Segunda Lectura

Evangelio

Mt 25, 31-46

En aquel tiempo, Jesús dijo a sus discípulos: "Cuando venga el Hijo del hombre, rodeado de su gloria, acompañado de todos sus ángeles, se sentará en su trono de gloria. Entonces serán congregadas ante él todas las naciones, y él apartará a los unos de los otros, como aparta el pastor a las ovejas de los cabritos, y pondrá a las ovejas a su derecha y a los cabritos a su izquierda.

Entonces dirá el rey a los de su derecha: 'Vengan, benditos de mi Padre; tomen posesión del Reino preparado para ustedes desde la creación del mundo; porque estuve hambriento y me dieron de comer, sediento y me dieron de beber, era forastero y me hospedaron, estuve desnudo y me vistieron, enfermo y me visitaron, encarcelado y fueron a verme'. Los justos le contestarán entonces: 'Señor, ¿cuándo te vimos hambriento y te dimos de comer, sediento y te dimos de beber? ¿Cuándo te vimos de forastero y te hospedamos, o desnudo y te vestimos? ¿Cuándo te vimos enfermo o encarcelado y te fuimos a ver?' Y el rey les dirá: 'Yo les aseguro que, cuando lo hicieron con el más insignificante de mis hermanos, conmigo lo hicieron'.

Entonces dirá también a los de su izquierda: 'Apártense de mí, malditos; vayan al fuego eterno, preparado para el diablo y sus ángeles; porque estuve hambriento y no me dieron de comer, sediento y no me dieron de beber, era forastero y no me hospedaron, estuve desnudo y no me vistieron, enfermo y encarcelado y no me visitaron'.

Entonces ellos le responderán: 'Señor, ¿cuándo te vimos hambriento o sediento, de forastero o desnudo, enfermo o encarcelado y no te asistimos?' Y él les replicará: 'Yo les aseguro que, cuando no lo hicieron con uno de aquellos más insignificantes, tampoco lo hicieron conmigo'. Entonces irán éstos al castigo eterno y los justos a la vida eterna".

foundation of the world. For I was hungry and you
gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink,
a stranger and you welcomed me, naked and you
clothed me, ill and you cared for me, in prison and you
visited me.' Then the righteous will answer him and
say, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you,
or thirsty and give you drink? When did we see you a
stranger and welcome you, or naked and clothe you?
When did we see you ill or in prison, and visit you?'
And the king will say to them in reply, 'Amen, I say to
you, whatever you did for one of the least brothers of
mine, you did for me.' Then he will say to those on his
left, 'Depart from me, you accursed, into the eternal
fire prepared for the devil and his angels.
For I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was
thirsty and you gave me no drink, a stranger and you
gave me no welcome, naked and you gave me no
clothing, ill and in prison, and you did not care for me.'
Then they will answer and say, 'Lord, when did we
see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or ill
or in prison, and not minister to your needs?' He will
answer them, 'Amen, I say to you, what you did not do
for one of these least ones, you did not do for me.'
And these will go off to eternal punishment,
but the righteous to eternal life."



Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

Ez 34:11-12, 15-17 | 1 Cor 15:20-26, 28 | Mt 25:31-46

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Today, we acknowledge and celebrate Christ the King. It's hard to put this royal image together with today's Gospel passage, where Jesus is not asking to be treated like a king, but rather instructing us to perform merciful deeds for the least of his brothers and sisters. Yet it is the perfect follow-on to the previous three Sundays' Scriptures, where Jesus tells us what it means to live a life of holiness, preparation, and faithful investment in the Kingdom. Now we see what awaits those of us who turn over our lives to him, seeing the face of Jesus in the least among us – the poor, the imprisoned, the thirsty, the stranger. "Come, you who are blessed by my Father. Inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world."

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

I confess that judgment day readings scare me a little. Some days I behave more like a "goat" than a "sheep." Side note: After a deep dive into the Internet (did you know that sheep have 54 chromosomes and goats have 60?), I've concluded that Jesus isn't talking about farm animals here. He's talking about us humans and the choices we make or don't make through sins of omission. The list seems endless if I focus on all the things I *could* be doing to help others each and every day. Yet, rather than getting caught up in fear or guilt, today's readings encourage me, and remind me, that Jesus has told us what we need to do to be counted as "sheep" on the last day.

