Dear Families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Discipleship on Jesus Christ requires action. Words are insufficient. To better understand the context of today's parable, we must know the reason why Jesus offers his teaching. After seeing Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem, his overturning the tables in the temple, and his continued curing of the blind and lame, the religious authorities are jealous and angry. They question Jesus' authority: How can this man act in the way that he does? Knowing this background gives us fuller insight into the two sons of today's parable. While the first son initially rejects the command to tend the vineyard, he experiences a conversion of heart and goes out to steward the land. There are the people Jesus has been associating with to the dismay of the religious authorities. Contrastingly, the religious authorities are like the second son who says "yes" but does not follow up with action.

The second reading from Paul's letter to the community at Philippi beautifully outlines the way of life that discipleship demands: love, compassion, mercy, unity, and humility. We must remember however, that this is not simply a random list of qualities or characteristics—they are the very things Christ modeled by his life.

Christ exemplifies humility. This is the same humility required of the first son who changed his mind and went out to the vineyard. This is the same humility required of each of us to admit when we are wrong and in need of a change of heart.

Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us.

El discipulado sobre Jesucristo requiere acción. Las palabras son insuficientes. Para comprender mejor el contexto de la parábola actual, debemos conocer la razón por la que Jesús ofrece su enseñanza. Tras ver la entrada triunfal de Jesús en Jerusalén, su volcar las mesas en el templo y su continua curación de ciegos y cojos, las autoridades religiosas se mostraron celosas y enfadadas. Cuestionan la autoridad de Jesús: ¿Cómo puede este hombre actuar de la manera en que lo hace? Conocer este trasfondo nos da una visión más completa de los dos hijos de la parábola actual. Aunque el primogénito rechaza inicialmente la orden de cuidar el viñedo, experimenta una conversión de corazón y sale a cuidar la tierra. Están las personas con las que Jesús se ha estado relacionando, para disgusto de las autoridades religiosas. En contraste, las autoridades religiosas son como el segundo hijo que dice "sí" pero no responde con la acción.

La segunda lectura de la carta de Pablo a la comunidad de Filipos describe de forma hermosa el modo de vida que exige el discipulado; amor, compasión, misericordia, unidad y humildad. Sin embargo, debemos recordar que esta no es simplemente una lista al azar de cualidades o características—son precisamente las cosas que Cristo modeló en su vida.

Cristo ejemplifica la humildad. Esta es la misma humildad que se requiere del primer hijo que cambió de opinión y salió al viñedo. Esta es la misma humildad que cada uno de nosotros requiere admitir cuando estamos equivocados y necesitamos un cambio de opinión.

Inmaculado Corazón de María, ruega por nosotros.

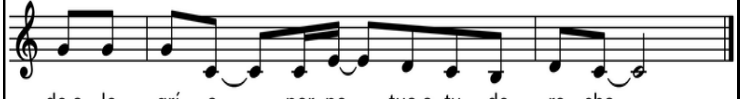

Twenty-sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Ez 18:25-28 | Phil 2:1-11 | Mt 21:28-32

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Ask any long-time educator, and they'll tell you we often learn more from our mistakes than from doing it perfectly from the start. Today's Gospel also seems to send the same message: Jesus tells us that tax collectors and prostitutes are entering the kingdom of God before the chief priests and elders. Perhaps this is because they – having lived a sinful life – know firsthand the emptiness of not following God's ways. Having gotten it wrong, they now earnestly seek what is right. The mystic Julian of Norwich writes, "First the fall, and then the recovery from the fall, and both are the mercy of God." Even in our wanderings, God is at work, drawing us to return to him. Ezekiel tells us that when we respond to that grace and turn from the wickedness we have committed, doing what is right and just, we will surely not die, but receive the gift of eternal life from the God who is Mercy itself.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Speaking to the Christian community at Philippi, St. Paul reminds them to have "the same attitude that is also in Christ Jesus." The previous lines offer a glimpse of what that attitude entails: encouragement, love, compassion, mercy, unity, humility, regarding others as more important than ourselves. These attitudes should shape our way of relating to those whom we are trying to evangelize. Rather than judging them or thinking of ourselves as more important, we are called to serve them with humility, offering them our encouragement to seek the Lord who loves them so much that he gave his life for them.

REFLECT

Today's Gospel includes the story of a son who initially says no to his father's request but then changes his mind and does it. The Gospel ends with a line about how the chief priests and elders did not change their minds even when they saw tax collectors and prostitutes responding to John's call to repentance. Indeed, the Greek word for conversion is *metanoia*, which has been defined as "a change of mind that leads to a change in action." Take some time today to do an examination of conscience, asking the Holy Spirit to reveal areas of thinking that need conversion and change. What might the Holy Spirit want to change your mind about this day?

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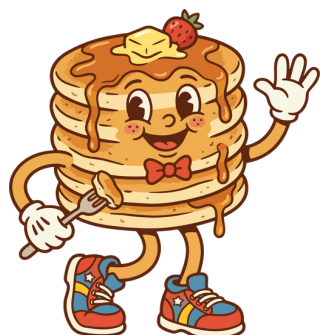

The God of Changed Minds

I wonder what was so important.

The man gave both his sons the same order: go out and work in the vineyard today. One son said yes. One refused.

The first son doesn't show up. The second son changes his mind, and does what his father asked. I wonder what was so important, that it kept the first from fulfilling his word. I wonder what was so important, that it prevented the second from committing wholeheartedly.

I have an image in my head of the sun setting on the vineyard. The second son pauses for a moment to catch his breath while his father sits at the gate, anxiously scanning the horizon. "Any sign?" the son asks the father, who instead of answering drops his gaze into his lap.

With this parable, Jesus acknowledges that few of his disciples can anticipate a straight path to Heaven. Most of us are destined for a few bends in the road. Most of us will suffer failures of will and strength. We will become distracted. We will become preoccupied. We will doubt ourselves. There will be so many things that seem important, and it will take us too long to realize they aren't. Once we have, we may be too proud to change course.

The shadows grow long in the vineyard. Any moment and they will give way to darkness. With its dying breath, the sun illuminates the contours of a figure making his way toward the father and son. When the figure cries out, it is a voice they recognize. "Am I too late?"

We worship the God of second chances. The God of changed minds. The God of never-too-late.

Con esta parábola, Jesús reconoce que pocos de sus discípulos pueden anticipar un camino directo al Cielo. La mayoría estamos destinados a encontrarnos con algunas curvas en el camino. La mayoría sufriremos flaquezas de voluntad y fortaleza. Nos distraeremos. Nos preocuparemos. Dudaremos de nosotros mismos. Habrá tantas cosas que parecerán importantes, y tardaremos demasiado en darnos cuenta de que no lo son. Una vez que lo hagamos, tal vez seamos demasiado orgullosos para cambiar de rumbo.

Las sombras se alargan en el viñedo. En cualquier momento cederán ante la oscuridad. Con su último aliento, el sol ilumina los contornos de una figura que se acerca al padre y al hijo. Cuando la figura grita, reconocen una voz. "¿Llego demasiado tarde?"

Adoramos al Dios de las segundas oportunidades. Al Dios de las mentes transformadas. Al Dios del que nunca es demasiado tarde.

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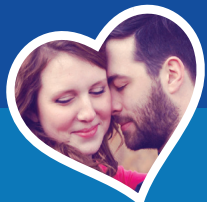
