Dear Families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Americans have an uncomfortable relationship with kings. The American Revolution was fought for independence from King George, after all. Nonetheless, today every Catholic church around the world celebrates the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. Today's feast invites us to look beyond our national loyalty and rejoice in our primary identity. We are children of God in Jesus, Christ the King. Our readings help us consider what it's like to belong to God's kingdom. The book of Samuel captures the deep longing of the Israelites for a king to shepherd them. Saint Paul reminds the Colossians that we belong to the kingdom of Christ, whose power he praises in a beautiful hymn. Finally, Luke's Gospel calls to mind the kind of king Jesus chooses to be—a suffering servant, a man for others. By sacrificing his life for us, Jesus throws open the gates of Paradise.

Today's Gospel paints in stark contrast the power of imperial Rome, which brooks no challenges to its rule, and the "kingly" ways of Jesus that rest forgiveness and love. Even as it appears the former may win out, the gospel makes it utterly clear that Jesus's merciful rule cannot be extinguished by death.

Por último, el Evangelio de Lucas evoca el tipo de rey que Jesús elige ser, un siervo sufriente, un hombre para los demás. Al sacrificar su vida por nosotros, Jesús abre las puertas del Paraíso.

El Evangelio de hoy pinta en marcado contraste el poder de la Roma imperial, que no tolera desafíos a su gobierno, y los caminos "reales" de Jesús que descansan el perdón y el amor. Incluso cuando parece que el primero puede ganar, el evangelio deja completamente claro que el gobierno misericordioso de Jesús no puede extinguirse con la muerte.

