Covenant... Much more than a contract

A covenant is a solemn agreement between human beings or between God and a human being involving mutual commitments guarantees. (CCC Glossary) A contract has an end; a covenant does not. It is an alliance with consequences for upholding not commitment. It is saying, "I am yours and you are mine". It is familial. Marriage and adoption are examples of covenants.

In the prayers and readings of the Holy Mass listen for these key words that show Divine covenants: co-heirs/heirs, adopt/ion/ed, sons/daughters/children. Listen for frequency Jesus is spoken of as "bridegroom", and the Church or Israel as "bride" (CCC 796).

The Sacred Oils

The Chrism Mass, which [the Bishop] concelebrates with Priests from various regions of the diocese and during which he consecrates the sacred Chrism and blesses the other oils, is among the principal manifestations of the fullness of the Bishop's Priesthood and is considered to be a sign of the close bond of the Priests with him. For it is with the sacred Chrism consecrated by the Bishop that the newly baptized are anointed and those to be confirmed are signed [also Holy Orders]. It is with the Oil of Catechumens that catechumens are prepared and disposed for Baptism. Finally it is with the Oil of the Sick that those who are ill are comforted in their infirmity. (USCCB)
