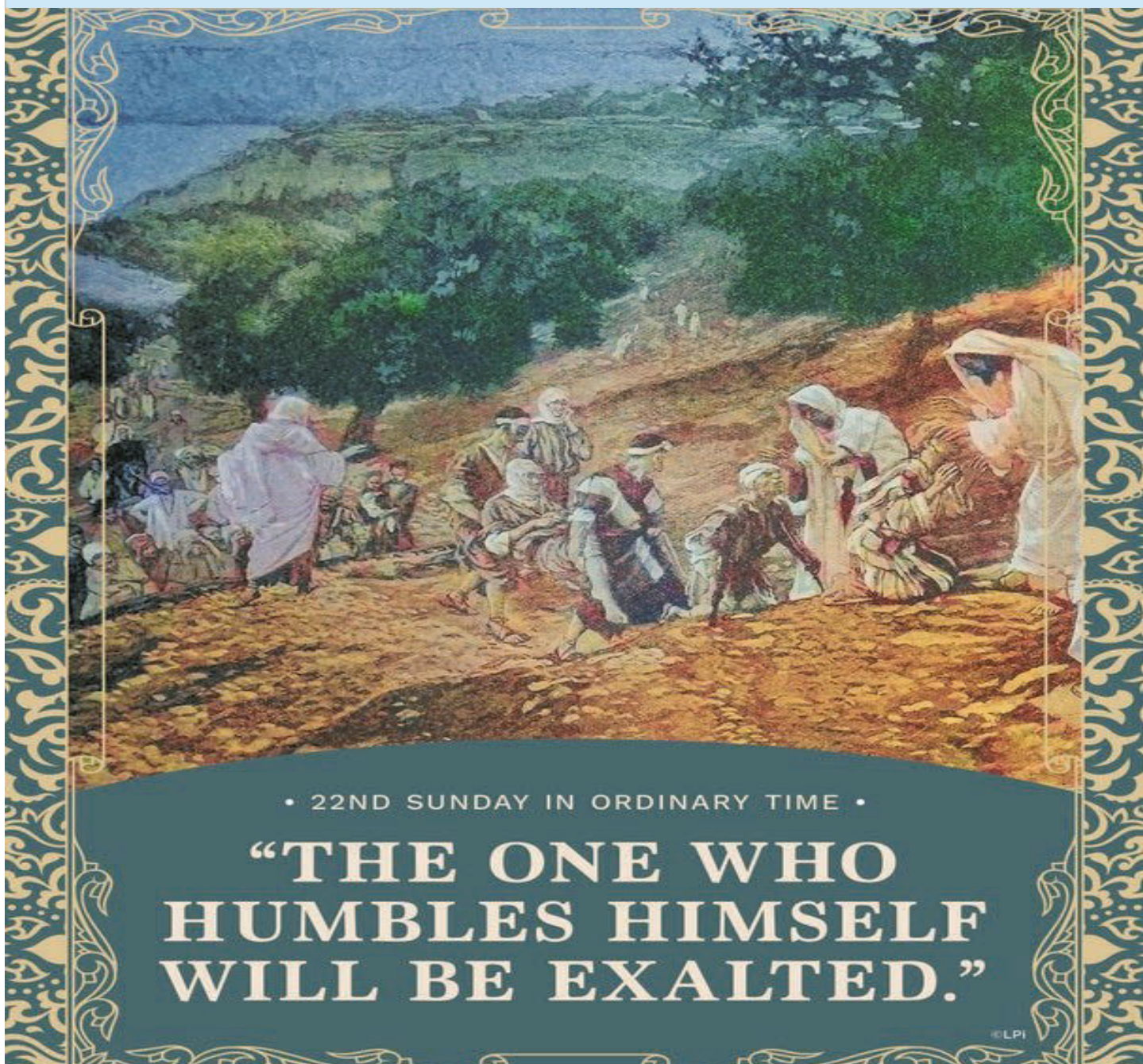

Humility is a virtue we don't see much in our times. It seems that bragging, swaggering, and arrogance dominate our fashion for everything and our Internet conversations. Who hasn't been irritated by the "trolls" who try (usually with bad grammar and poor spelling) to start an online fight with those whose opinions do not align with theirs? Our stores, catalogs, and online shopping sites are full of useless items geared in use and price to the very rich, as ordinary, useful things seem to fade off the sales scene.