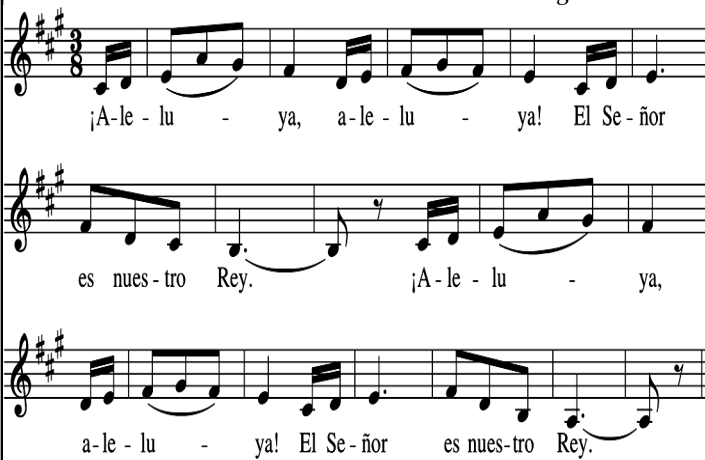

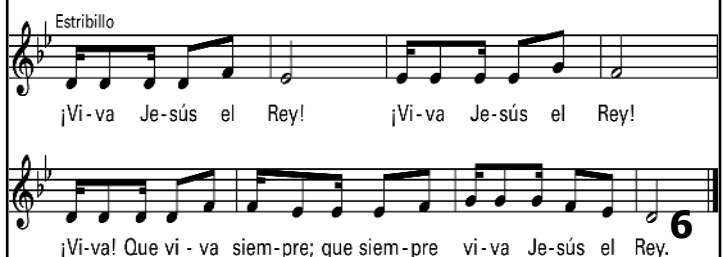

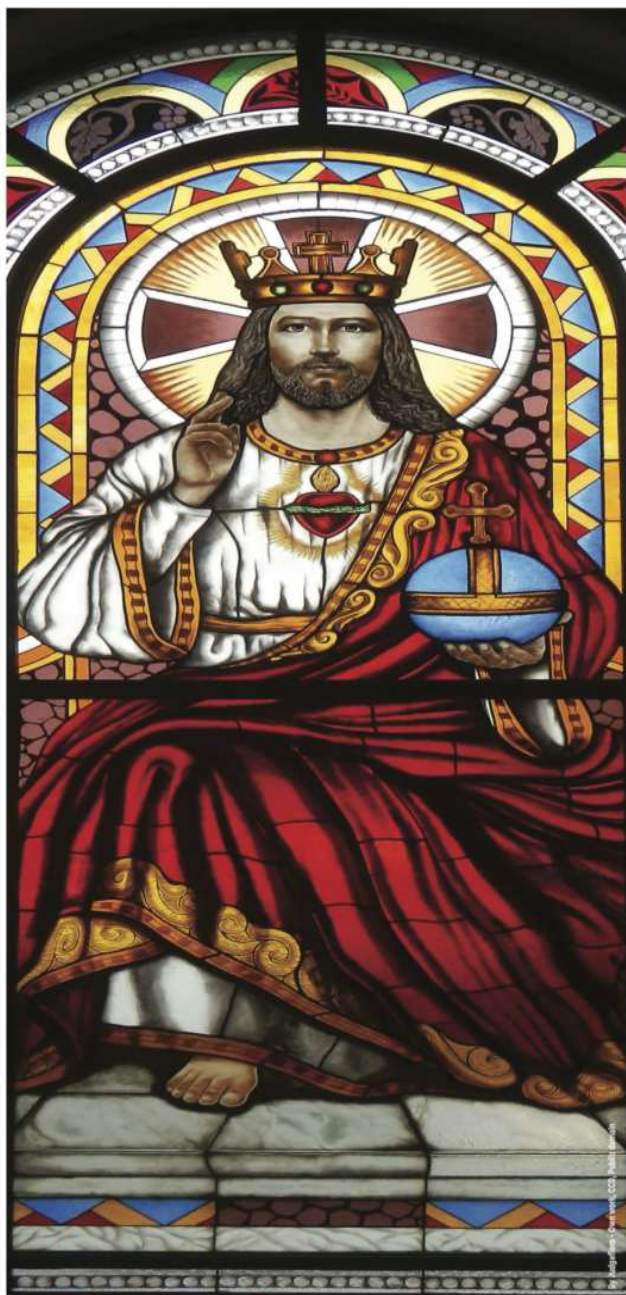

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Since the birth of my oldest child, I have seen and heard many things about what I *should* do as a mother. I have heard everything from which products I should purchase to how I should help my child develop a healthy sleep routine. But my identity as a mother is not dependent upon any of these things; instead, it rests on my relationship with God as his beloved daughter and who he has called me to be as a mother. Those living at the time of Jesus were also trying to understand his identity as king according to their own expectations of what a king was meant to be. They certainly did not expect their king to be crucified by the Romans as we read about in our Gospel today. But Jesus did not come to rule as an earthly king. He *is* king because of his identity as the beloved Son of God, whose mission it was to offer his life for the salvation of all. Jesus did not allow society's understanding of a king to dictate how he lived his mission. Likewise, we must act confidently in accordance with the particular call that God has entrusted to us.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

I find it interesting that when David was anointed king of Israel, he is designated as a commander whose vocation it was to *shepherd* the tribes of Israel. Of course, now we also readily associate the term *shepherd* with Christ, the Good Shepherd who cares for his sheep. The notion of kingship and shepherding, therefore, seem to be intertwined. In the sacrament of baptism, each of us is invited to participate in Christ's mission as priest, prophet, and king. To join Christ in his mission as king, we must also lead lives of service in which we allow the love of God to generously flow through us by caring for others. Let us strive to be shepherds for those in our communities who are seeking to know Christ more intimately; let us participate in Christ's mission as king through humble service to others.

PRAY

Today, take a few minutes to pray for all leaders. Ask the Lord to guide them in their leadership to be good shepherds to all those who fall under their governance. As you participate in your local community and parish, ask for the guidance of the Holy Spirit to join in Christ's mission as king by serving those in need.

Christ the King

This week marks the end of the season of Ordinary Time as well as the end of the liturgical year. Next week is the First Sunday of Advent. The three-year liturgical cycle of Sunday readings will switch next week from Year C to Year A. The last Sunday of Ordinary Time is the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe.

