Dear families of the Immaculate Heart of Mary,

Political power meets spiritual power in today's conversation between Jesus and Pilate. "Are you the King of the Jews?" Pilate asks Jesus (John 18:33). Pilate is concerned about whether Jesus is a threat to Roman rule, just as the Jewish leaders see Jesus as a threat to their authority. Jesus is thus either guilty of fomenting insurrection as a militant messiah or of speaking blasphemy by presenting himself as one who inaugurates the reign of God.

Jesus, however, speaks not about himself as a king but about a kingdom that "does not belong to this world" (John 18:36). This kingdom may not be of this world, but it is in this world. God's kingdom is present in Jesus as one who comes to bear witness to the truth. And what is this truth? That "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life" (John 3:16).

On Thursday, November 28 there will only be one Bilingual Mass at 10:00AM. Our Thanksgiving Day Mass is a long tradition here at IHM. The priests, deacons, Missionary Sisters and the entire Staff wish you a Happy Thanksgiving.

El poder político se encuentra con el poder espiritual en la conversación de hoy entre Jesús y Pilato. "¿Eres tú el rey de los judíos?", le pregunta Pilato a Jesús (Juan 18:33). A Pilato le inquieta que Jesús pueda ser una amenaza para el gobierno romano, así como los líderes judíos ven en Jesús una amenaza a la autoridad de ellos. Jesús, por su parte, ni es culpable ni fomenta una insurrección como un mesías militar, ni tampoco blasfema presentándose como el que inaugura el reino de Dios.

Jesús no se refiere a sí mismo como rey, sino que habla de un reino que "no es de este mundo" (Juan 18:36). Ese reino no será de este mundo, pero está en este mundo. El reino de Dios está presente en Jesús, que viene a dar testimonio de la verdad. Y, ¿cuál es esta verdad? Es que "tanto amó Dios al mundo que le dio a su Hijo único, para que todo el que crea en él no perezca, sino que tenga vida eterna" (Juan 3:16).

## Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

Dn 7:13-14 | Rv 1:5-8 | Jn 18:33b-37

### **GROW AS A DISCIPLE** | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

If we reflect on today's Gospel, it might be hard for us to envision Jesus ever dressed like an actual king! When Pontius Pilate asked him if he was a king, Jesus responded, "If my kingdom did belong to this world, my attendants would be fighting to keep me from being handed over." Imagine: Jesus had spent the night in agony; his friends had all abandoned him; and, in a few verses, Pilate will deliver him to be scourged. He must have *felt*, at that moment, like anything but a king. But, indeed, he was (and is) the Creator of the Universe and its rightful king. We Christians - called, like Jesus' first disciples, to be his friends and followers - should do everything we can to proclaim him as king of our hearts, our families, our lives, and our society.

### **GO EVANGELIZE**

#### **PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT**

There is a tradition of placing an image of Jesus' Sacred Heart in a prominent place in the home. The idea is to "enthroned" Jesus as king of the home and the family; there is even a small ceremony to go along with the enthronement. In one of the most famous images of the Sacred Heart, Jesus wears a magnificent crown, holds a scepter in his right hand, and carries the earth in his left hand. We see, from this picture, Jesus as a king with a glorious crown who holds the world in his hand - but he does so with a heart burning with love! He loves us so much that he wishes to extend the reign of his love to every human being on earth. We can cooperate with him in this by "enthroning" him as king of our hearts and our homes and allowing his love to impact everything we do and say. By our willingness to welcome God into every aspect of our lives, we will become witnesses of his love to others.

**INVITE** This week, take one opportunity to invite someone to pray with you. They could be dinner guests, a coworker, or a friend you meet for coffee. Whoever it is, ask him or her if there are any particular intentions you can bring to God in prayer. By doing this, you remind your friend of God's constant presence and his desire to be part of all of your joys, sorrows, and anxieties.