As the rich get richer, the poor get poorer, and the middle class is fading away. What is the antidote to this? Humility is a good place to start. Devotion to God is worth more than riches. "The father of orphans and the defender of widows is God in his holy dwelling. God gives a home to the forsaken; [God] leads for prisoners to prosperity."

Twenty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Sir 3:17-18, 20, 28-29 | Heb 12:18-19, 22-24a | Lk 14:1, 7-14

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

There's a well-known story about an actor who was asked by an elderly priest to recite Psalm 23. The actor agreed only if the priest also recited the psalm. While the actor's delivery was met with esteem and applause, the priest's was met with raw emotion, stunned silence, and tears. The actor, smiling, said, "I may know the psalm, but the priest, he knows the Shepherd." I can't help but be reminded of this story when reading today's Gospel. Like the Pharisees, the actor represents the one who was the "center of attention" who was humbled whereas the priest, in his humble service to God, found himself exalted. That is where true humility lies, when our actions and our everyday lives are rooted in God first and not ourselves.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

As Jesus reminds us today, "Every one who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted." Beyond telling us this truth, Jesus lived it. Scripture tells us that Jesus – the second Person of the Holy Trinity – "emptied himself, taking the form of a slave..." (Phil 2:7), and that he came not "to be served but to serve" (Mk 10:45). Each of us is invited to consider the ways we can imitate the same humble servant-leadership which Jesus showed throughout his life. What does servant leadership look like, practically speaking? Some simple examples: At work, it might look like signing up to do those less desirable tasks that others would prefer to avoid. In our homes, it could look mean letting your children or spouse choose what's for dinner rather than asserting your own preferences over meal planning. In our relationships, it might mean allowing a friend to talk through their struggles without offering advice or sharing how you might have handled things differently. With the eyes of faith, each of us can see countless opportunities to practice the virtue of humility in daily life.

WITNESS

Like the priest in the story above who revealed God to the crowd in his recitation of Psalm 23, you have the opportunity to let God shine through in your life to others. Be a servant leader, seeking to glorify God rather than yourself. When you are humble you "will be exalted" and "repaid at the resurrection of the righteous."

Jubilee 2025 – The Great Unknown

The Holy Spirit fulfills all the goals of the jubilee year. The Holy Spirit forgives our sins, frees us from the tyranny of Satan, and adopts us as children of God. The prophet Isaiah's messianic oracle in the first-person says, "The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed me to bring good tidings to the afflicted; he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor." (61:1-2) Jesus reads this oracle from the synagogue in Nazareth and tells those present, saying, "Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing." (Luke 4:21).

The priest, St. Josemaria Escriva, described the Holy Spirit as the Great Unknown because of Catholics' lack of awareness of the workings of the Holy Spirit. He was known to recommend that Catholics focus on three areas to grow in affection and knowledge of the Holy Spirit: docility towards the Holy Spirit and His inspirations, a lifestyle of prayer, and constant union with the Cross. Over the next few months, we are going to examine each of these using a homily he gave on Pentecost on May 25, 1969, as a guide.

In his homily, St. Josemaria says, "God is no less powerful today than he was at other times; his love for man is no less true. Our faith teaches us that all creation, the movement of heavenly bodies, the good actions of creatures, and all the good that has been achieved in history, in short, everything comes from God and is directed toward him." In our noisy, distracted culture, we lose sight of this. He continues, "The action of the Holy Spirit can pass unnoticed, because God does not reveal to us his plans, and because man's sin clouds over the divine gifts. But faith reminds us that God is always acting. He has created us and maintains us in existence, and he leads all creation by his grace toward the glorious freedom of the children of God."