ACTIONS:

- Choose one corporal work of mercy today and act on it. What does it look like to "visit the sick"? Donate blood; make food for someone who isn't feeling well; check in on an elderly neighbor.
- Do you know some "sheep" – people who radiate faith and kindness to others? Just as you might network with a professional in your field, invite that person out for coffee. Ask them about their faith and how it inspires them in their daily lives.

Dear IHM Family,

As this difficult year is coming to an end, and it is time to look forward to 2021, the Finance Council is working on the budget. This is a much harder task this time, as no one knows when we will be able to resume our "new" normal church life.

Before we look forward however, we want to look back on this year and let all of you know what was accomplished. **It is only with your continued financial support, the dedication and sacrifice of all staff members, working minimal hours, we have been able to keep office operations and Religious Formation activities running.**

Although our income **YTD September** is down -37%, we managed to keep the expenses lower by -25%. **While we did have a shortfall, we were fortunate to have a rainy-day fund that helped us meet all our financial obligations including our annual Diocesan assessment, keep our facilities in good repair, and provide live mass feeds.** There are several parishes that have had to close their doors, as they did not have the funds for staffing or general expenses.

We were truly fortunate in having set aside funds for the last 2 years to cover the costs of a necessary **complete IT, computer system upgrade of our very outdated and vulnerable system which was prone to losing important information.** Along with the computer system a new wi-fi upgrade was done to enable better **connectivity** in the hall, **church, plaza, and classrooms.**

We also have a new camera **security** system to make our facility more secure, both inside and in the parking lots. **The landscape updates and tree trimming have almost exclusively been covered by donations and the work completed by volunteers.**

Although these capital expenditures were **incurred** during this time, the costs will be offset by lowering the costs of monthly phone and internet bills, as well as the maintenance of outdated equipment.

It is with deep gratitude, on behalf of Fr. Quang and the Finance Council, **we thank you for of all** your contributions and constant support of Immaculate Heart of Mary Church.

Queridas familias del Inmaculado Corazon de Maria,

Ya que este difícil año está llegando a su fin, es hora de mirar hacia el 2021, el Consejo de Finanzas está trabajando en el presupuesto. Esta vez es una tarea mucho más difícil, ya que nadie sabe cuándo podremos reanudar nuestra "nueva" vida normal eclesiástica.

Sin embargo, antes de mirar hacia adelante, queremos mirar hacia atrás, a este año y decirles a todos ustedes lo que se logró. **Sólo con su continuo apoyo financiero, la dedicación y el sacrificio de todos los miembros del personal, trabajando un mínimo de horas, hemos podido mantener las operaciones de la oficina y las actividades de Formación Religiosa en funcionamiento.**

A pesar de que nuestros ingresos **de Enero hasta septiembre bajaron** un -37%, hemos logrado mantener los gastos a un nivel del -25%. **Aunque tuvimos un déficit, tuvimos la suerte de tener un fondo para los gastos imprevistos que nos ayudó a cumplir con todas nuestras obligaciones financieras, incluyendo la evaluación anual de la Diócesis, mantener nuestras instalaciones en buen estado y proporcionar Misas en vivo para nuestros fieles.** Hay varias parroquias que han tenido que cerrar sus puertas, ya que no tenían los fondos para el personal o los gastos generales.

Fuimos realmente afortunados en haber reservado fondos durante los últimos 2 años para cubrir los costos de una necesaria **actualización del sistema de computacion** completo de nuestro anticuado y vulnerable sistema que era propenso a perder información importante. Junto con el sistema de computacion se hizo una nueva actualización del wi-fi para permitir una mejor **conectividad** en el vestíbulo, **la iglesia**, la plaza y las aulas.

También tenemos un nuevo sistema de cámaras de seguridad para hacer nuestras instalaciones más seguras, tanto en el interior como en los estacionamientos. **Las actualizaciones de los jardines y la poda de árboles se han cubierto casi exclusivamente con donaciones y el trabajo realizado por voluntarios.**

Aunque estos gastos del capital **fueron realizados** durante este tiempo, los costos se compensarán con la reducción de los costos de las facturas mensuales de teléfono e Internet, así como el mantenimiento del equipo antiguo.

Es con profunda gratitud, en nombre del Padre Quang y del Consejo de Finanzas, **les agradecemos todas sus contribuciones y el apoyo constante a Iglesia del Inmaculado Corazón de María.**