## The Church and Mary – The Assumption

We looked at Mary as the new Ark of the Covenant a couple of weeks ago. From the moment of her fiat at the Annunciation, she was God's dwelling place on earth. In the Old Testament, upon becoming king, one of David's priorities was to bring the Ark of the Covenant to Jerusalem. The new David, Jesus, who has ascended into the heavenly Jerusalem, would do the same with his mother. The book of Revelation shows this. "Then God's temple in heaven was opened, and the ark of his covenant was seen within his temple; and there were flashes of lightning, loud noises, peals of thunder, an earthquake, and heavy hail. And a great sign appeared in heaven, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars." (Revelation 11:19 – 12:1)

In the 7<sup>th</sup> century, St. Modestus of Jerusalem wrote, "When she [Mary] had completed her life's voyage...Our God summoned his ark of sanctification to be brought home from Zion to himself, just as David said in a psalm, 'Go up, O Lord, to the place of your rest, you and your ark of sanctification.'" (Ps 132:8)

In the 8<sup>th</sup> century, St. John Damascene wrote, "Today the holy, incomparable virgin enters the heavenly sanctuary that lies above the universe. Today the holy, living ark of the living God, the one who carried her maker within herself, come to her rest in the temple of the Lord not made by hands. David, her ancestor and God's, leap for joy, and the angels join in the dance."

Mary's assumption into heaven is a sign of our resurrection and our true home. God created us to be with him in eternity. By assuming his mother into heaven, Jesus is showing us that bodily resurrection and ascension into heaven are not just for him.

Pope Pius XII officially declared the dogma of the Assumption in 1950. In his Apostolic Constitution *Munificentissimus Deus*, he wrote, "We pronounce, declare, and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma: that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever-Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory." As we see from the above examples, Christians have believed in Mary's Assumption from the early times of Christianity.

Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us!

## La Iglesia y María - La Asunción

Hace un par de semanas vimos a María como la nueva Arca de la Alianza. Desde el momento de su fiat en la Anunciación, fue la morada de Dios en la tierra. En el Antiguo Testamento, al convertirse en rey, una de las prioridades de David era llevar el Arca de la Alianza a Jerusalén. El nuevo

David, Jesús, que ha ascendido a la Jerusalén celestial, haría lo mismo con su Madre. Así lo muestra el libro del Apocalipsis. «Entonces se abrió el templo de Dios en el cielo, y se vio el arca de su alianza dentro de su templo; y hubo relámpagos, grandes estruendos, truenos, terremoto y granizo. Y apareció en el cielo una gran señal: una mujer vestida del sol, con la luna debajo de sus pies, y sobre su cabeza una corona de doce estrellas». (Apocalipsis 11:19 - 12:1).

En el siglo VII, San Modesto de Jerusalén escribió: «Cuando ella [María] hubo completado el viaje de su vida... Nuestro Dios llamó a su arca de santificación para que fuera llevada a su casa desde Sión, tal como dijo David en un salmo: "Sube, Señor, al lugar de tu reposo, tú y tu arca de santificación"». (Sal 132, 8)

En el siglo VIII, San Juan Damasceno escribió: «Hoy la santa e incomparable virgen entra en el santuario celestial que está por encima del universo. Hoy el arca santa y viviente del Dios viviente, la que llevó a su creador dentro de sí, viene a su descanso en el templo del Señor no hecho por manos humanas. David, su antepasado y de Dios, salta de alegría, y los ángeles se unen a la danza».

La asunción de María al cielo es un signo de nuestra resurrección y de nuestro verdadero hogar. Dios nos creó para estar con Él en la eternidad. Al asumir a su madre en el cielo, Jesús nos muestra que la resurrección corporal y la ascensión al cielo no son sólo para él.

El Papa Pío XII declaró oficialmente el dogma de la Asunción en 1950. En su Constitución Apostólica *Munificentissimus Deus*, escribió: «Pronunciamos, declaramos y definimos que es un dogma divinamente revelado: que la Inmaculada Madre de Dios, la siempre Virgen María, habiendo completado el curso de su vida terrenal, fue asunta en cuerpo y alma a la gloria celestial.» Como vemos en los ejemplos anteriores, los cristianos han creído en la Asunción de María desde los primeros tiempos del cristianismo.

Inmaculado Corazón de María, ruega por nosotros.

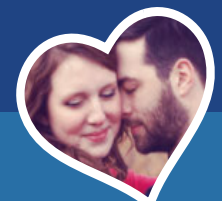