St. Josemaria says that we should conform ourselves to the rich Christian tradition of docility to the Holy Spirit. To be docile means we are willing to be taught. We should be aware of His work all around us. We should recognize the gifts he has given us. We should look to the movements and institutions He inspires. He is constantly carrying out the works of God in the world; if we do not see them, it is not because He is absent. Our faith in the Holy Spirit must be more than a vague belief.

Jubileo 2025: La Gran Incógnita

El Espíritu Santo cumple todos los objetivos del año jubilar. El Espíritu Santo perdona nuestros pecados, nos libera de la tiranía de Satanás y nos adopta como hijos de Dios. El profeta Isaías, en su profecía mesiánica en primera persona, dice: «El Espíritu del Señor Dios está sobre mí, porque el Señor me ha ungido para llevar buenas nuevas a los afligidos; me ha enviado a vender a los quebrantados de corazón, a proclamar libertad a los cautivos y la apertura de la prisión a los que están atados; a proclamar el año favorable del Señor». (61:1-2) Jesús lee este oráculo en la sinagoga de Nazaret y dice a los presentes: «Hoy se ha cumplido esta Escritura delante de vosotros» (Lucas 4:21).

El sacerdote San Josemaría Escrivá describió al Espíritu Santo como el Gran Desconocido debido a la falta de conciencia de los católicos sobre la obra del Espíritu Santo. Era conocido por recomendar a los católicos que se centraran en tres áreas para crecer en el afecto y el conocimiento del Espíritu Santo: la docilidad hacia el Espíritu Santo y sus inspiraciones, un estilo de vida de oración y la unión constante con la Cruz. Durante los próximos meses, vamos a examinar cada una de ellas utilizando como guía una homilía que pronunció en Pentecostés, el 25 de mayo de 1969.

En su homilía, san Josemaría dice: «Dios no es menos poderoso hoy que en otros tiempos; su amor por el hombre no es menos verdadero. Nuestra fe nos enseña que toda la creación, el movimiento de los cuerpos celestes, las buenas acciones de las criaturas y todo el bien que se ha logrado en la historia, en definitiva, todo proviene de Dios y está orientado hacia él». En nuestra cultura ruidosa y distraída, perdemos de vista esto. Continúa diciendo: «La acción del Espíritu Santo puede pasar desapercibida, porque Dios no nos revela sus planes y porque el pecado del hombre nubla los dones divinos. Pero la fe nos recuerda que Dios siempre está actuando. Él nos ha creado y nos mantiene en existencia, y conduce a toda la creación por su gracia hacia la gloriosa libertad de los hijos de Dios».

San Josemaría dice que debemos conformarnos a la rica tradición cristiana de docilidad al Espíritu Santo. Ser dóciles significa estar dispuestos a aprender. Debemos ser conscientes de su obra a nuestro alrededor. Debemos reconocer los dones que nos ha dado. Debemos fijarnos en los movimientos e instituciones que Él inspira. Él está constantemente llevando a cabo las obras de Dios en el mundo; si no las vemos, no es porque Él esté ausente. Nuestra fe en el Espíritu Santo debe ser más que una vaga creencia.

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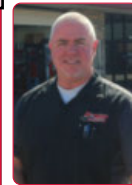
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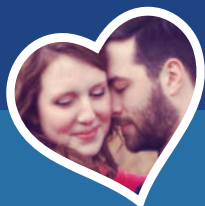
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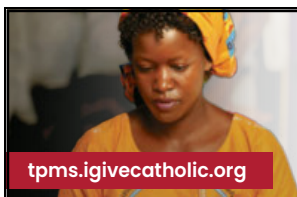