For the Jubilee year of 1925, Pope Pius XI wanted to add a new feast to honor the Kingship of Jesus Christ. He issued an encyclical, *Quas Primus*, on December 11, 1925, near the end of that Jubilee year. His reasoning for instituting a feast to the Kingship of Jesus was the aftermath of the First World War and the end of the four major monarchies in Europe. A wave of secularism and ultra-nationalism was spreading worldwide. Pope Pius wrote, "These manifold evils in the world were due to the fact that the majority of men had thrust Jesus Christ and his holy law out of their lives; that these had no place either in private affairs or in politics. As long as individuals and states refused to submit to the rule of our Savior, there would be no really hopeful prospect of a lasting peace among nations."

In *Quas Primus*, he explores the doctrine of Christ's kingship throughout the Old and New Testaments. He writes, "It was surely right, then, in view of the common teaching of the sacred books, that the Catholic Church, which is the kingdom of Christ on earth, destined to be spread among all men and all nations, should with every token of veneration salute her Author and Founder in her annual liturgy as King and Lord, and as King of Kings."

The feast was celebrated on the last Sunday in October, and still is in the extraordinary form. In 1970, Pope St. Paul VI moved the feast to the final Sunday of the liturgical year. This ensures that the liturgical year ends with a focus on the Kingship of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. As we close out this liturgical year and prepare to begin a new one, let us all pray to keep the Kingship of Christ central in our lives and be open to sharing Jesus' Kingship with others.

Cristo Rey

Esta semana marca el final del tiempo ordinario, así como el final del año litúrgico. La próxima semana es el primer domingo de Adviento. El ciclo litúrgico de tres años de lecturas dominicales cambiará la próxima semana del Año C al Año A. El último domingo del Tiempo Ordinario es la Solemnidad de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, Rey del Universo.

Para el año jubilar de 1925, el Papa Pío XI quiso agregar una nueva fiesta para honrar la realeza de Jesucristo. Emitió una encíclica, *Quas Primus*, el 11 de diciembre de 1925, cerca del final de ese año jubilar. Su razonamiento para instituir una fiesta al reinado de Jesús fue después de la Primera Guerra Mundial y el final de las cuatro monarquías principales de Europa. Una ola de secularismo y ultranacionalismo se estaba extendiendo por todo el mundo. El Papa Pío escribió: "Estos múltiples males en el mundo se debieron al hecho de que la mayoría de los hombres habían expulsado a Jesucristo y su santa ley de sus vidas; que estos no tenían cabida ni en los asuntos privados ni en la política. Mientras los individuos y los estados se negaran a someterse al gobierno de nuestro Salvador, no habría ninguna perspectiva realmente esperanzadora de una paz duradera entre las naciones".

En *Quas Primus*, explora la doctrina de la realeza de Cristo a lo largo del Antiguo y Nuevo Testamento. Escribe: "Seguramente fue correcto, entonces, en vista de la enseñanza común de los libros sagrados, que la Iglesia Católica, que es el reino de Cristo en la tierra, destinado a ser difundido entre todos los hombres y todas las naciones, saludara con todas las muestras de veneración a su Autor y Fundador en su liturgia anual como Rey y Señor, y como Rey de Reyes".

La fiesta se celebró el último domingo de octubre, y todavía está en la forma extraordinaria. En 1970, el Papa San Pablo VI trasladó la fiesta al último domingo del año litúrgico. Esto asegura que el año litúrgico termine con un enfoque en la Realeza de nuestro Señor y Salvador Jesucristo. Al cerrar este año litúrgico y prepararnos para comenzar uno nuevo, oremos todos para mantener el Reinado de Cristo en el centro de nuestras vidas y estar abiertos a compartir el Reinado de Jesús con los demás.

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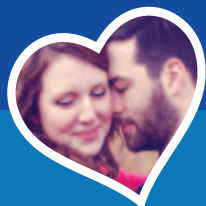
