Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,
In today's gospel the Pharisees and scribes challenge Jesus asking why his disciples don't follow the practices that have been handed on regarding ritual washing. The roots of these practices are found on Exodus 39:19; 40:12. They concern the custom of priests to wash their hands and feet before entering the tent of meeting. By the second century BC, some Jews who were not priests had voluntarily assumed the practice of ritual washing of hands before Morning prayer and before eating. In the gospel reading the washing extends to the utensils for preparing the meal and dining coach. The Pharisees seem to presume these should be universal practices. But such observations would have been nearly impossible for peasant farmers, fishermen, and itinerants such as Jesus given the scarcity of water and contact with dead fish and other pollutants. This "tradition of the elders" (v.3) would have been largely defined and maintained by urban elites.

It is important to recognize the ways in which the heart can stray, as the ending of today's gospel emphasizes. The enumeration of vices is a typical teaching device used by Hellenistic philosophers (see also Rom 1:29-31; Gal 5: 9-10). Jesus warns that it is not external observance or lack of it that determines one's relationship with God but a heart that is ever being transformed by divine love, which becomes visible in concrete acts.

This week we typically think of summer's end since all schools are back in session and IHM Faith Formation completely resumes. Even though we continue to see summer weather we have begun to have not so hot weather. Early registration for our 7th Marian Conference is over and we will still be accepting registrations until September 20. After that date you will need to register when you come to the Marian Conference on October 11-12.

Queridas familias del Corazón Inmaculado de María,

En el evangelio de hoy, los fariseos y los escribas interpelan a Jesús preguntándole por qué sus discípulos no siguen las prácticas transmitidas sobre el lavado ritual. Las raíces de estas prácticas se encuentran en Éxodo 39:19; 40:12. Se refieren a la costumbre de los sacerdotes de lavarse las manos y los pies antes de entrar en la tienda de reunión. En el siglo II a.C., algunos judíos que no eran sacerdotes habían asumido voluntariamente la práctica del lavado ritual de manos antes de la oración matutina y antes de comer. En la lectura del Evangelio, el lavado se extiende a los utensilios para preparar la comida y a la mesa. Los fariseos parecen suponer que éstas deberían ser prácticas universales. Pero tales observaciones habrían sido casi imposibles para campesinos, pescadores e itinerantes como Jesús, dada la escasez de agua y el contacto con peces muertos y otros contaminantes. Esta "tradición de los ancianos" (v. 3) habría sido definida y mantenida en gran medida por las élites urbanas.

Es importante reconocer las formas en que el corazón puede desviarse, como subraya el final del evangelio de hoy. La enumeración de los vicios es un recurso didáctico típico de los filósofos herméticos (véanse también Rom 1:29-31; Gal 5:9-10). Jesús advierte que no es la observancia externa o la falta de ella lo que determina la relación con Dios, sino un corazón siempre transformado por el amor divino, que se hace visible en actos concretos.

Esta semana típicamente pensamos en el fin del verano ya que todas las escuelas regresan a clases y la Formación de Fe de IHM se reanuda completamente. Aunque continuamos viendo el clima de verano hemos comenzado a tener un clima no tan caluroso. La inscripción temprana para nuestra Séptima Conferencia Mariana ha terminado y todavía estaremos aceptando inscripciones hasta el 20 de septiembre. Después de esa fecha tendrán que inscribirse cuando vengan a la Conferencia Mariana el 11 y 12 de octubre.

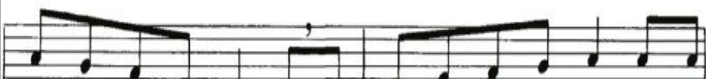

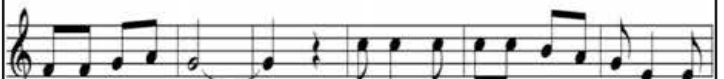

On Tuesday, September 3rd, the Church celebrates St. Gregory the Great. He was born in Rome in 540 to a Catholic and wealthy noble Roman family. Young Gregory, as was customary for boys of affluent families, was well-educated and excelled as a student. He was prepared for a career in public life. He became a government official, quickly rising through the ranks. By age 33, he had become the Prefect of Rome, the highest civil office in Rome.

After his father died, Gregory converted his family villa into a monastery dedicated to St. Andrew the Apostle. He became a monk and deeply respected the monastic life and those who took the vow of poverty. Pope Pelagius II ordained Gregory a deacon and sent him off to deal with various crises in the Church. He was later named the ambassador to the imperial court in Constantinople. Upon the death of Pope Pelagius II in 590, Gregory was elected Pope, much to his disappointment that he could not return home to the monastic life.

Pope Gregory's papacy lasted 14 years. Although he suffered from ill health for much of it, he accomplished a great deal. He wrote extensively, more than all the previous 63 popes. His first writing as Pope was on the duties of the office of the bishop. He led by example; for what he preached, he practiced. He used his previous administration experience to develop an efficient system of charitable relief to the poor in Rome, which were many. He instituted several liturgical reforms. He is credited with the standardization of plainchant, now called Gregorian Chant. This happened well after his death, however. Gregory died on March 12, 604.

St. Gregory the Great is a Doctor of the Church and is the patron saint of musicians, Church music, and teachers. St. Gregory the Great, pray for us; Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us!

Please continue to pray for vocations to the priesthood, permanent diaconate, religious life, and marriage.

San Gregorio Magno - 3 de septiembre

El martes 3 de septiembre, la Iglesia celebra a San Gregorio Magno. Nació en Roma en el año 540, en el seno de una familia noble romana, católica y acomodada. El joven Gregorio, como era habitual en los hijos de familias acomodadas, recibió una buena educación y destacó como estudiante. Estaba preparado para una carrera en la vida pública. Se convirtió en funcionario del gobierno, ascendiendo rápidamente en el escalafón. A los 33 años ya era prefecto de Roma, el cargo civil más alto de la ciudad.

Tras la muerte de su padre, Gregorio convirtió la villa familiar en un monasterio dedicado a San Andrés Apóstol. Se hizo monje y respetó profundamente la vida monástica y a quienes hacían voto de pobreza. El Papa Pelagio II ordenó a Gregorio diácono y lo envió a ocuparse de diversas crisis de la Iglesia. Más tarde fue nombrado embajador en la corte imperial de Constantinopla. A la muerte del Papa Pelagio II en 590, Gregorio fue elegido Papa, muy a su pesar por no poder volver a su casa a la vida monástica.

El papado de Gregorio duró 14 años. Aunque sufrió de mala salud durante gran parte del mismo, logró mucho. Escribió mucho, más que todos los 63 papas anteriores. Su primer escrito como Papa fue sobre los deberes del oficio de obispo. Predicaba con el ejemplo; lo que predicaba, lo practicaba. Aprovechó su experiencia previa en la administración para desarrollar un eficaz sistema de ayuda caritativa a los pobres de Roma, que eran muchos. Instituyó varias reformas litúrgicas. Se le atribuye la estandarización del canto llano, ahora llamado canto gregoriano. Sin embargo, esto ocurrió mucho después de su muerte. Gregorio murió el 12 de marzo de 604.

San Gregorio Magno es Doctor de la Iglesia y patrón de los músicos, de la música eclesiástica y de los profesores. San Gregorio Magno, ruega por nosotros; Corazón Inmaculado de María, ruega por nosotros.

Por favor, sigan rezando por las vocaciones al sacerdocio, al diaconado permanente, a la vida religiosa y al matrimonio.


